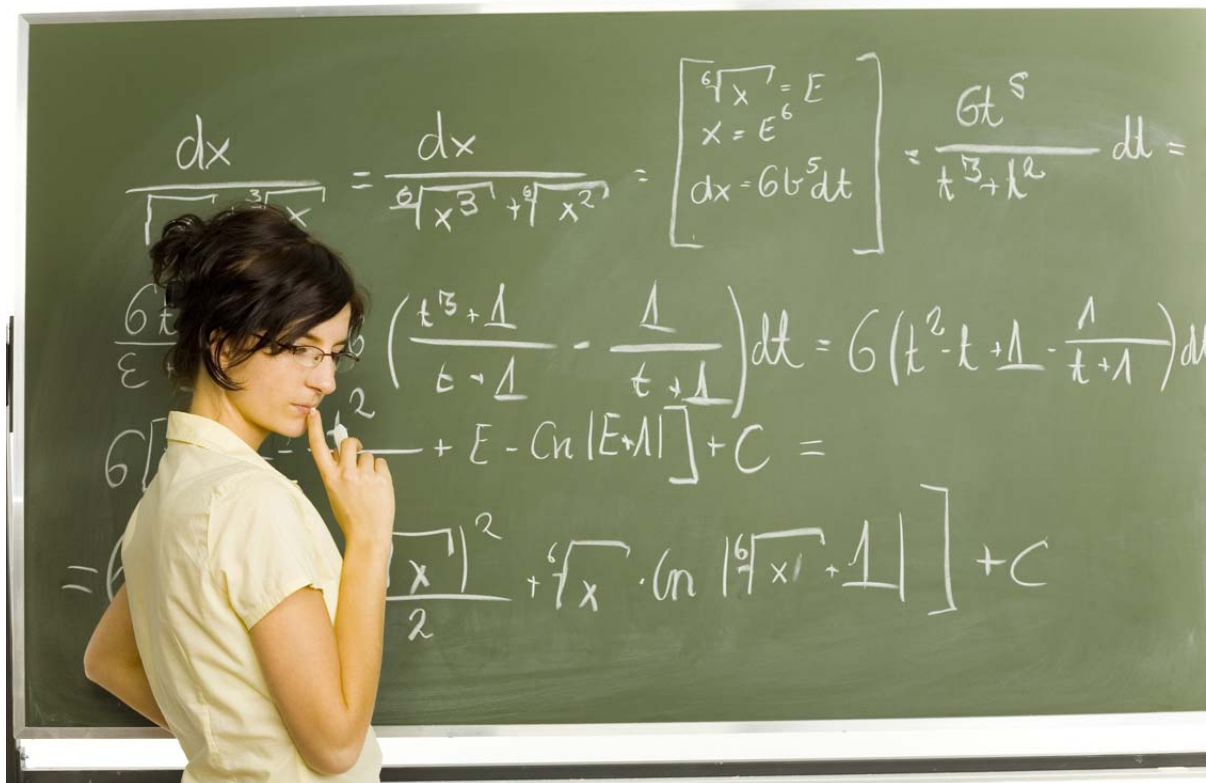

Degrees Awarded as Double Majors by School, AY 2003-04 through AY 2007-08

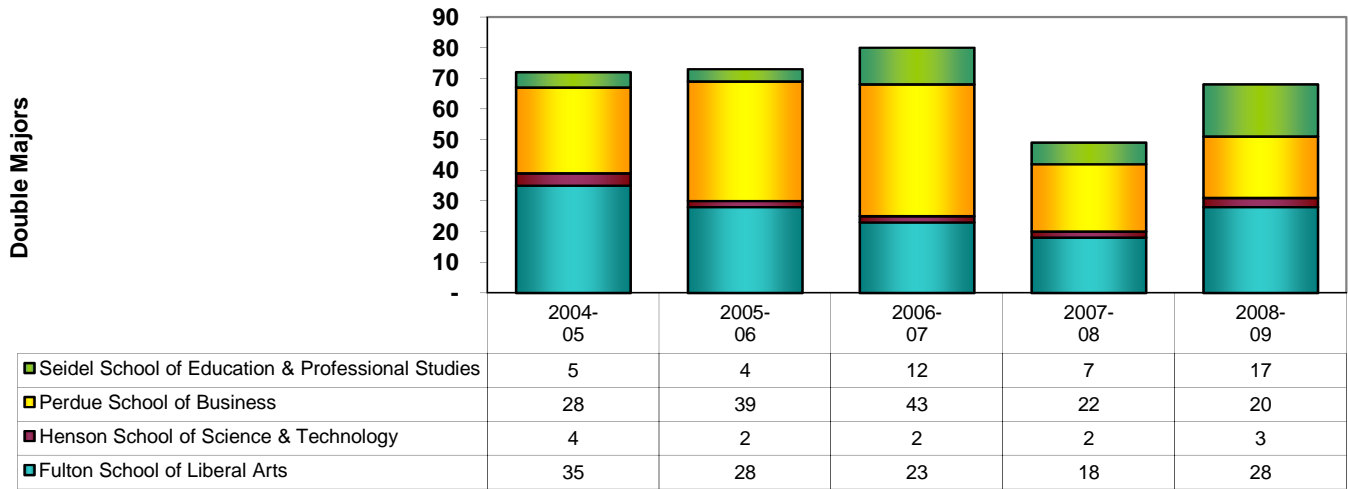


Chart 1.2:

AY 2006-07 through AY 2008-09

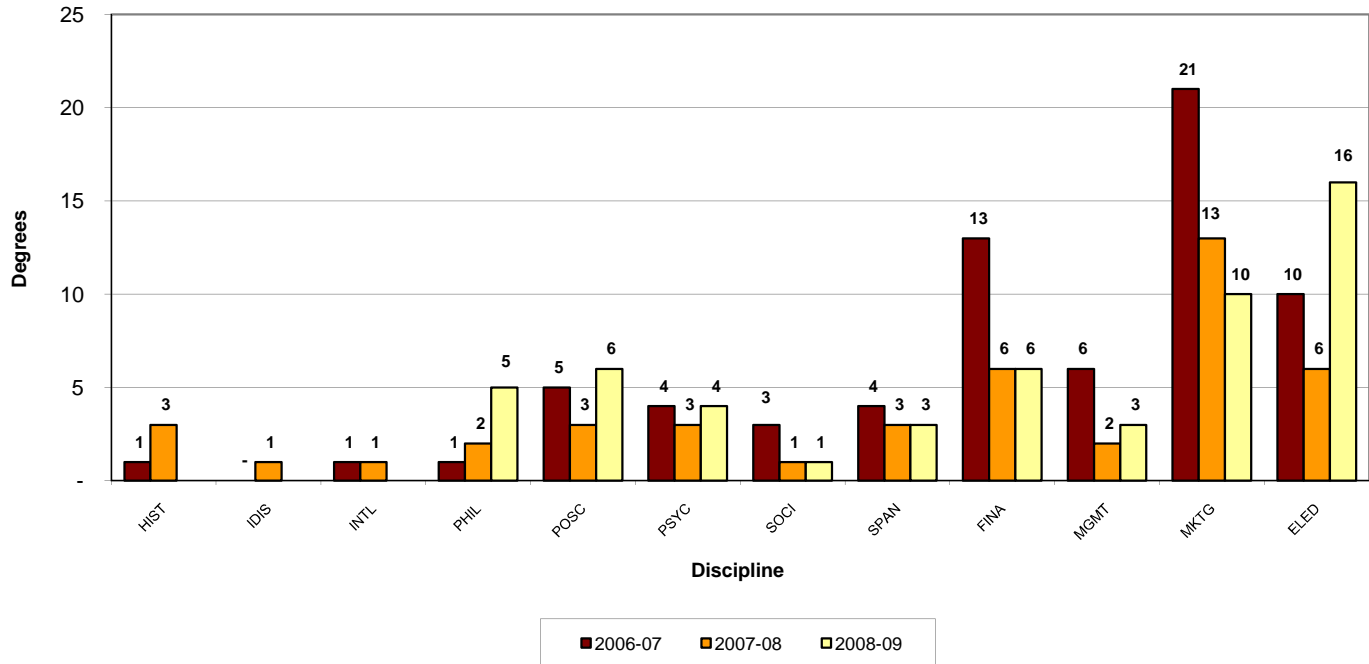

