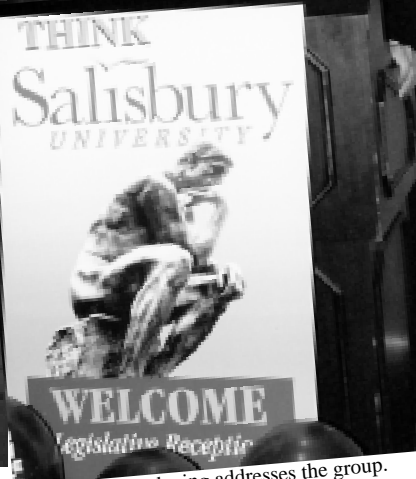
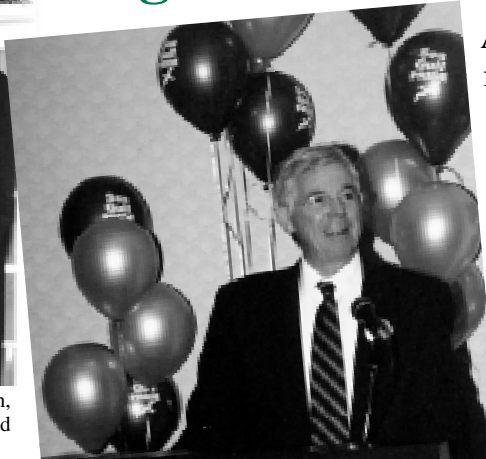


## Legislative Reception 2002

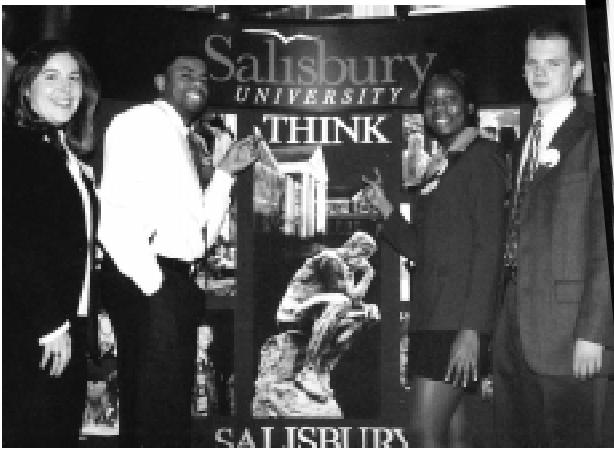

## New Alumni Awards Announced

For years, the Alumni Association has presented an Alumni Appreciation Award to someone who has demonstrated outstanding dedication and service to SU and/or the Alumni Association. This year the Awards and Recognition Committee is changing the name of that award to **Alumni Service Award** and is accepting nominations for this award as well as two new awards:

### Lifetime Achievement Award

This award will be presented to an alumnus/a who has demonstrated long-term success in his/her career and who also exemplifies the attributes of an SU graduate, such as leadership, citizenship, community service and/or service to his/her business or industry.

### Service to Society Award

This award will be presented to an alumnus/a who has demonstrated a contribution of service made for the betterment of society, either in a professional or volunteer capacity.

Nominations should strongly support the reason why your nomination is worthy of the award for which you are nominating him/her. This support must include your letter of nomination and could include, but not necessarily be limited to, your nomination's resume, newspaper/magazine articles, testimonials, etc.
