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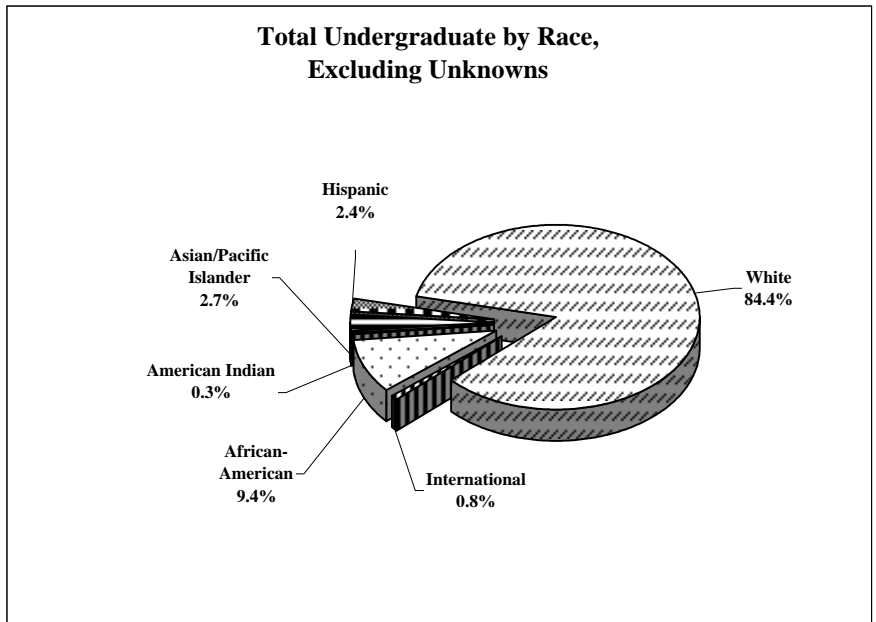
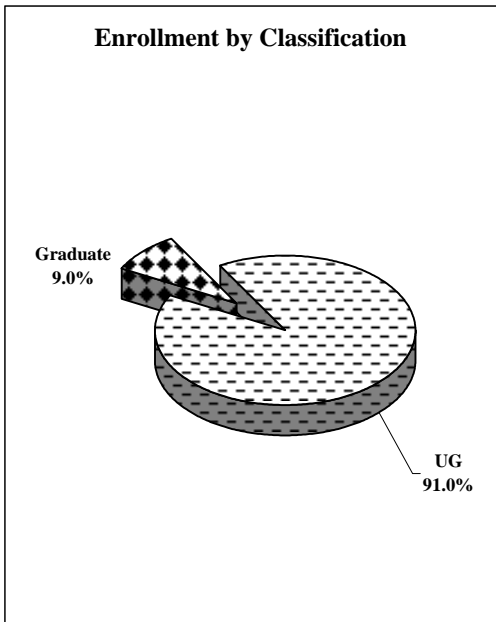

Total Institutional Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity, Sex, and Status: Spring 2004

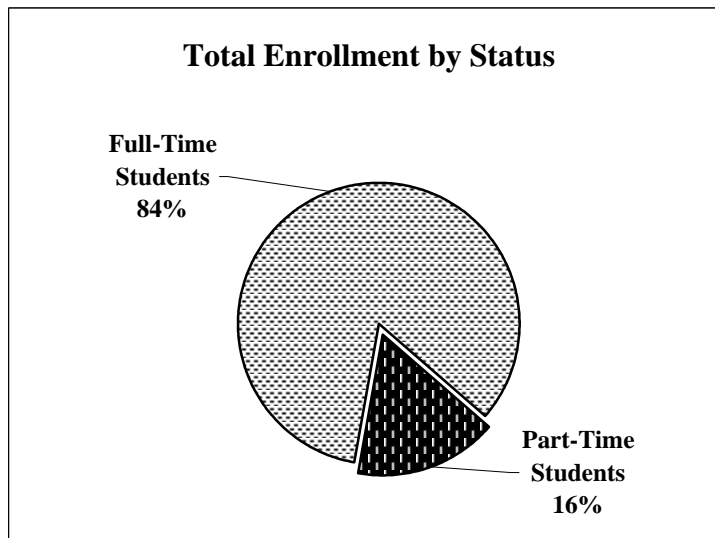
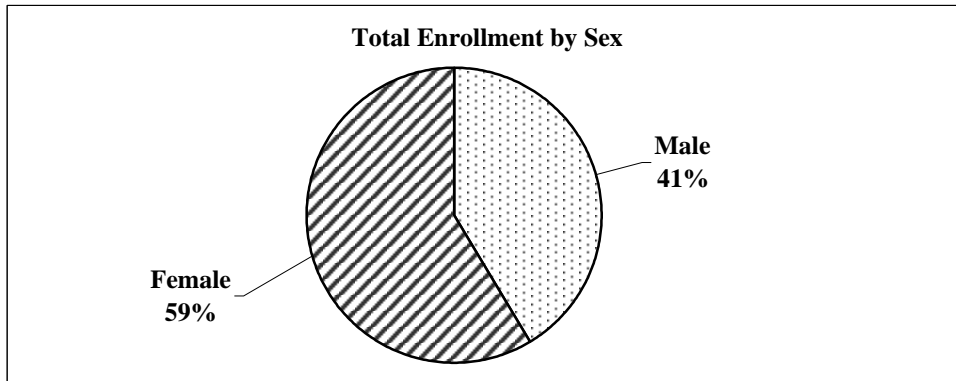

