The first checklist (on this side) should be used by students **not** intending to pursue the Perdue School M.B.A. Students wishing to attend M.B.A. programs at other institutions should consult those schools' entrance requirements to determine which electives to take. **Students desiring to complete the prerequisite courses for the Perdue School M.B.A. program should use the checklist on the reverse side.**

Students must take **all** courses in Group 1, **all** courses in Group 2, and **three** of the courses in Group 3, **including all prerequisite courses.** (Additionally, for economics majors, 15 credits must be credits not applied to the economics major.)

Policies and Procedures

1. All courses in each minor (BUAD or 4+1 BUAD) must be completed with a "C" or better including transfer credits. No course may be taken pass/fail.
2. At least **9 credits** of each minor must be earned at Salisbury University
3. At least **15 credits** of the work applied toward the BUAD or 4+1 BUAD minor must consist of courses which are **not** used to satisfy General Education or Perdue School requirements.
4. The Perdue School does not allow course substitution; only those courses listed as fulfilling the minor are accepted.
5. Not intended for Accounting, Business Concentrations, Finance, Information Systems, Management, and Marketing majors.
6. Check the SU catalog for course pre-requisite information.
