The Information Systems minor is open to any student at Salisbury University except Information Systems majors. The minor requires 18 credit hours, any of which may be used to fulfill other degree requirements.

Policies and Procedures

1. All courses in the INFO minor must be completed with a “C” or better including transfer credits. No course may be taken pass/fail.
2. At least **9 credits** of each minor must be earned at Salisbury University
3. The minor in INFO consists of 18 credits, any of which may be used to fulfill other Perdue School requirements.
4. The Perdue School does not allow course substitution; only those courses listed as fulfilling the minor are accepted.