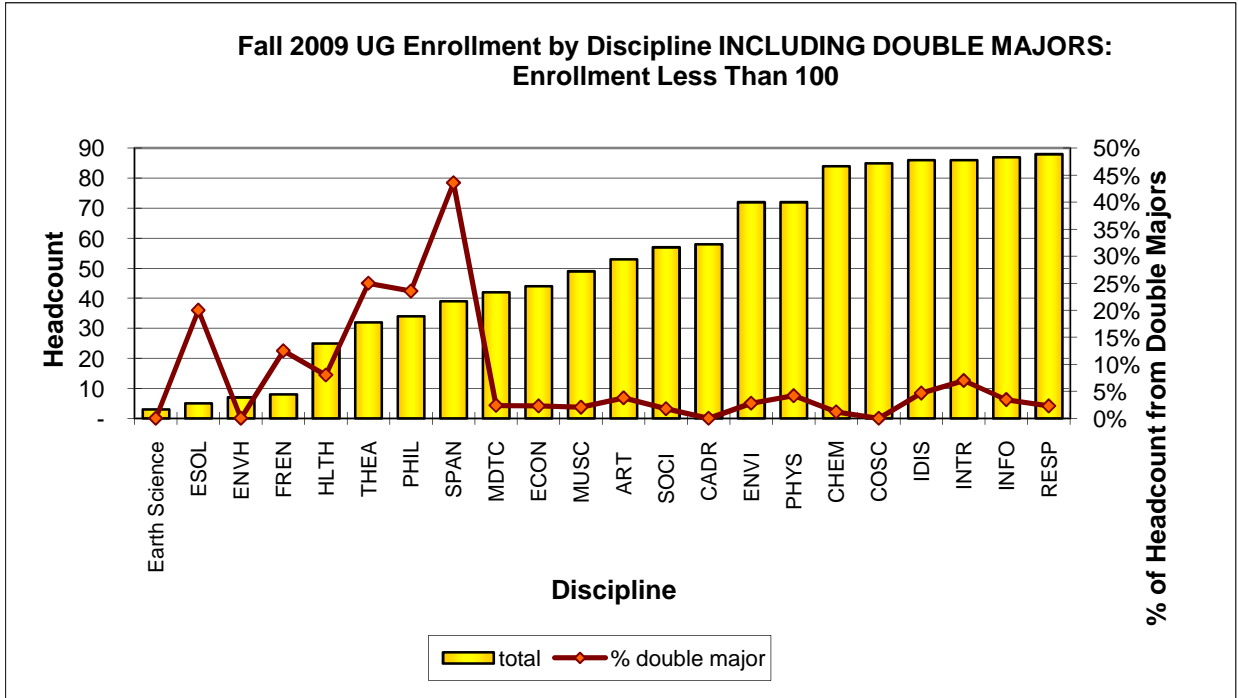
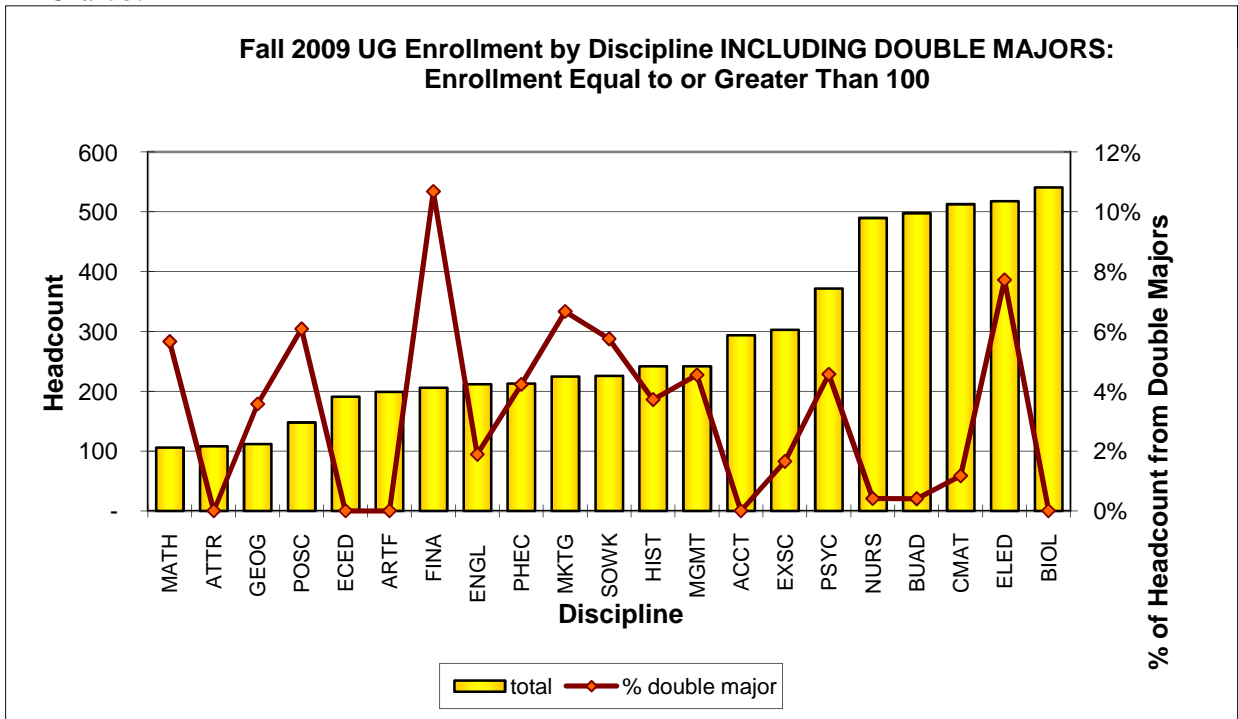

