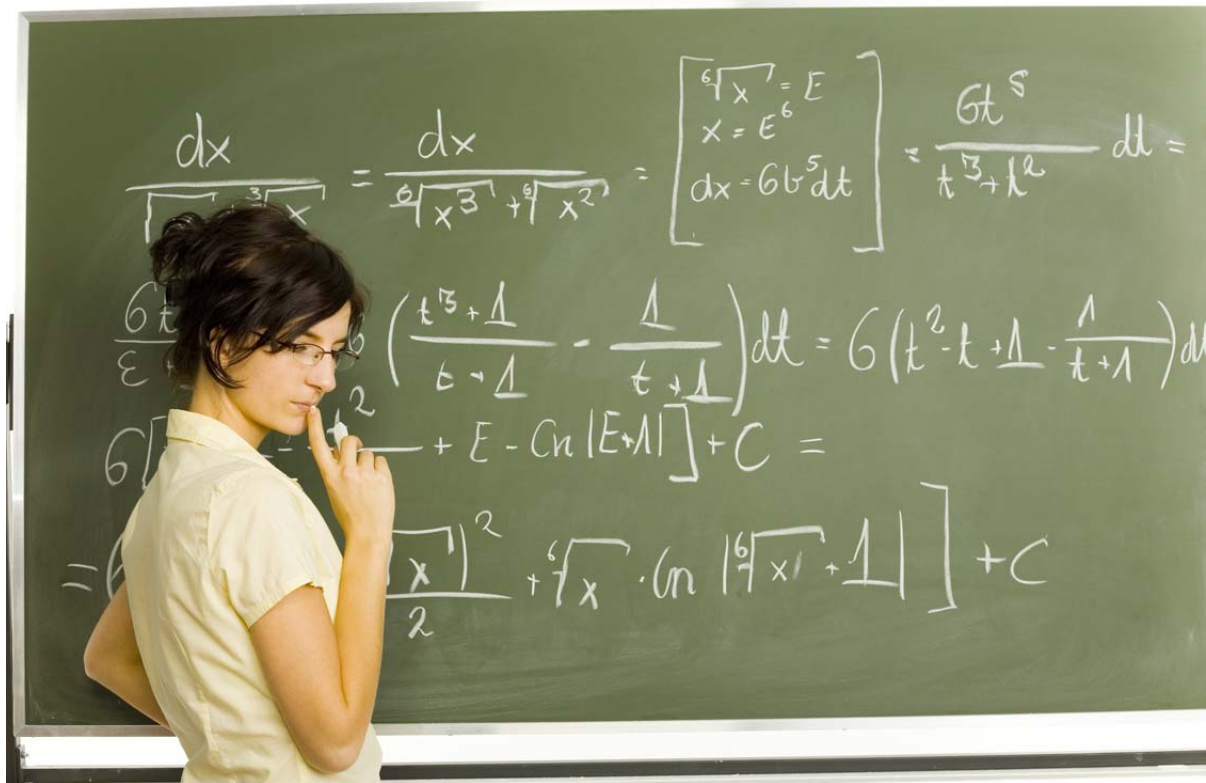

Degrees Awarded as Double Majors by