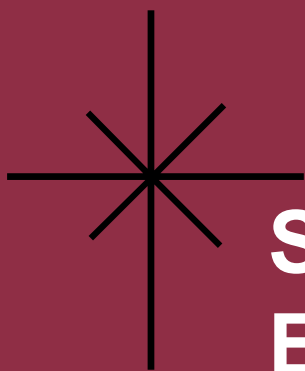

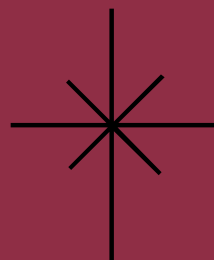

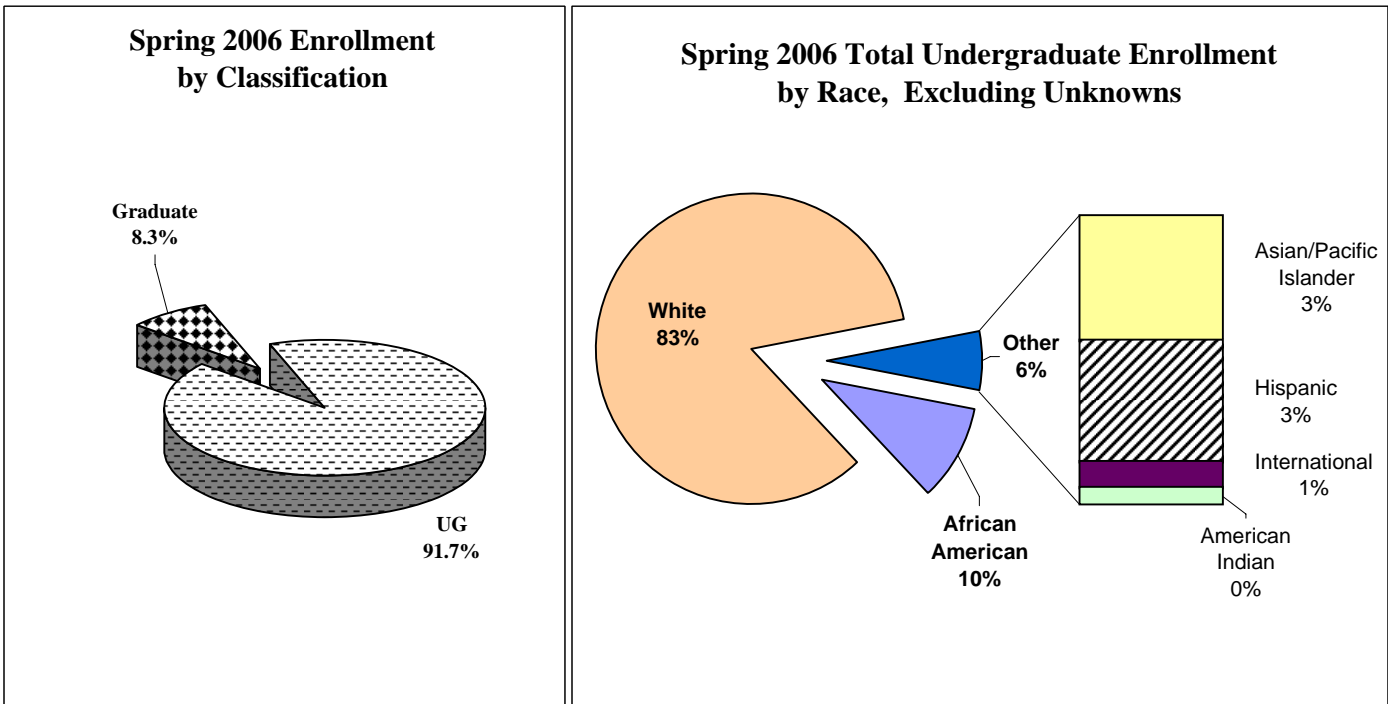

Total Institutional Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity, Sex, and Status: Spring 2005

