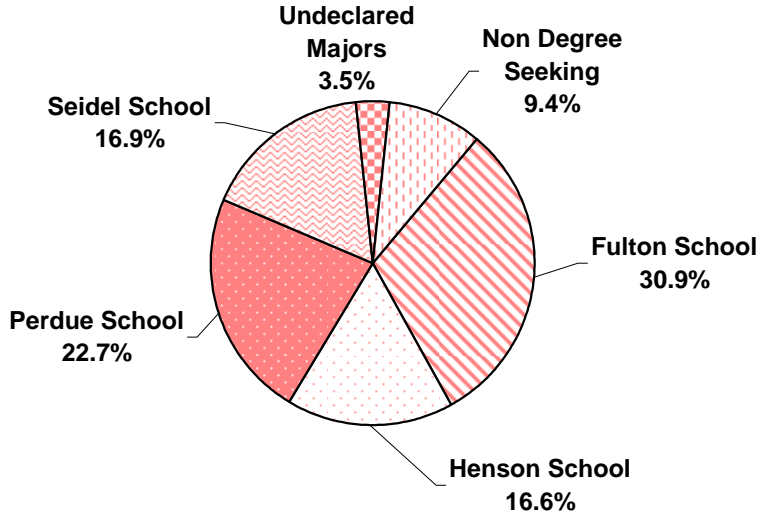

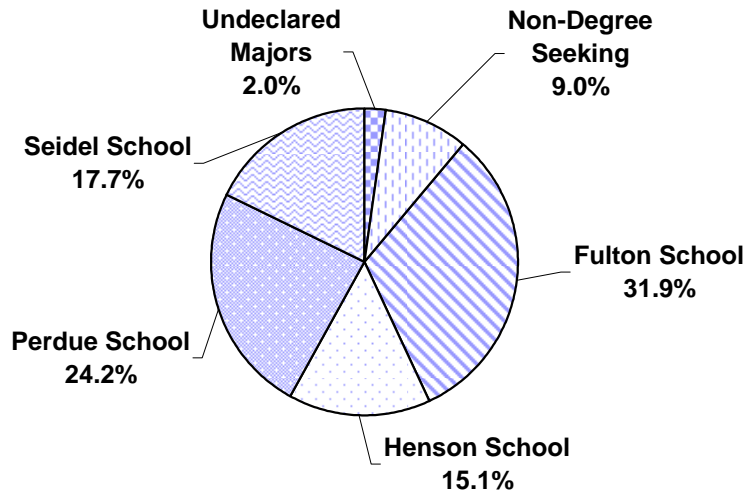

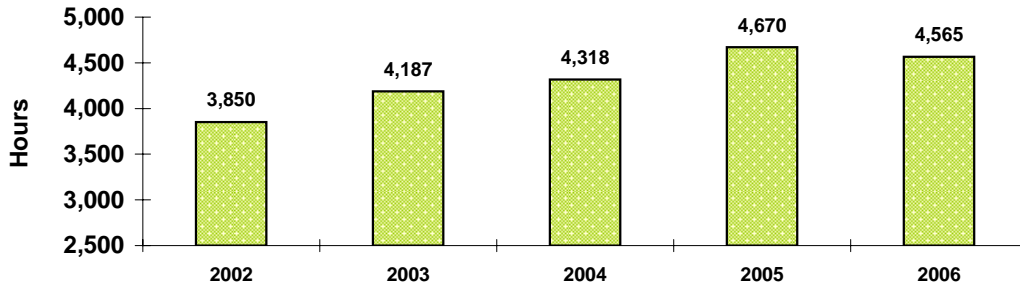
UG Enrollment by School: Winter 2002

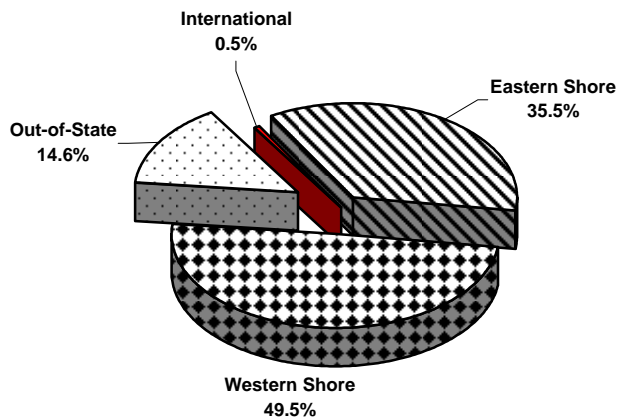

