We offer two distinct Economics majors:

- BA in Economics
A major in economics combines a solid foundation in contemporary economic theory with the opportunity to analyze a wide range of issues important to the material well-being of society. The economics major prepares students for graduate study in economics; careers in education, law, or research; as well as employment in business, government, or international agencies.
- BS in Business Economics
A major in business economics prepares majors to apply the scientific approach to cause and effect relationships affecting the performance of the business enterprise and its impact on society's living standards. The emphasis on analytical skills and empirical methodology provides a strong foundation for students interested in graduate study in business and for those with career interests in economic research or forecasting in either business or government.