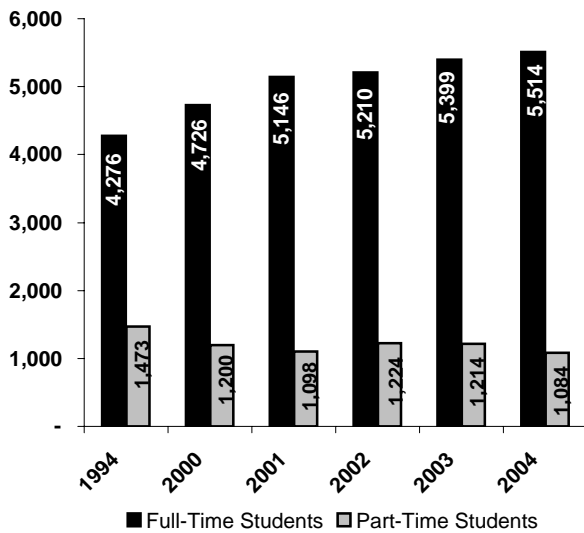

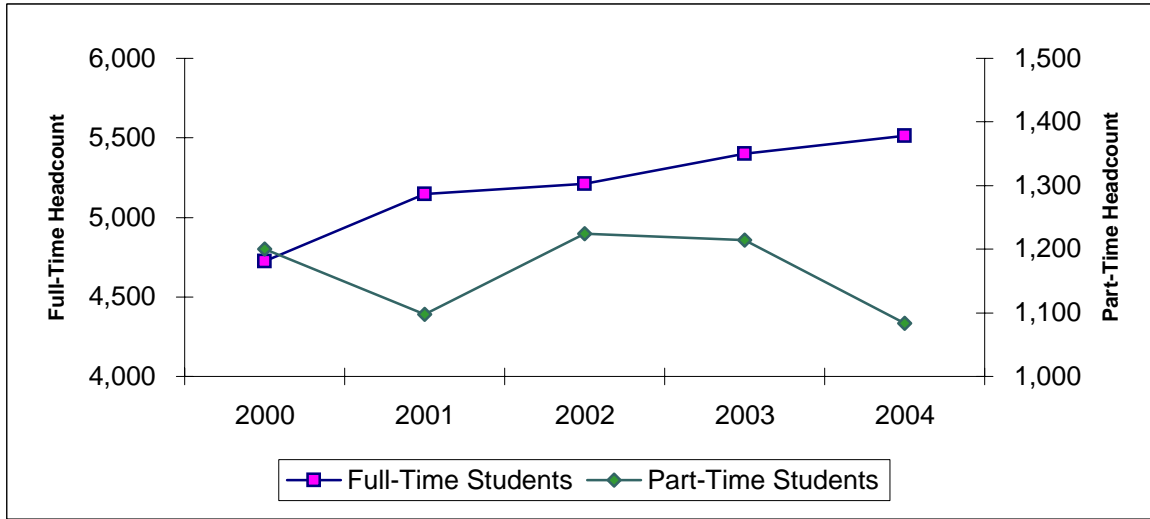

Institutional Enrollment: 1994, 2000-2004**



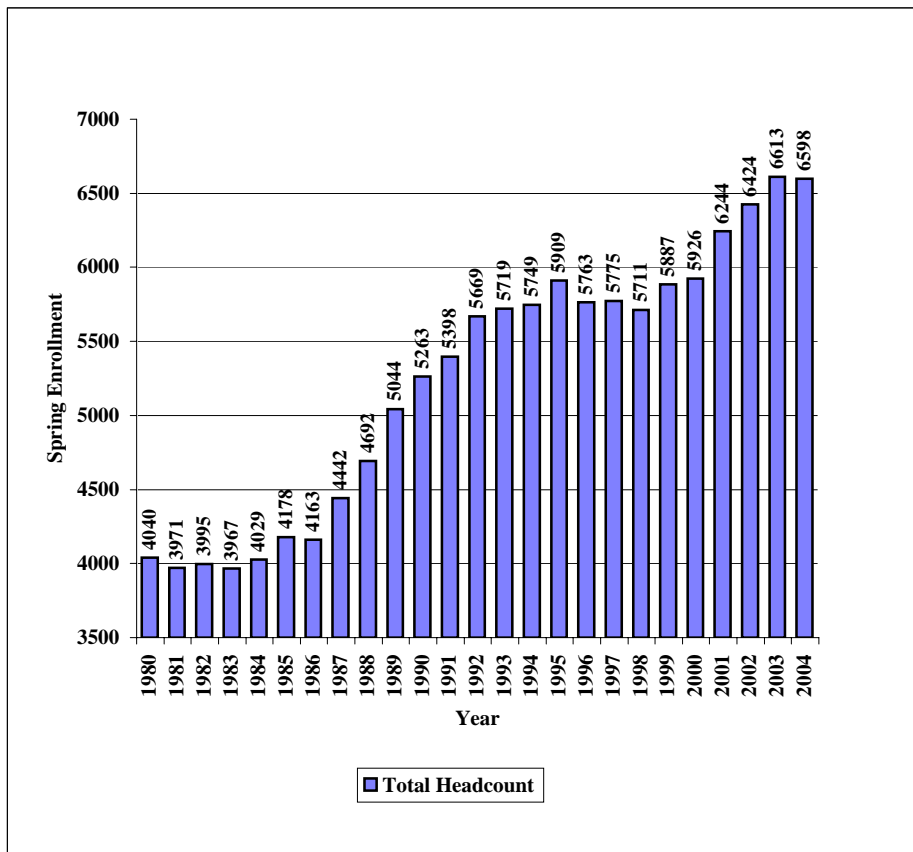
**Percent Full-Time

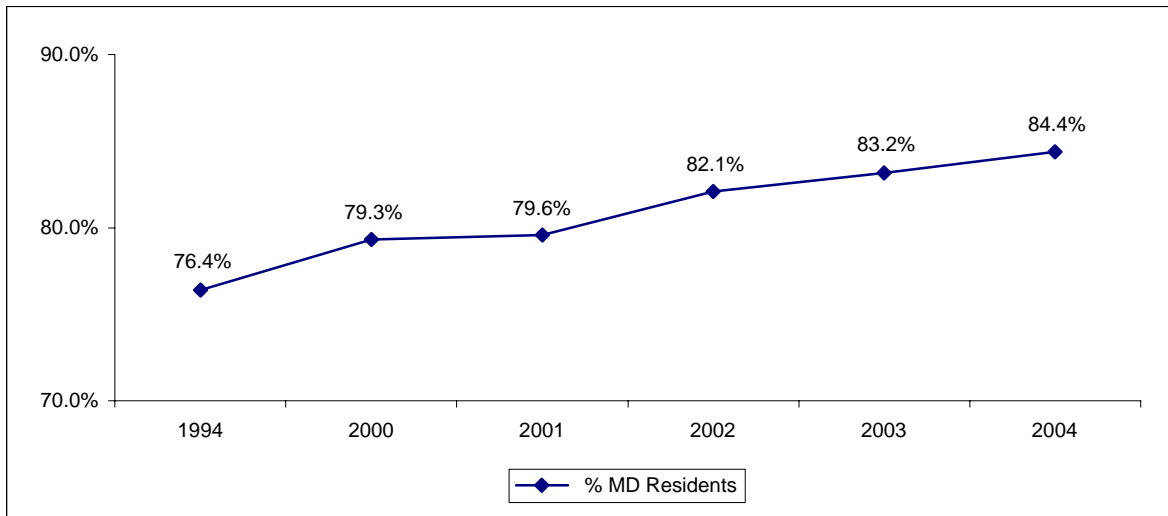

