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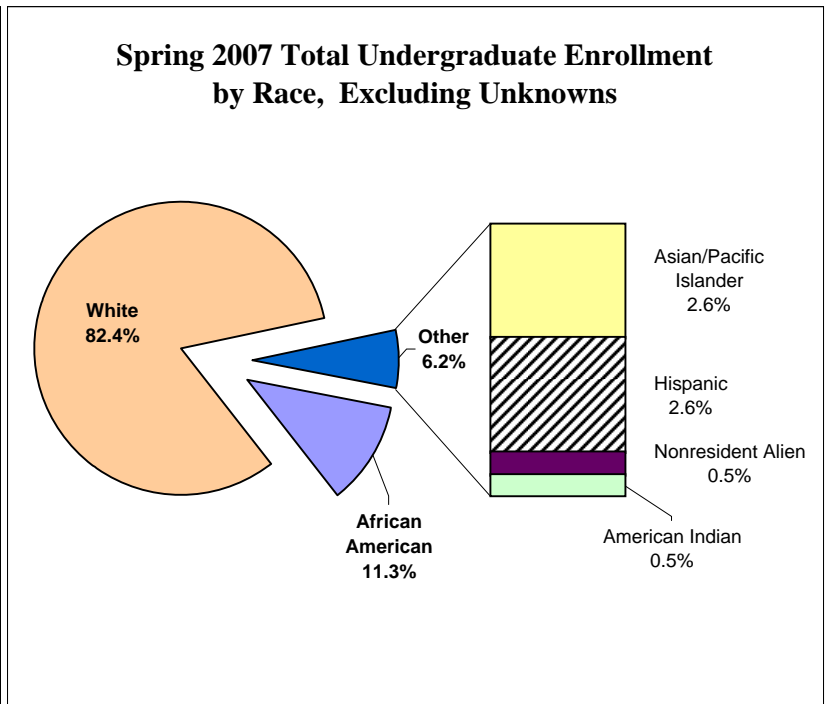
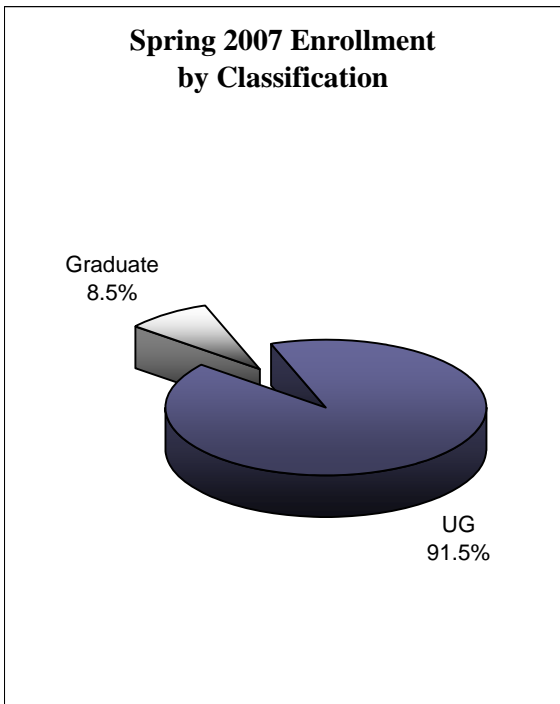

**Total Institutional Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity, Sex, and Status: Spring 2007**

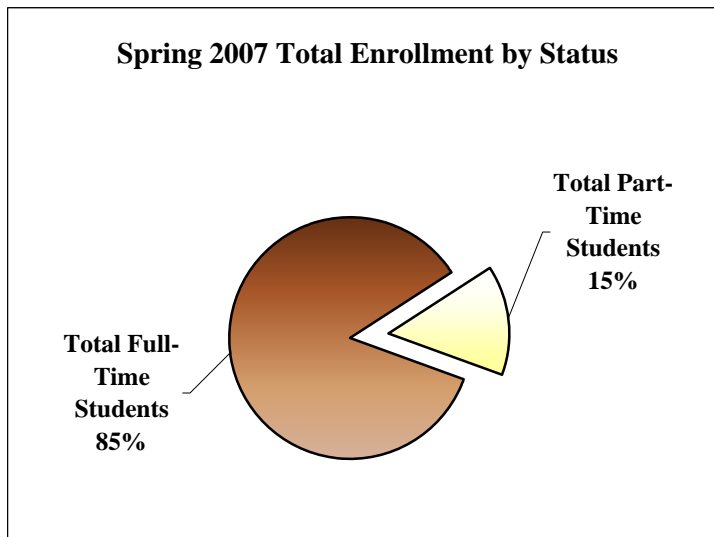
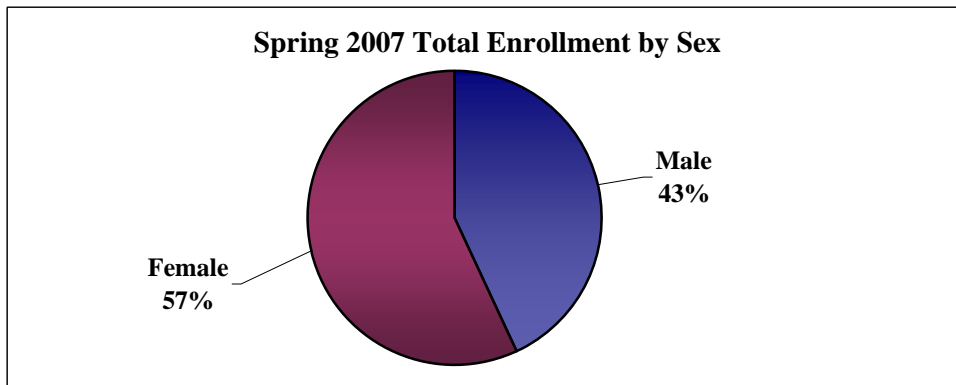

