Scholarship Application Information for PHI THETA KAPPA Members Applying to Salisbury University:

Scholarship Awards:

In-State: \$2,000 per year; renewable for four semesters providing the student maintains full-time status and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 at SU.

Out-of State: \$3,000 per year; renewable for four semesters providing the student maintains full-time status and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 at SU.

Eligibility Requirements:

Applicants must submit documentation of current PTK membership.

Applicants must have earned a minimum of 56 transferable semester hours.

Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50, including all colleges attended

Final student transcripts must verify a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50 and 56 transferable S.H., or the scholarship, if awarded, will be rescinded.

Applicants must apply for admission to SU directly from their PTK Community College; use the PTK fee waiver to waive the \$45.00 application fee.

Scholarships are considered only for students entering in the fall semester.

PTK scholarship application, PTK membership documentation, application for admission, and transcripts from all colleges attended must arrive in the SU Admissions Office by March 1. Your current transcript must include grades for all completed courses and a list of your final spring courses.

Decision letters will be mailed in April.

Along with the academic profile, leadership roles and community service will also be considered.

Students who have earned a bachelor's degree, international students, and students who will attend SU on a part-time basis are not eligible for this scholarship.