School, AY 2003-04 through AY 2007-08

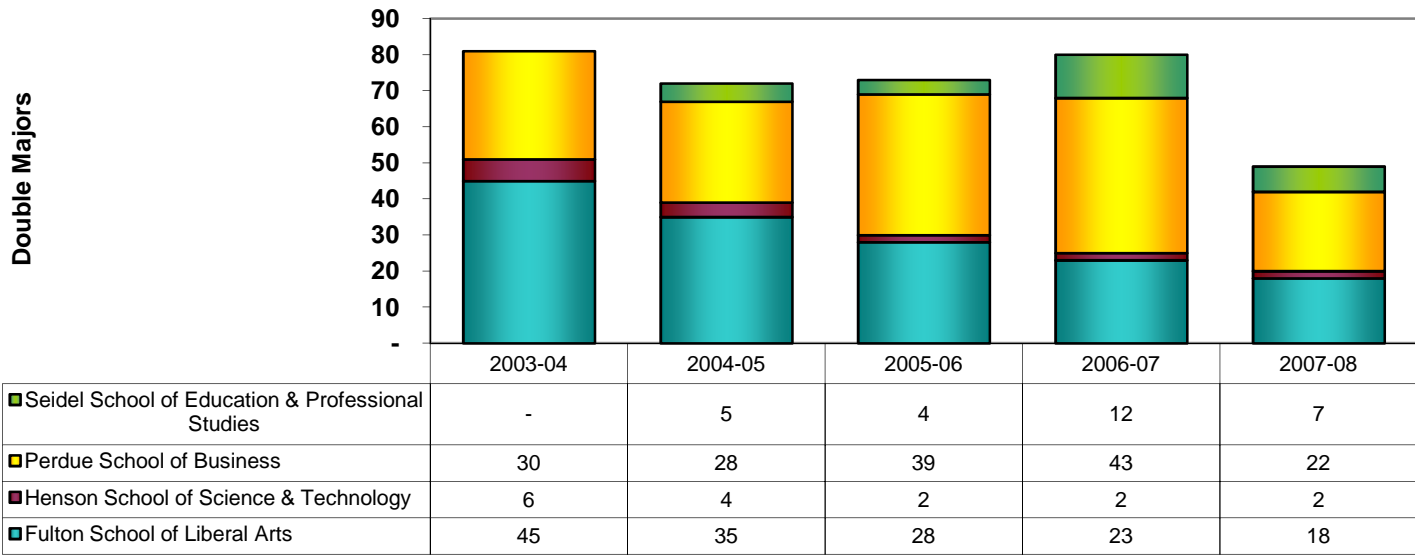

