

Residence Hall Traffic and Move-In Procedure

Fall 2011

We are looking forward to your arrival at Salisbury University! We understand that this is an exciting, yet stressful, time for you and your family and we are making every effort to create a smooth transition for you.

We have developed a traffic flow system to aid in the movement of vehicles to and from the residence hall loading zones. In order to limit delays, enclosed is a parking permit required by all *freshmen students* and those moving into *Sea Gull Square*. It is highly important that you display the permit on the driver's side dashboard as you arrive to campus. The absence of a permit may delay your arrival to your assigned residence hall. To allow for a more efficient unloading system and to assist in limiting delays, police officers will direct you to your designated off-loading area.

The included charts indicate your designated move-in date and time. Please plan to arrive at your assigned time to expedite your check-in process and avoid delays. Adhering to the designated time will assist in your successful move. A licensed driver must stay with each vehicle. Once unloaded, you will be directed to a designated parking area. If you are delayed in traffic or experience any difficulties, please call us at 410-543-6040 to ensure that your residence hall room is held. Rooms unclaimed on check-in day may become available for re-assignment to another student.

To summarize:

1. Display permit on driver dash (Freshmen and Sea Gull Square students ONLY).
2. Follow signs and SU personnel directing traffic.
3. A licensed driver MUST stay with each vehicle.
4. Once unloaded, move vehicle to designated parking area.
5. A hand cart or dolly may prove helpful for your move!
6. Please remember to bring your Gull Card!

Sea Gull Square: University Police will guide your vehicle around campus upon your arrival. Each student has been assigned a specific zone in which to park for move-in. These zones were designed to provide you the most direct and closest access to your room to unload your belongings. While access doors for zones A and C are not next to the elevator, any student is welcome to park in the Dogwood Village parking lot to access the elevator.

A few important reminders regarding Sea Gull Square:

- Bikes are not permitted in any room or interior hallway. There is an enclosed bike barn located on the southwest corner of the building closest to the Housing Office.
- All Sea Gull Square apartments are fully furnished. Residents are not allowed to bring additional furniture into any apartment.
- ***Hanging televisions on any wall is not allowed.*** Additionally, nailing or screwing anything into a wall is not permissible. We will provide you with a starter portion of Magic Mount.
- Students are not permitted to park in the retail parking area in and around Sea Gull Square. Please visit Parking Services at www.salisbury.edu/police/Parking for more information.
