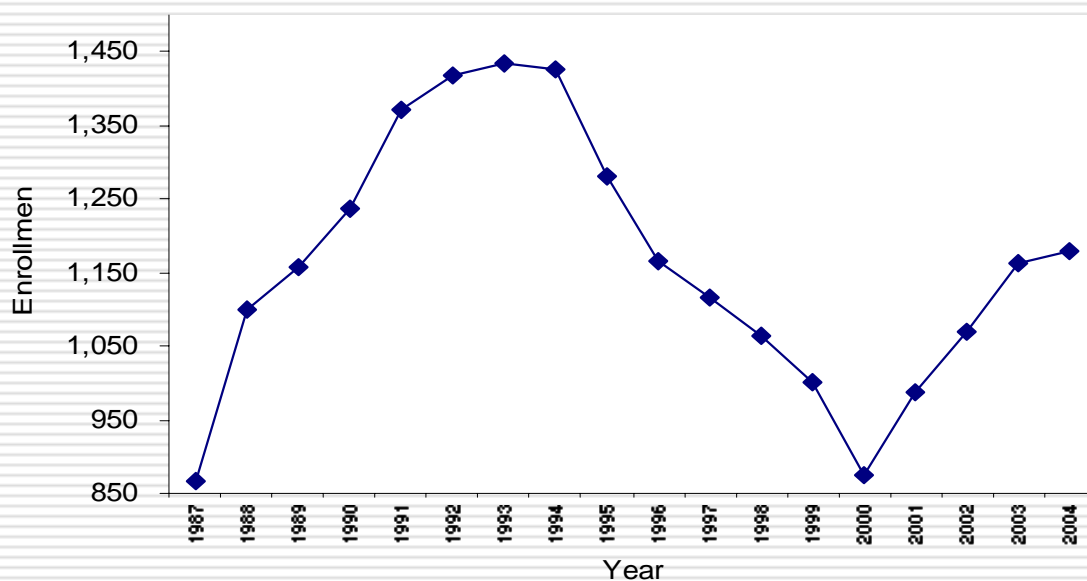

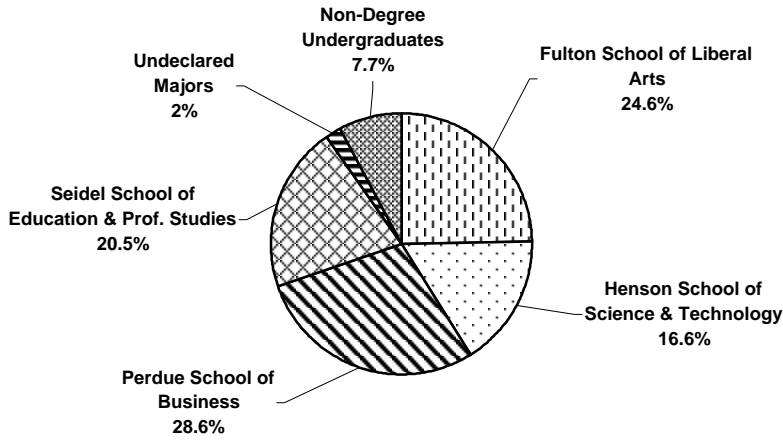

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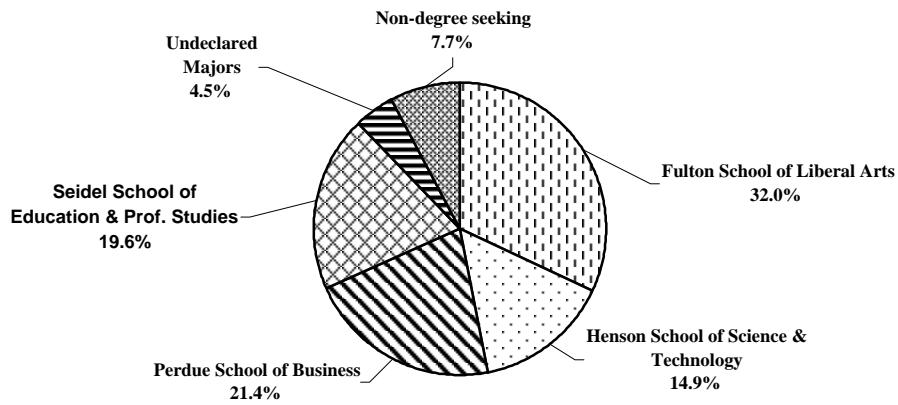

