2. All students must complete either NURS 590, NURS 591, or NURS 592. Approval of Committee Chair is required for registration.
 - a) **NURS 590 Thesis** - variable credit - may register for 1-3 credits for a total of 3 credits. Students must be registered for at least 1 credit in NURS 590 in the semester that they defend the thesis.
 - b) **NURS 591 Capstone Project** - variable credit - may register for 1-3 credits for a total of 3 credits. Students must be registered for at least 1 credit in NURS 591 in the semester that they present at Graduate Scholarship Night.
 - c) **NURS 592 Internship** - 3 credits - Students must complete all practicum courses prior to registering for NURS 592.