Total Institutional Enrollment: Percent In-State - 1994, 2000-2004



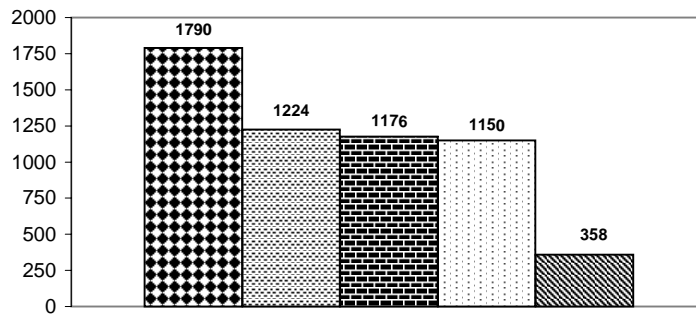

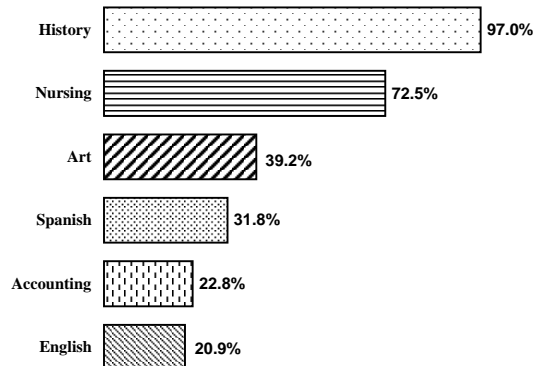

Undergraduate Enrollment by School

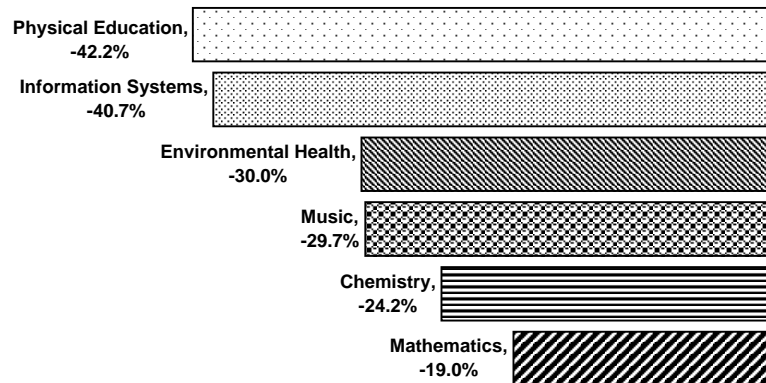

Undergraduate Programs Revealing Largest Percentile Growth in Enrollment