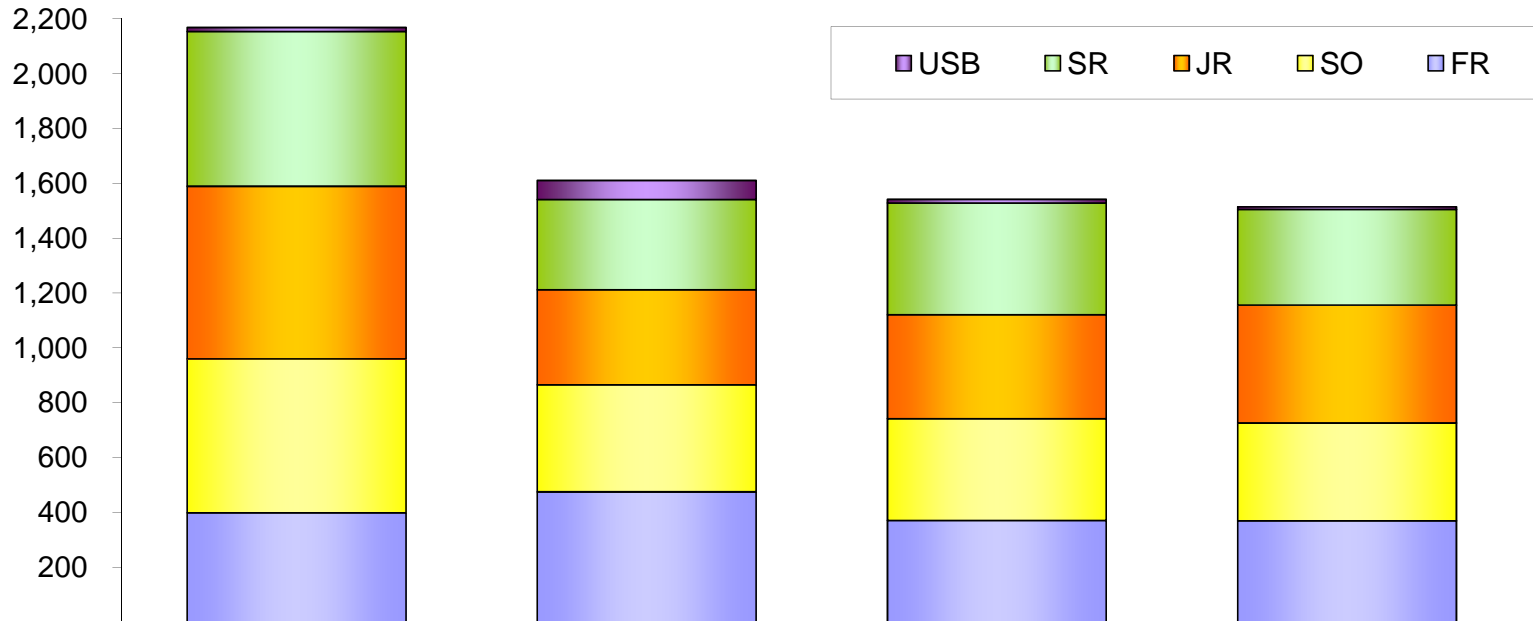

Fulton School Matriculated Undergraduates by Residence

