I ride the waves—real and quantum

I came to SU because it was close to home and the beaches where I love to surf. In my introductory physics class my professor was super nice and the subject was so interesting that I made physics my major. The projects I've done are pretty cool. My most recent is my development of a Passive Infrared Device (PID) that detects motion. It tells you whenever a mouse is going by and uses energy only when it detects a mouse. I did a poster session on it at my second SU Undergraduate Research Conference. I also did a lot of work with wave theory, which is part of quantum mechanics that measures a particle as part of a wave function. I'm planning on going to grad school for electrical engineering, so experience with the wave theory is really useful. I'm definitely glad I chose SU because it's a small community where everybody knows everybody. However, its size has encouraged me to see the world

through my semester abroad in Australia and participating in important physics research that will help jump-start my future.