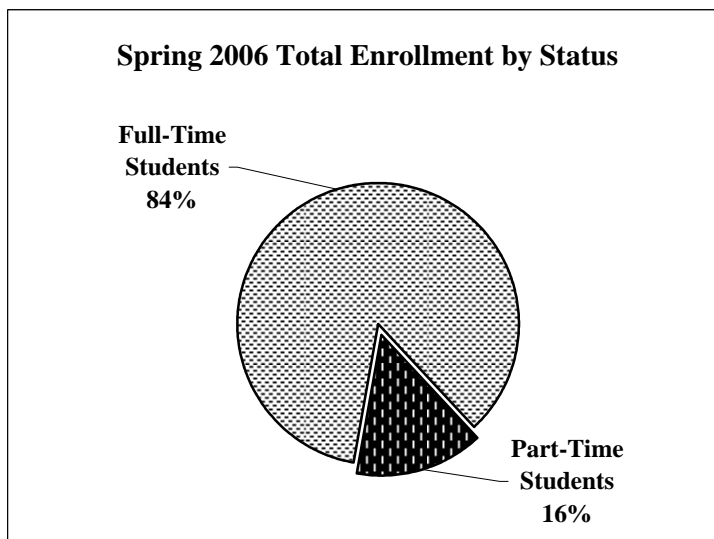
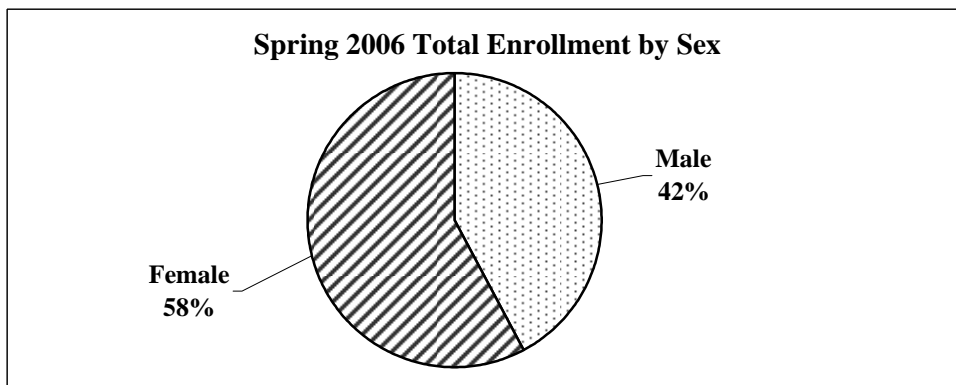

