The minor in Mathematics consists of at least 18 credit hours of mathematics, of which at least 15 credit hours are not counted for general education, at least 12 credit hours are numbered 201 or higher, at least 3 credit hours are at the 300 or 400 level, and at least 9 credit hours are earned at Salisbury University. The student must earn a grade of "C" or better in each course. **Faculty are available for students seeking advice in planning a sequence.**