AY 2005-06 through AY 2007-08

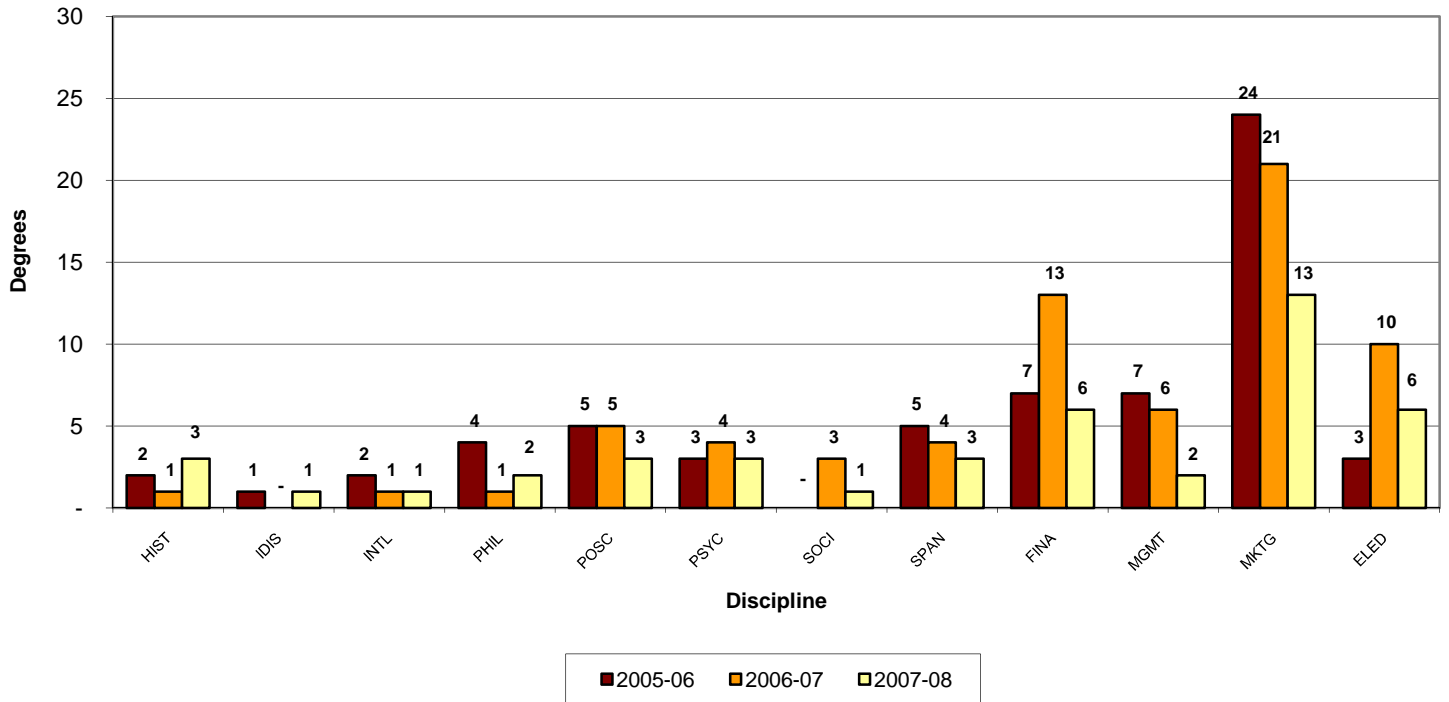