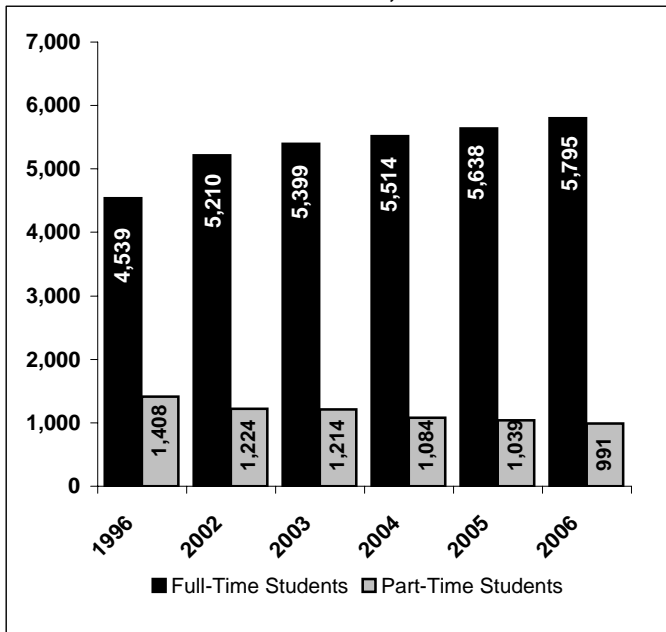

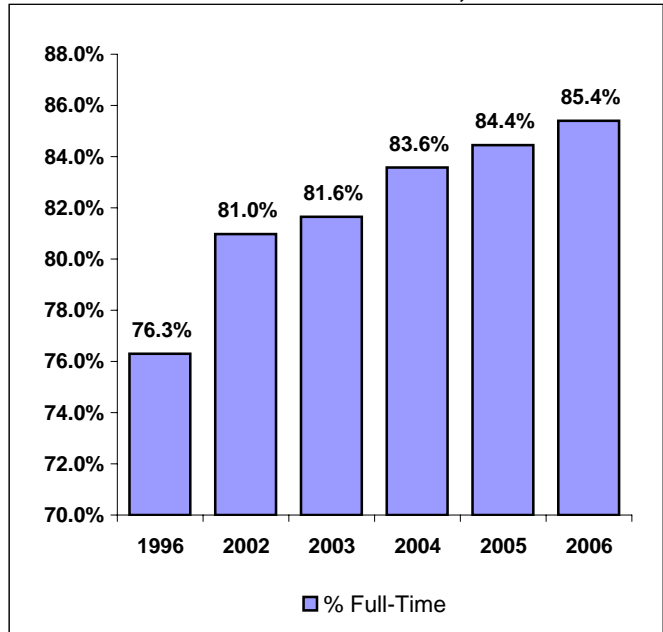

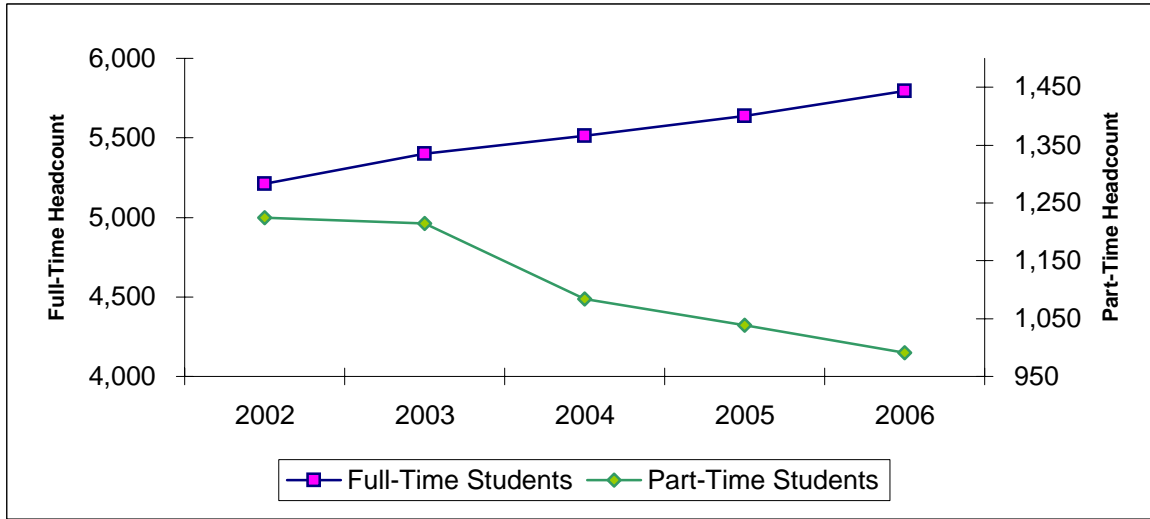
Full-Time and Part-Time Institutional Enrollment: 1996, 2002-2006



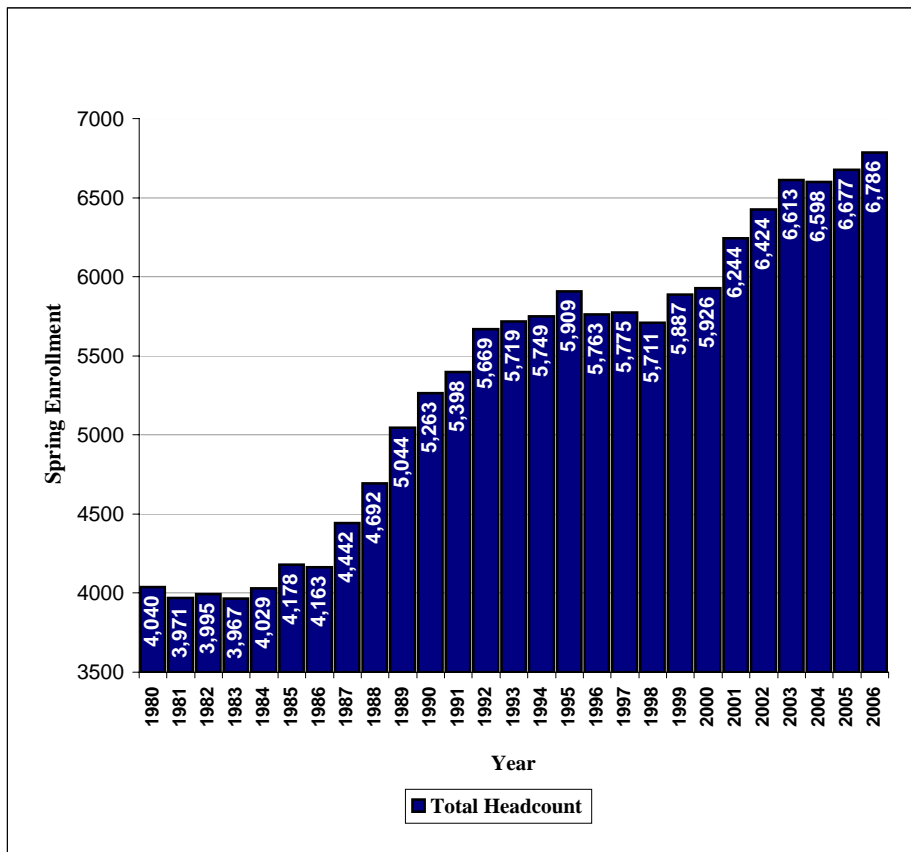
Percent Full-Time Institutional Enrollment: 1996, 2002-2006