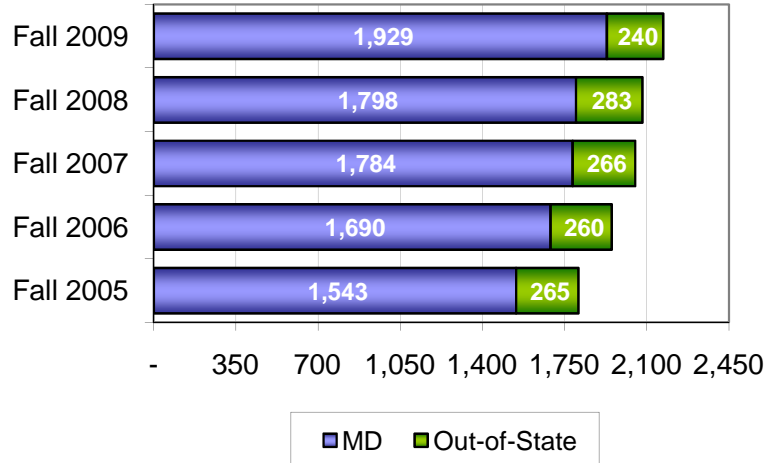
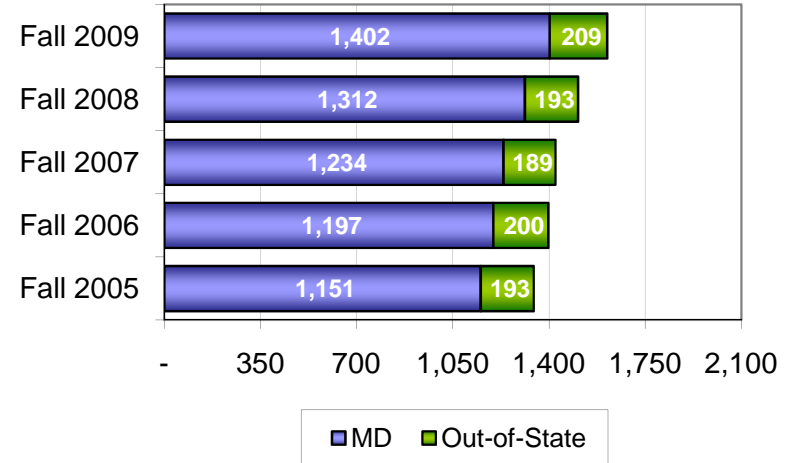

