DEFINITIONS

A location, other than a branch campus or additional location, at which the institution offers one or more courses for credit.

Yes or No indicates whether or not the institution has been approved to offer one or more degree certificate/diploma programs for which students could meet 50% or more of their requirements by taking distance learning courses.