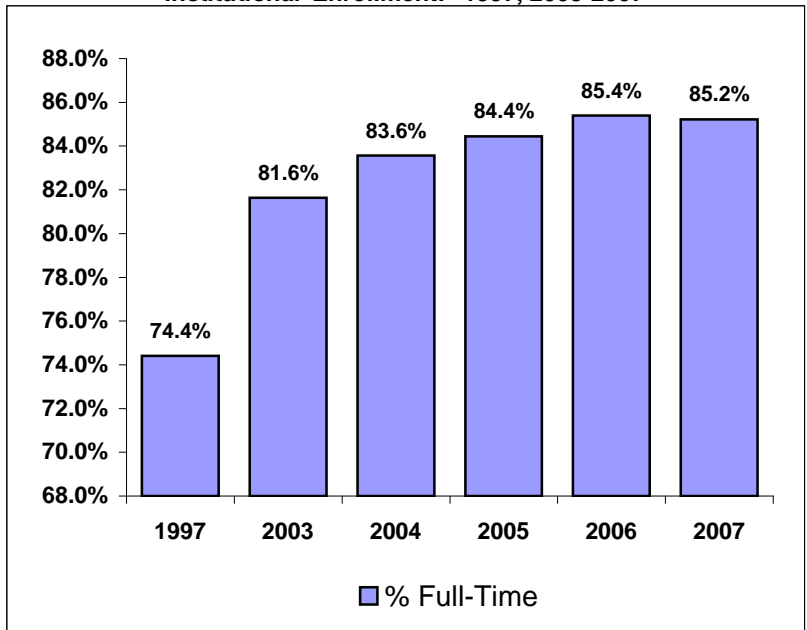

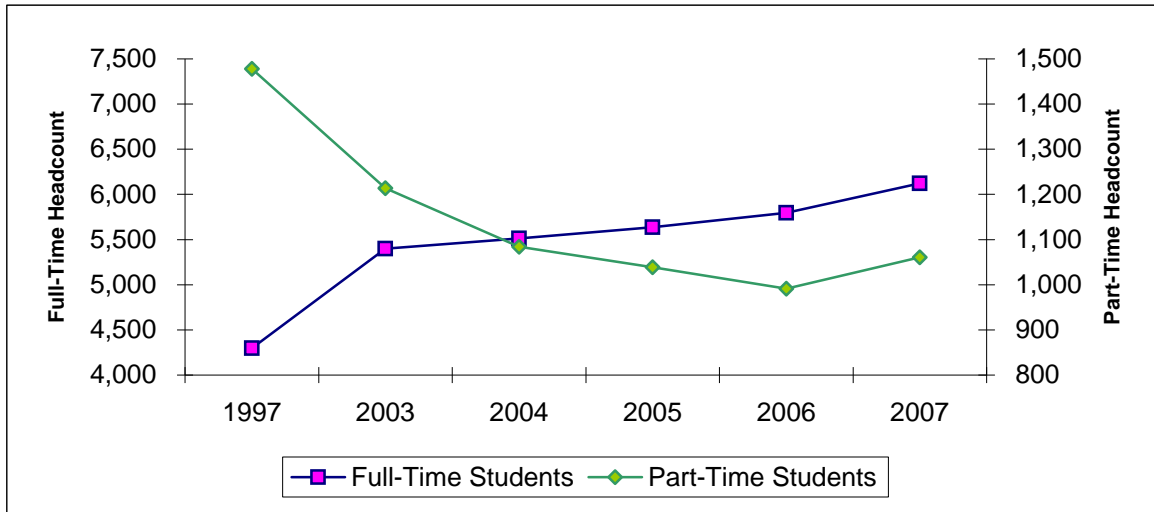
**Full-Time and Part-Time  
Institutional Enrollment: 1997, 2003-2007**