Perdue School Matriculated Undergraduates by Residence

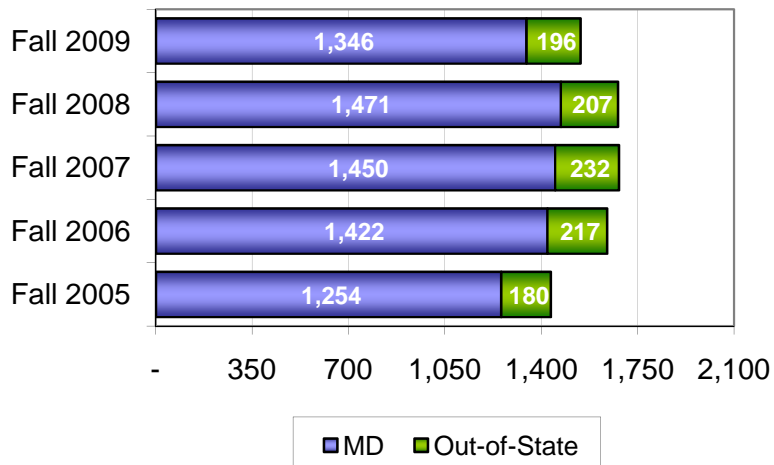
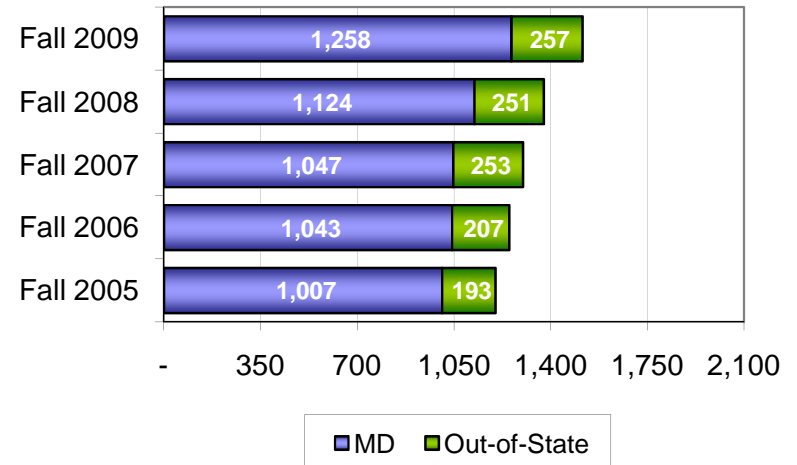

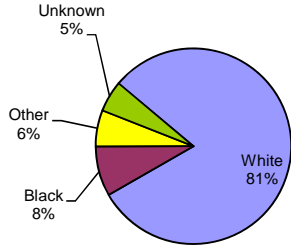

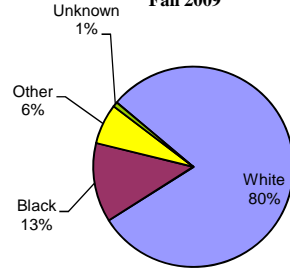
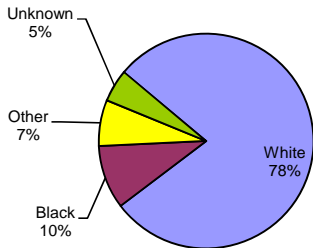

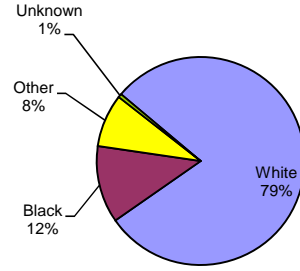
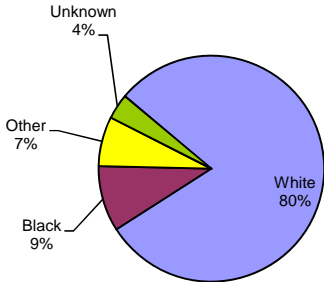

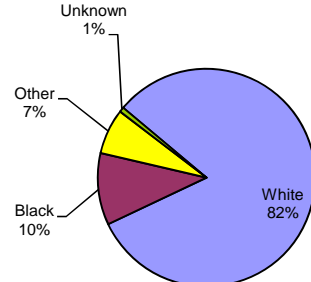
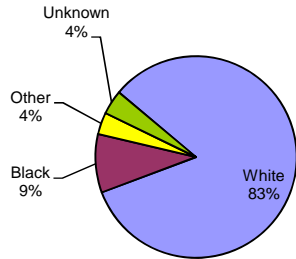

