For a minor in Philosophy, a student must complete 5 courses, with at least 2 at the 300/400 level. Of these, 1 course must be taken from the Classical Core, 1 course from the History of Philosophy, and 3 courses from Philosophy Electives. The University requires that at least 15 hours of the work applied toward a minor must consist of courses which are not used to satisfy General Education requirements, and at least 9 of these hours must be credits earned at the University. Additionally, minors require grades of C or better in all courses applicable to the minor. Please refer to the back of this page for a complete listing of course titles and categories.