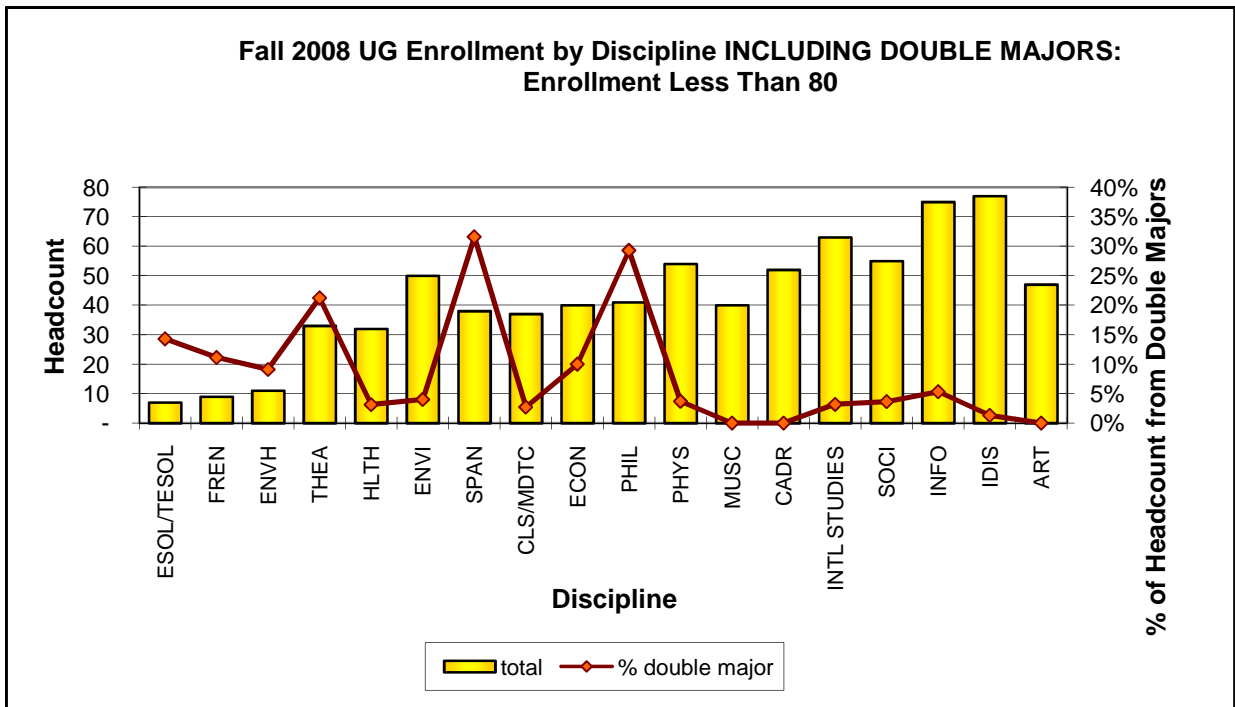
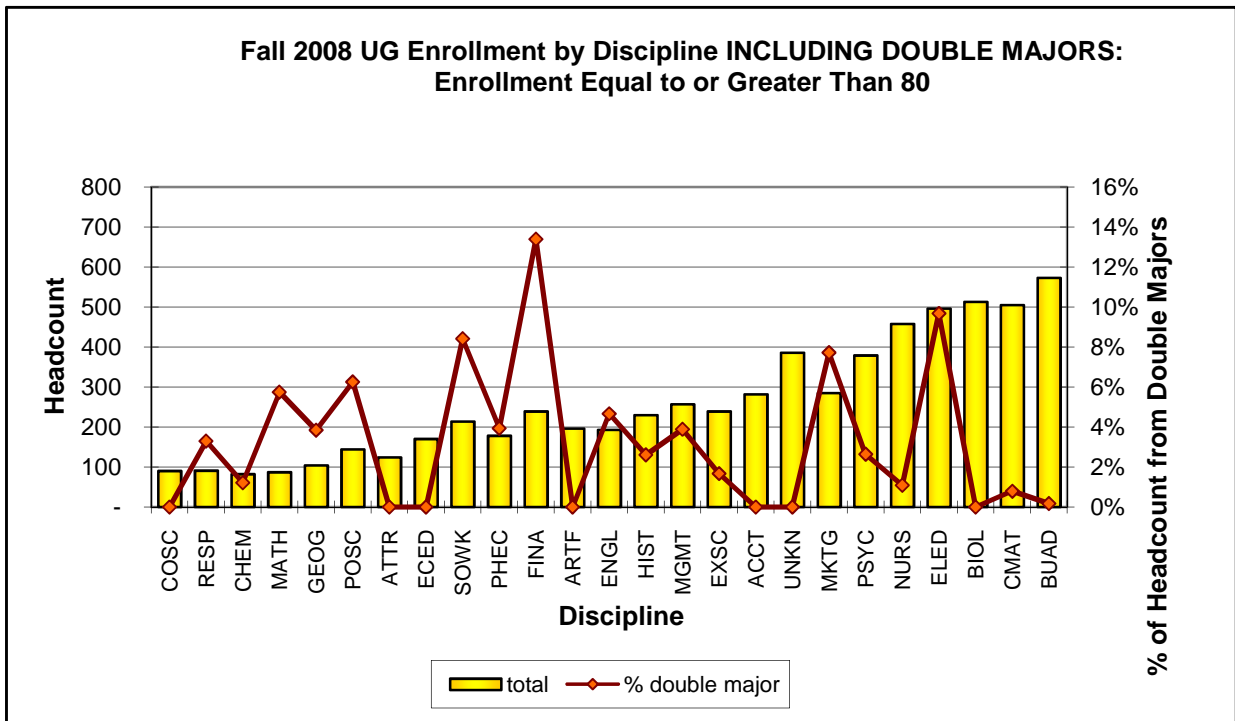

