UNIVERSITY POLICIES

Salisbury University minors require:

- The completion of at least 18 credits with grades of C or better.
- At least 15 credits applied toward the minor must be coursework that is not used to satisfy General Education requirements.
- At least nine credits must be earned at SU.

Advisement for the minor is available from the Art Department.

MINOR REQUIREMENTS

- At least 4 courses of the work applied toward the minor must consist of courses that are not used to satisfy General Education requirements.
- At least 3 courses must be earned at the University.
- Grades of C or better are required in all courses applicable to the minor.
- Art minors interested in the art history minor must complete four courses outside the art minor requirements.
- Art majors interested in the art history minor must complete four courses outside of their major requirements.
- B.A. art majors with the Art History Track may not minor in art history.