Since Spring 2000 (excludes programs with traditionally low enrollments)



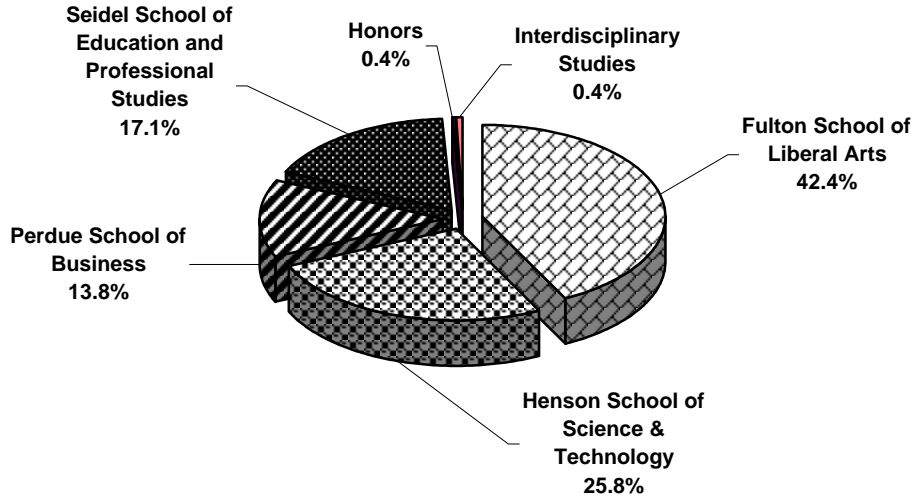
Undergraduate Programs Revealing Largest Percentile Decline in Enrollment Since Spring 2000 (excludes programs with traditionally low enrollments)