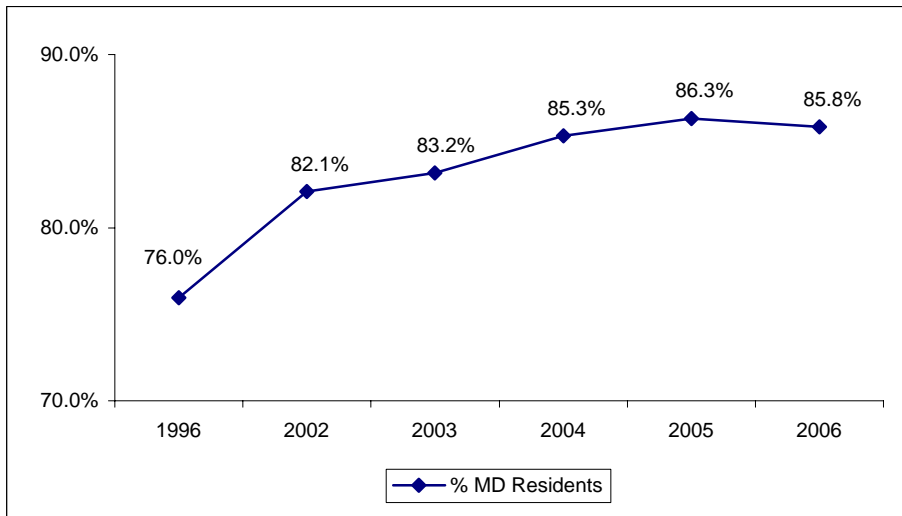

Total Institutional Enrollment: Percent In-State: 1996, 2002-2006



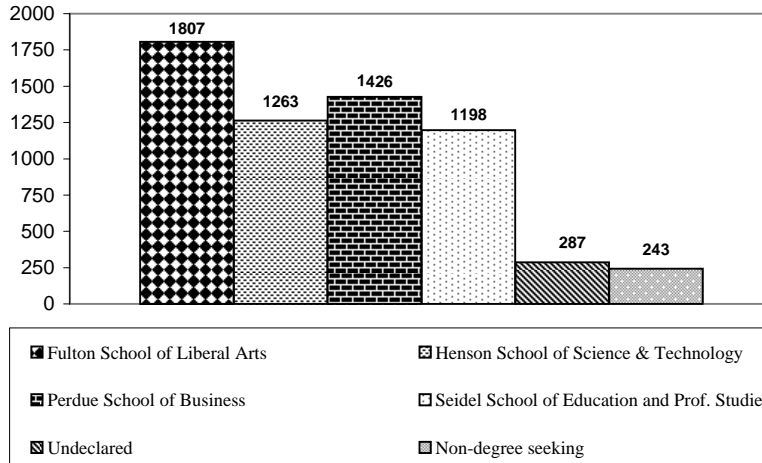

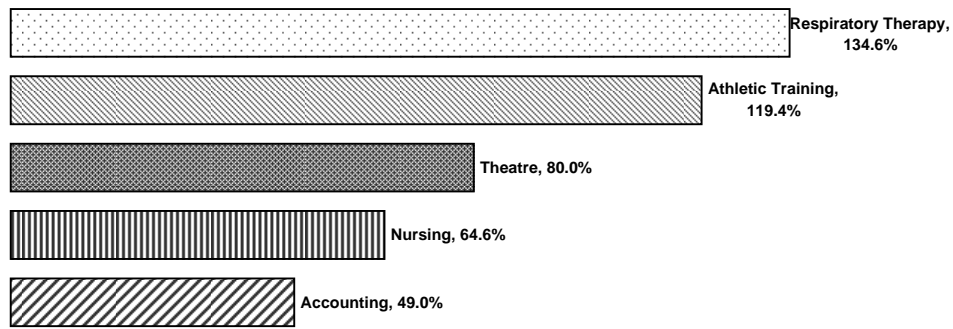

