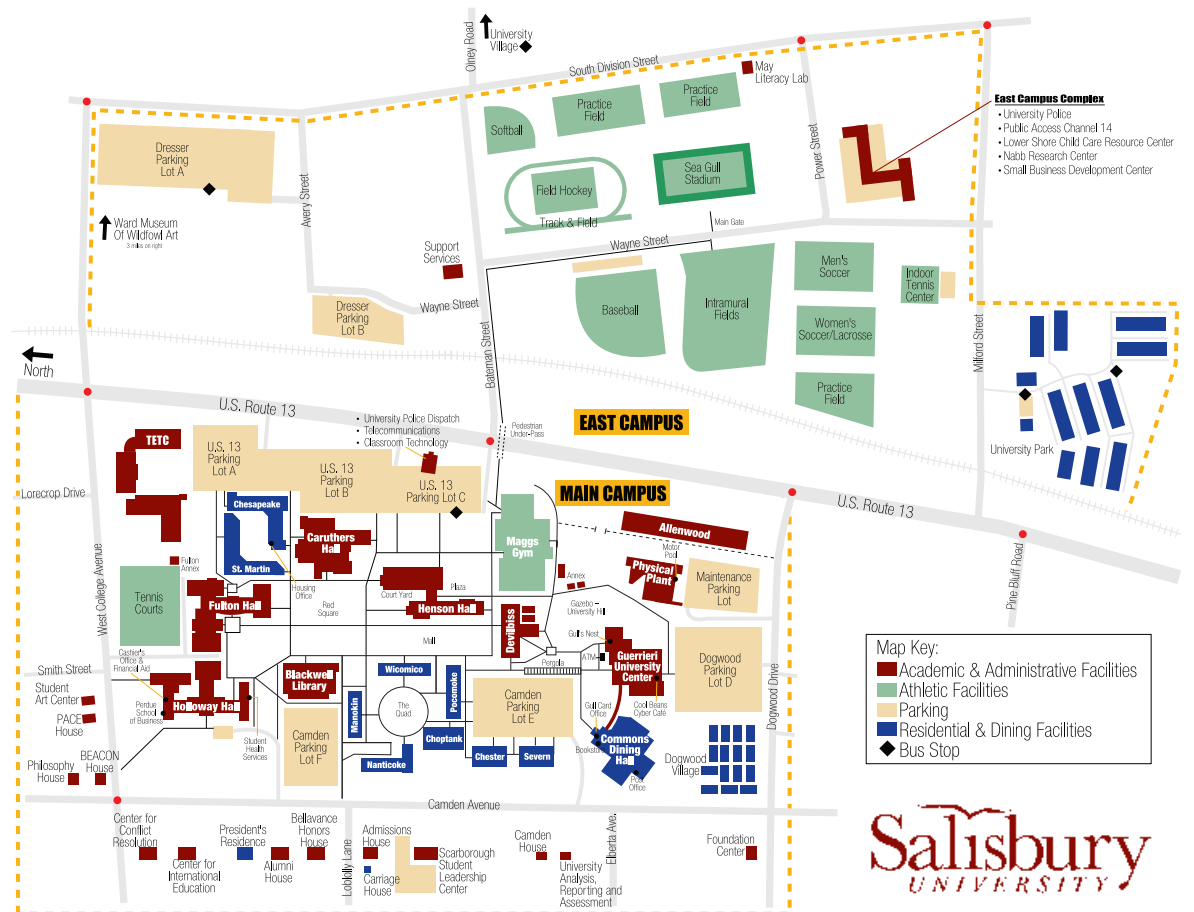
## GETTING HERE