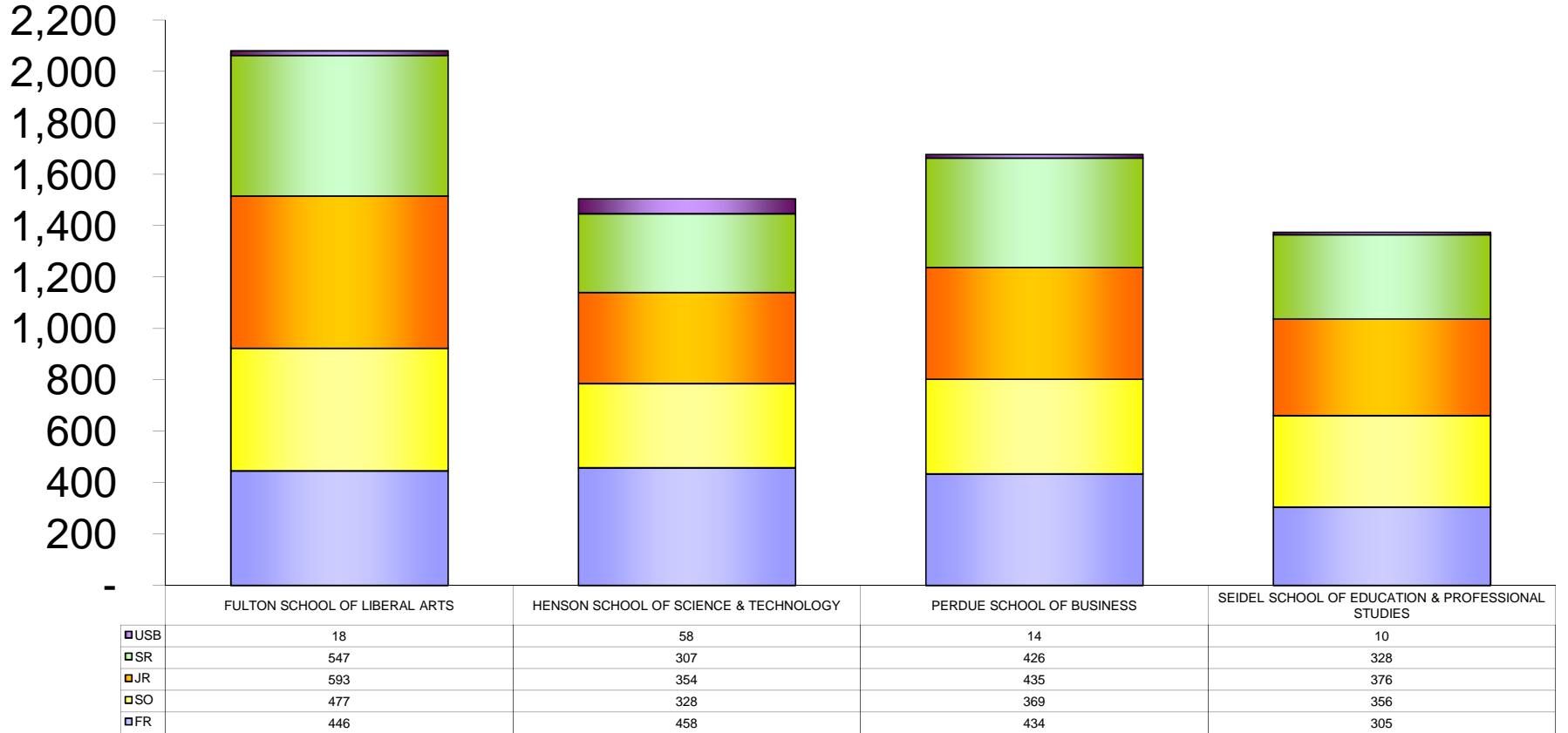

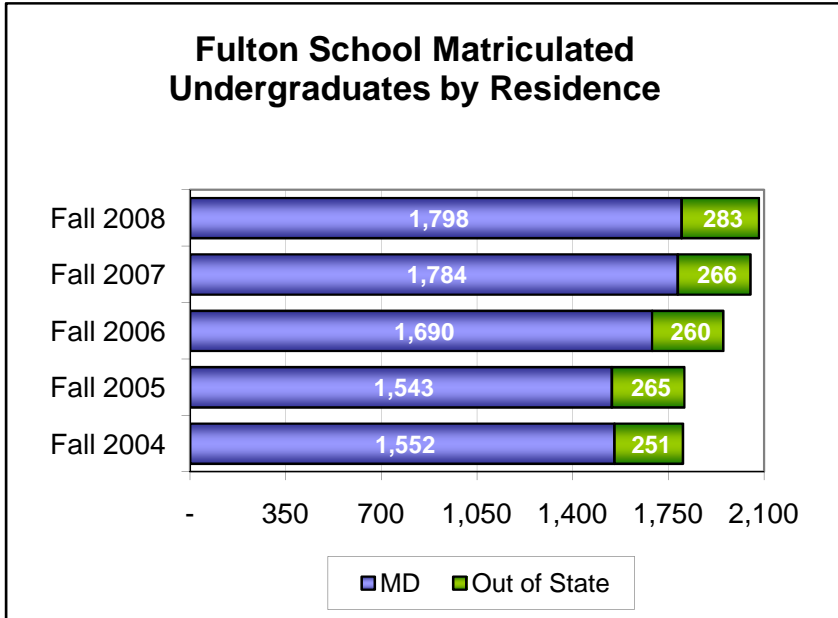

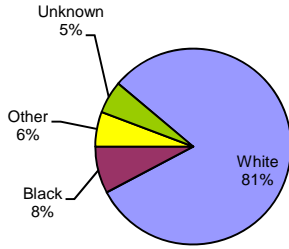

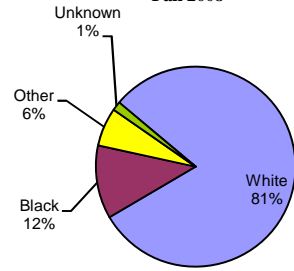