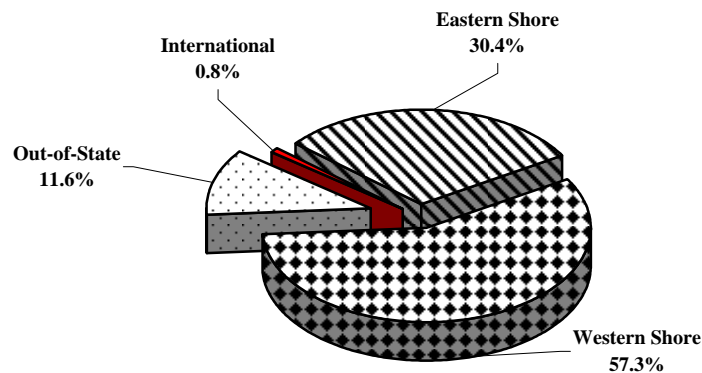

Enrollment by Region: Winter 2006

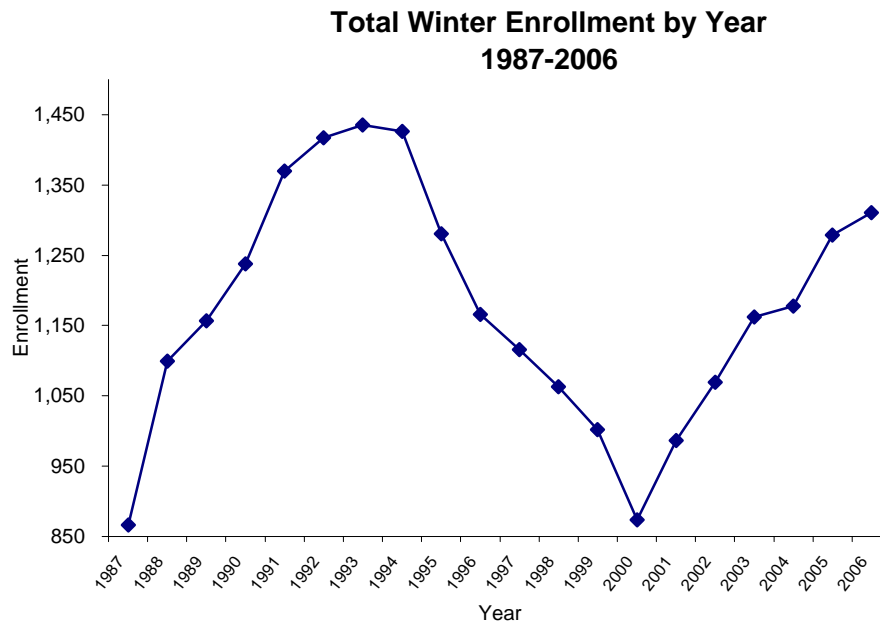

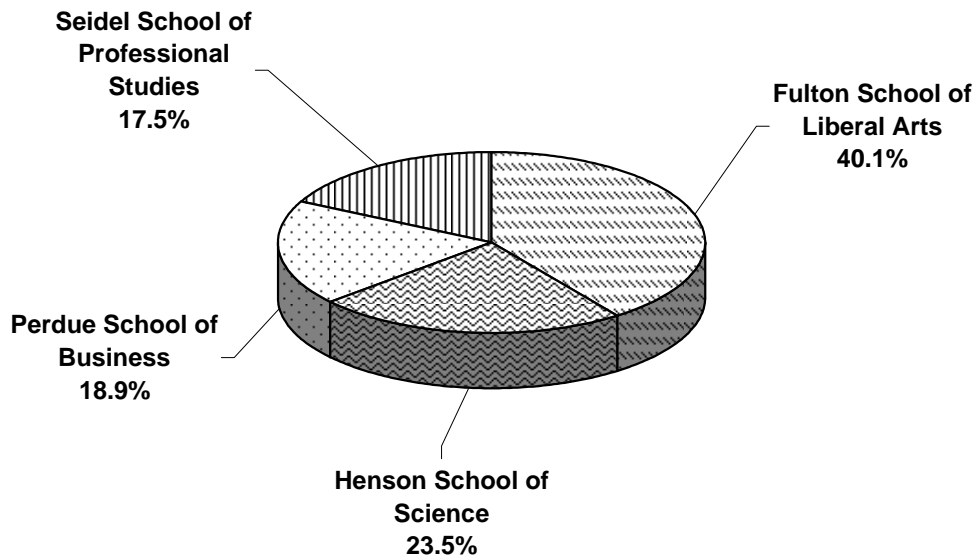

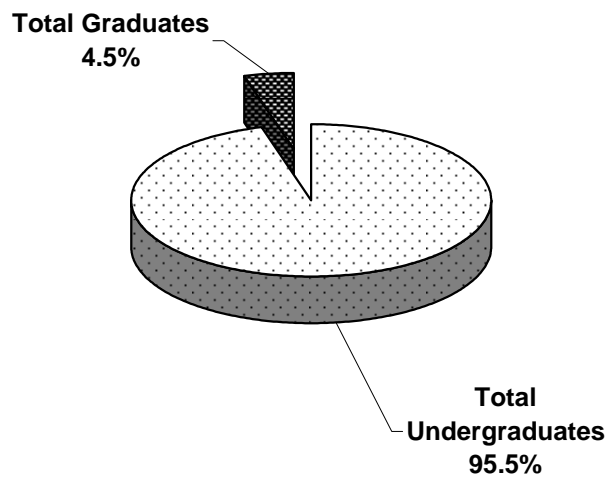