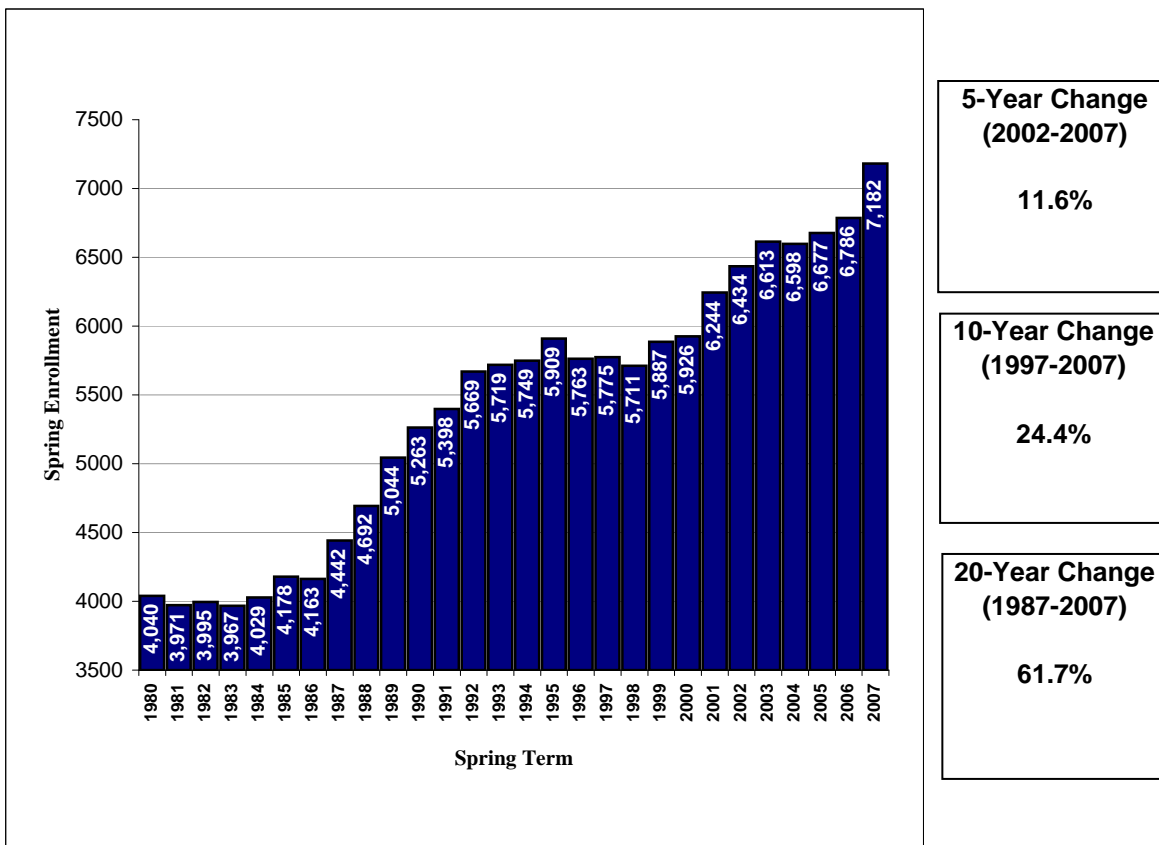
**Percent Full-Time

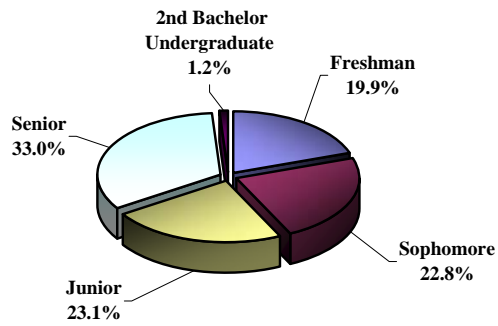

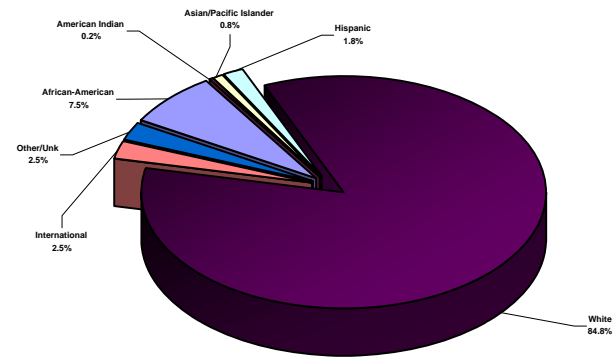

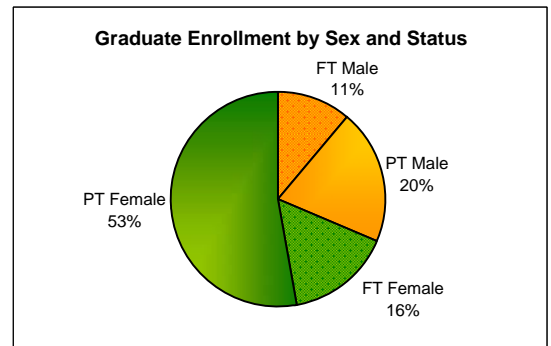