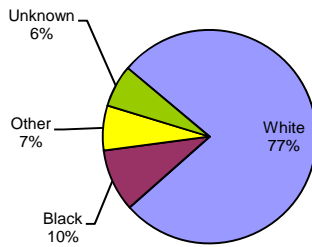

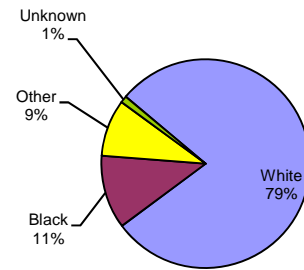
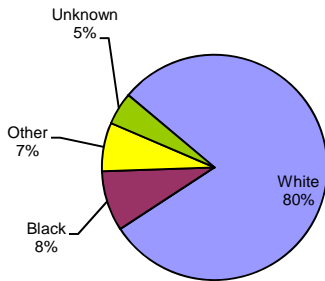

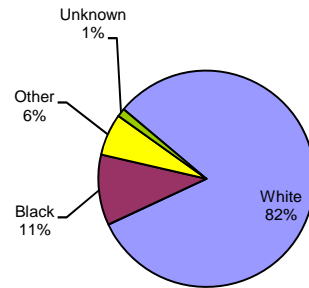
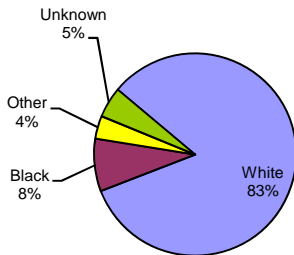