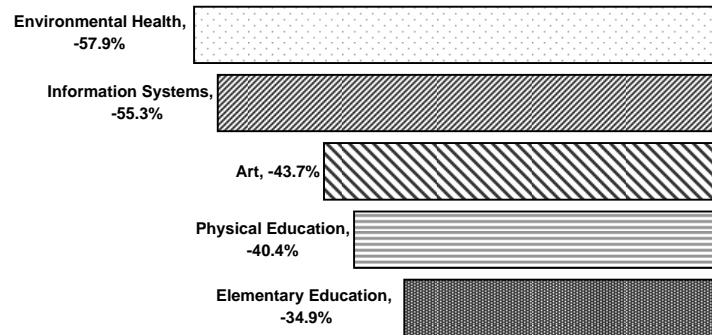
Spring 2006 Undergraduate Enrollment by School

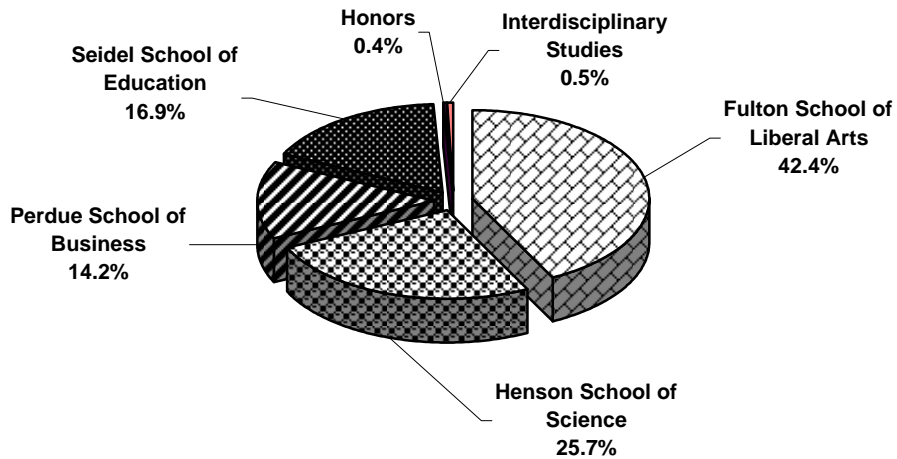

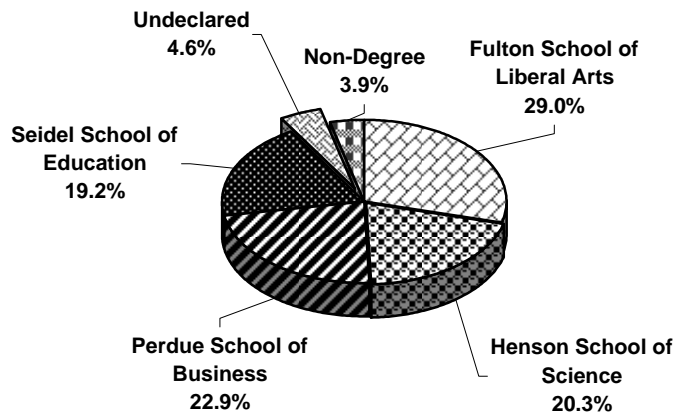

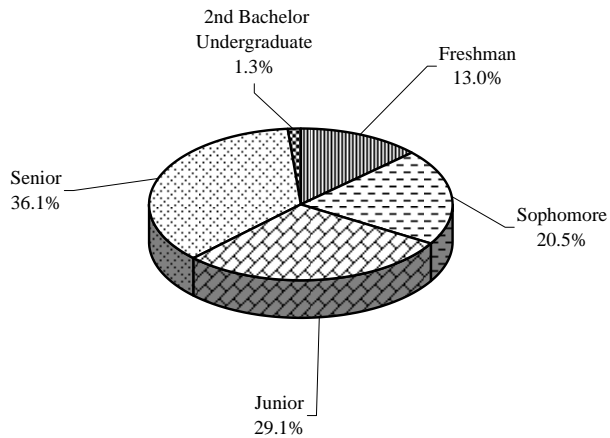