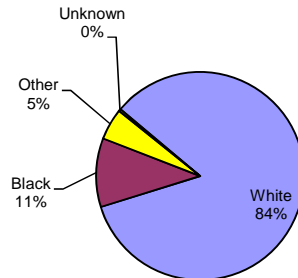

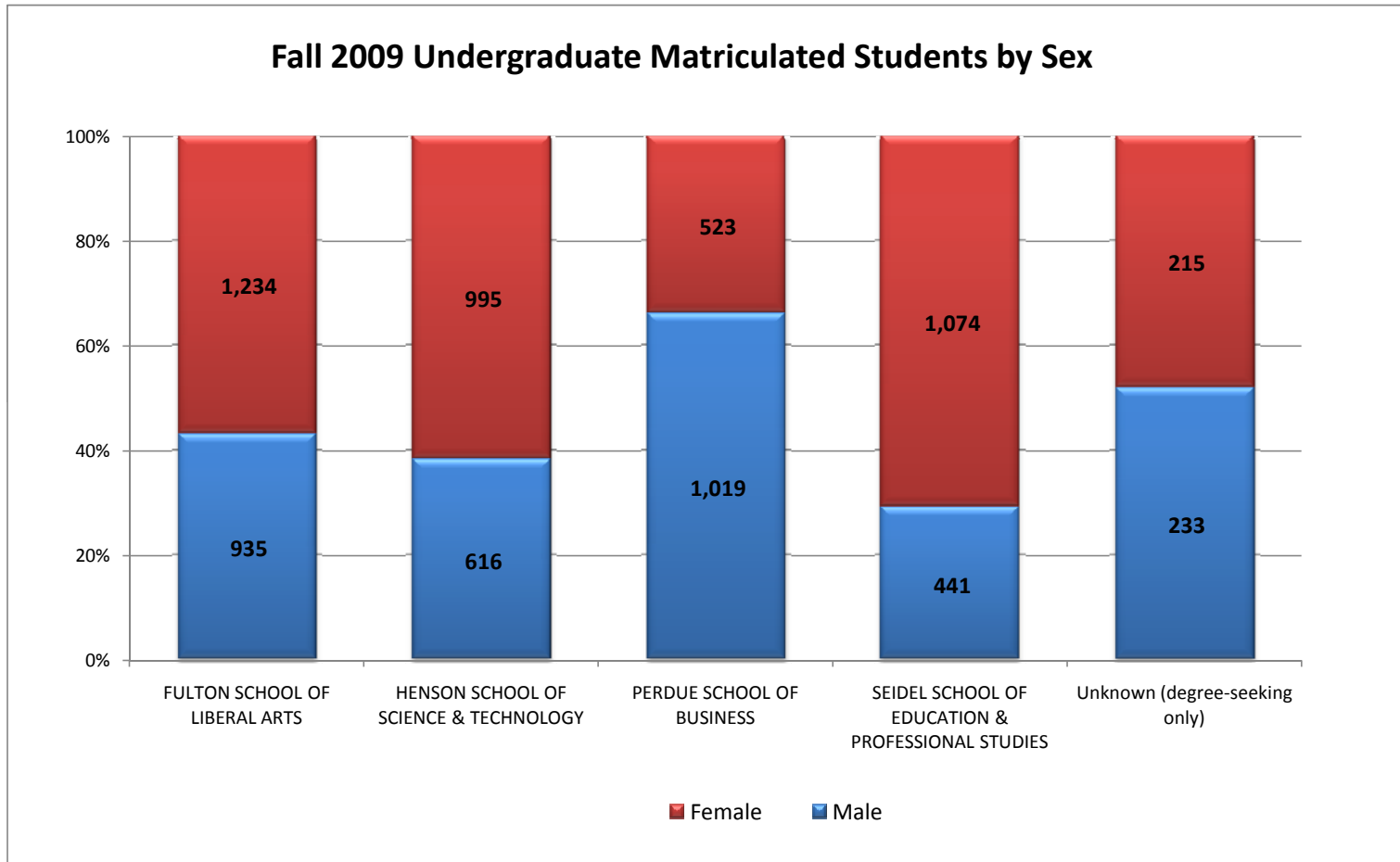

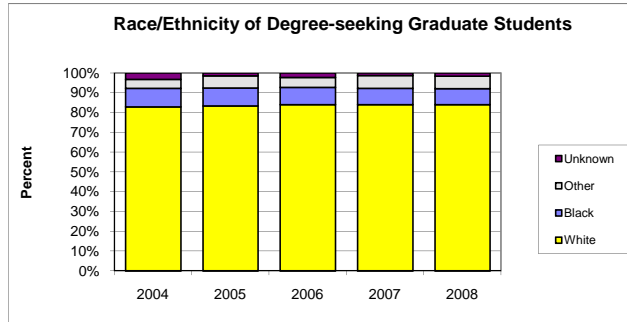
