OTHER MINOR REQUIREMENTS:

- A minimum grade of C earned in each course.
- Courses selected to complete the core requirements may not be used to complete track requirements.
- No more than 2 courses from one department may be used to complete the minor.
- Eligibility of topics courses, studies and language courses not listed above will be determined through review of syllabi by the minor coordinator at the request of students and/or faculty.

The University requires that at least 15 hours of work applied toward the minor must consist of courses which are not use to satisfy General Education requirements and at least nine of these hours must be credits earned at the University.
