Policies and Procedures

1. All courses in the ECON minor must be completed with a "C" or better including transfer credits. No course may be taken pass/fail.
2. At least **9 credits** of the ECON minor must be earned at Salisbury University
3. At least **15 credits** of the work applied toward the ECON minor must consist of courses which are **not** used to satisfy General Education or Perdue School requirements.
4. The Perdue School does not allow course substitution; only those courses listed as fulfilling the minor are accepted.
5. Students must declare the Economics minor with the Director of Academic Services in the Perdue School.
