Full-Time and Part-Time Institutional Enrollment: 1999, 2005-2009

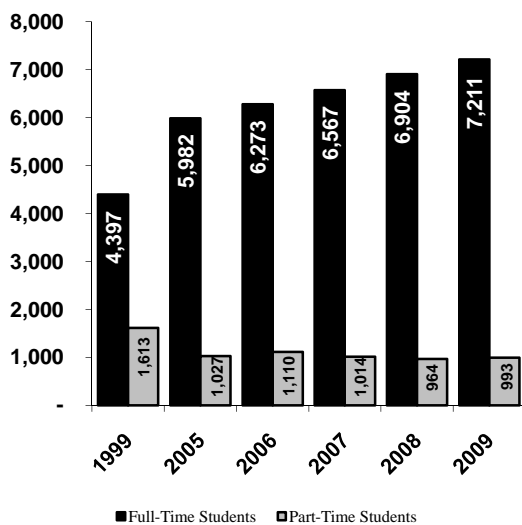