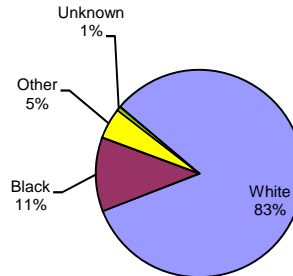

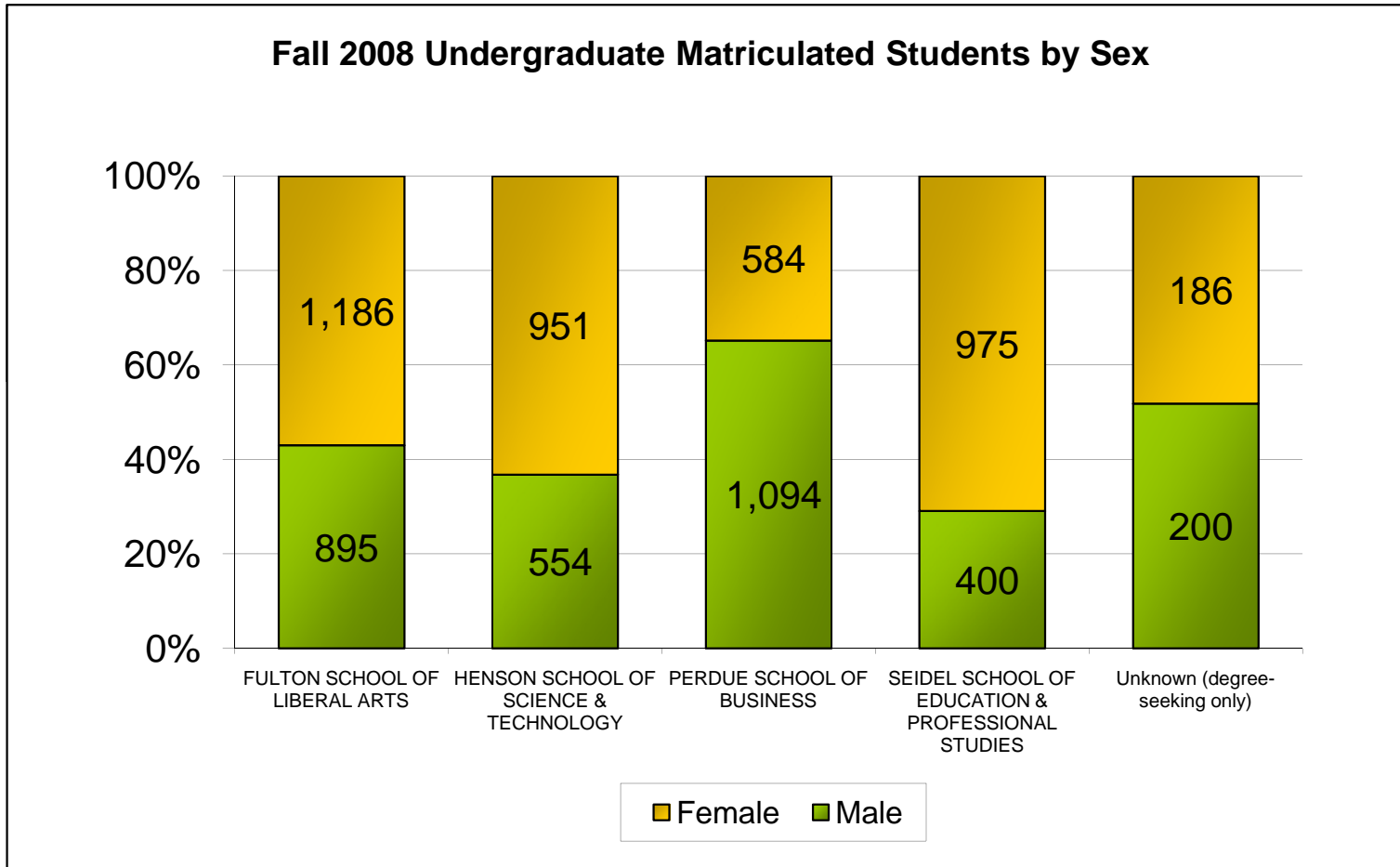

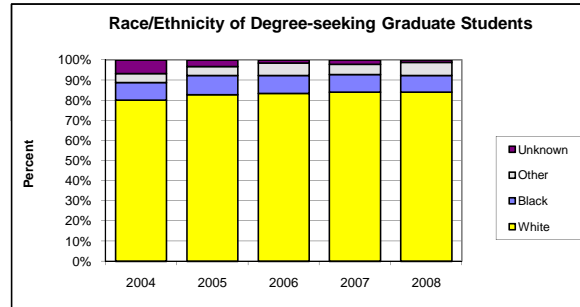
