- 3. Financial need as verified by the Office of Admissions/Financial Aid Office

- 5. One letter of recommendation from an instructor in the field of study
- 6. Must agree to work for at least six (6) months at Peninsula Regional Medical Center upon graduation

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 each, six awards available; can be used for tuition, uniforms, books, liability insurance, etc.

## Peninsula Regional Medical Center Standard Educational Scholarship Program for Nursing

To qualify as a candidate for financial assistance, the student must:

- A. Be either a junior or senior-level nursing student at Salisbury University, pursuing initial RN licensure
- B. Apply by filing out the Peninsula Regional Medical Center Standard Educational Scholarship form located at <a href="www.peninsula.org">www.peninsula.org</a> under the Career link. The application can also be obtained by calling the Education Department at Peninsula Regional Medical Center.
- C. Complete an interview by Peninsula Regional Medical Center representatives.
- D. Must agree to work full-time at Peninsula Regional Medical Center for a predetermined amount of time based on financial assistance. Payback time to be stipulated in contract.

Scholarship Amount: Maximum amount of **\$6,000** per student to complete the program; to be used for tuition, fees, books, supplies and uniforms. Funds are paid directly to the University or reimbursed to the student with submitted receipts.

\*Students must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 to continue to receive financial support. Students who drop out of the program will be required to repay sums advanced. Students who complete the program and elect to work at another facility before satisfying their commitment to Peninsula Regional Medical Center will be expected to repay the scholarship loan in full. There is no application deadline.