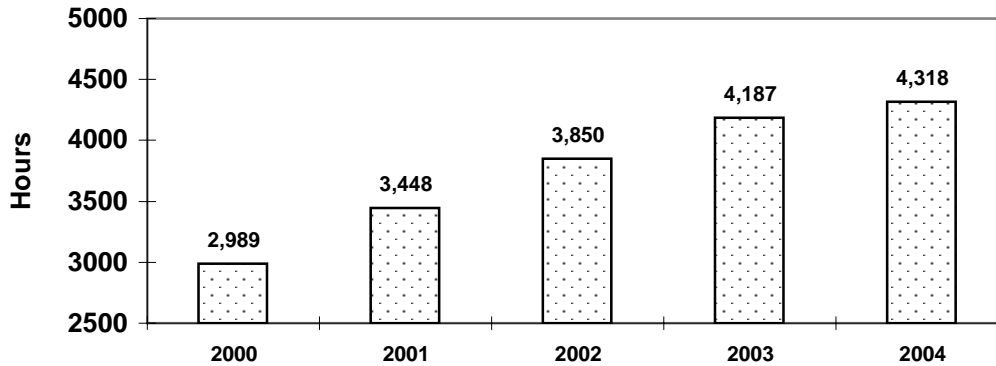
UG Enrollment by School: Winter 2000

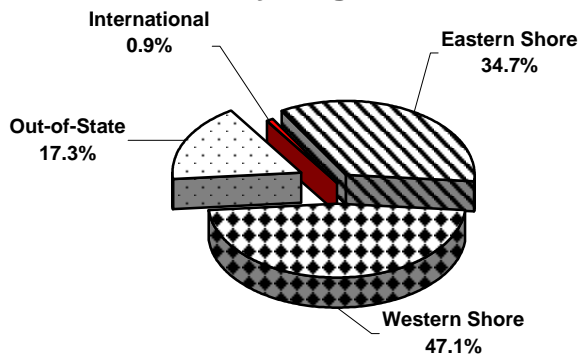

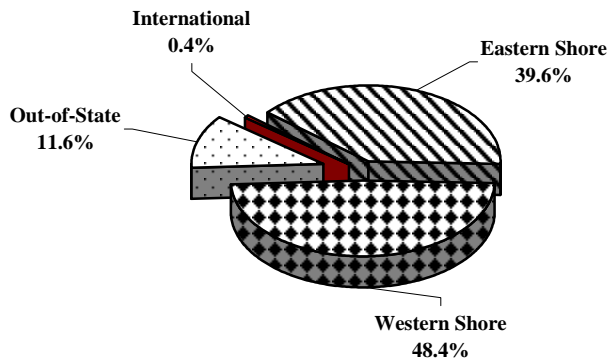

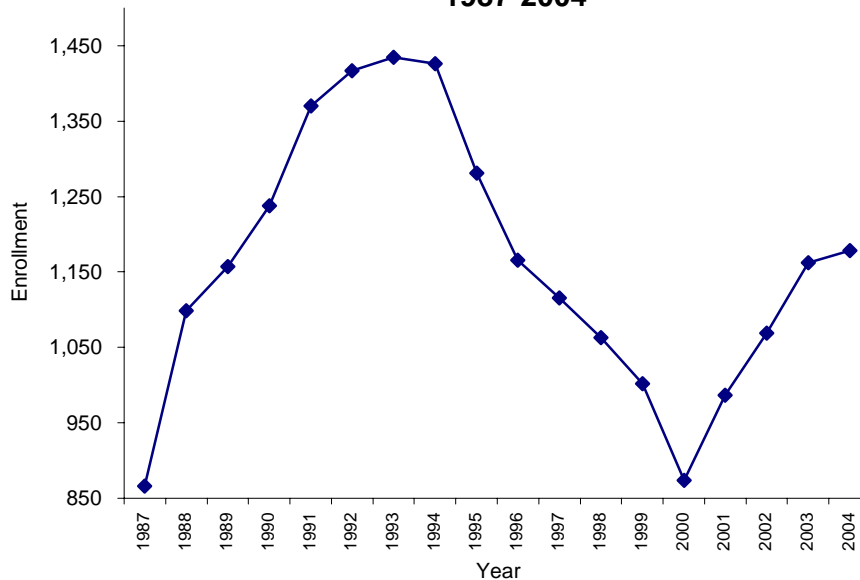

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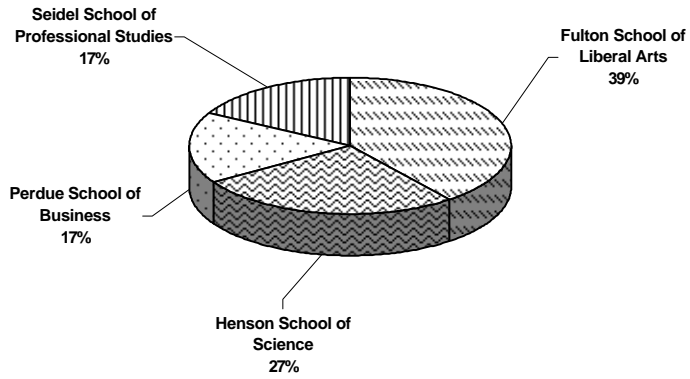
Total Winter Enrollment by Year 1987-2004



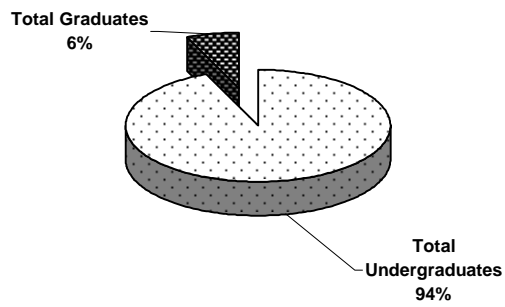