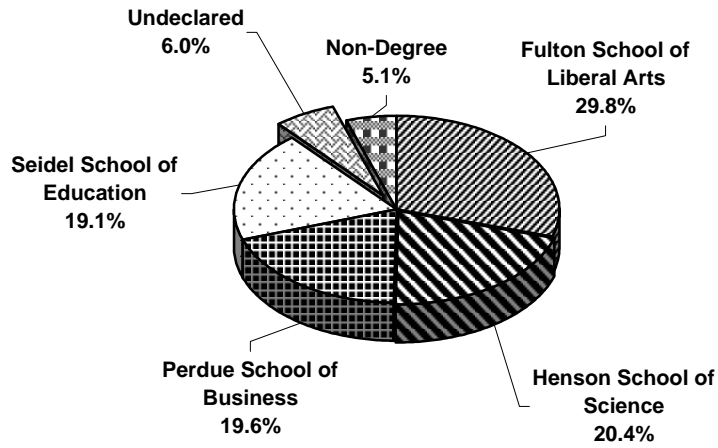

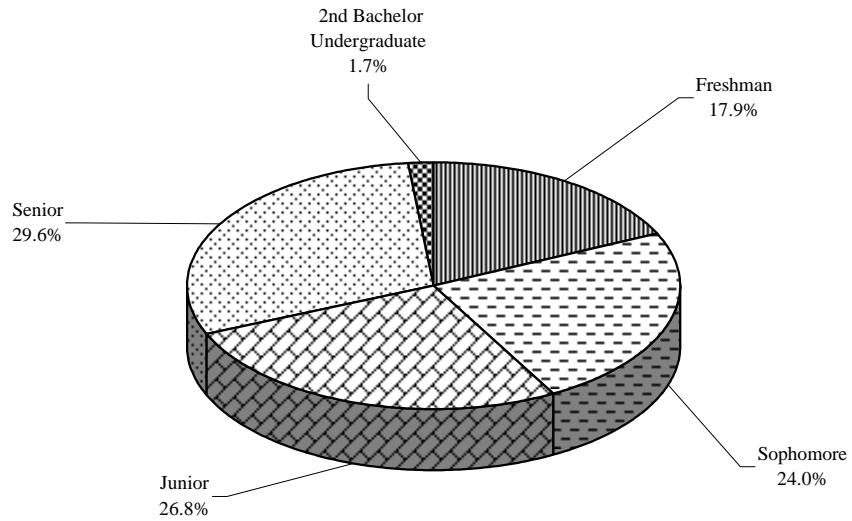

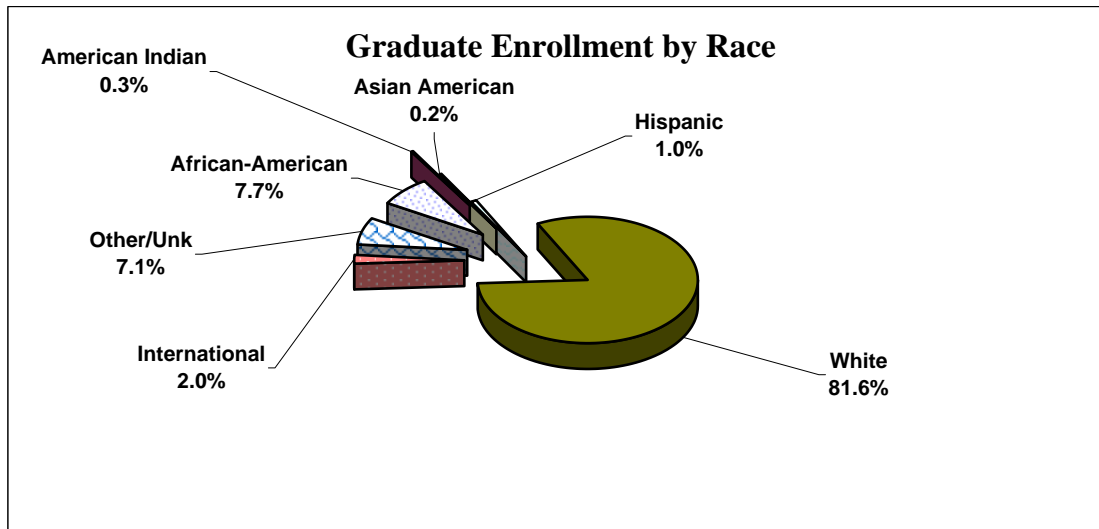
