Students Becoming Ill on a Trip

Should a student become ill during a trip, contact Wayne Gorrow (410-228-2771). Depending on the nature of the illness and your current location, you may need to take the ill person to a hospital or urgent care facility. If you are on a university campus for an event, work with the host site to contact the student health center on campus. Hotel staff will also be able to assist you with locating a nearby medical clinic or hospital.



When to Call 911 on the Road**If the victim:**



Becomes unconscious
has trouble breathing or is breathing in a strange way
has chest pain or pressure
is bleeding severely
has pressure or pain in the abdomen that does not go away
is vomiting or passing blood
has seizures, a severe headache, or slurred speech
appears to have been poisoned
has injuries to the head, neck, or back
has possible broken bones
is pregnant and becomes ill



If the situation involves:



fire or explosion
downed electrical wires
swiftly moving or rapidly rising water
presence of poisonous gas
vehicle collisions
victims who cannot be easily moved


1. Tell the 911 dispatcher
 - Your name
 - The nature of the emergency
 - The quantity and condition(s) of the victim(s)
 - Your name and a phone number where you can be reached
 - The location of the situation (inside the facility, room number, etc.)
 - The area that a staff person will meet emergency medical personnel
2. Do not hang up until you are told to do so or unless there is an immediate threat to your safety.


