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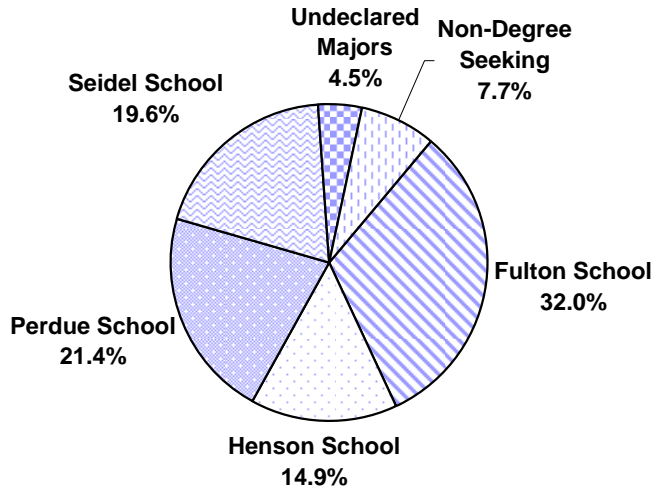

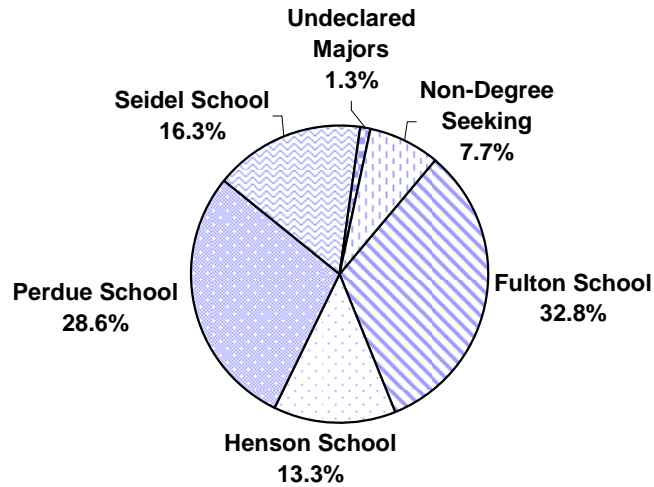

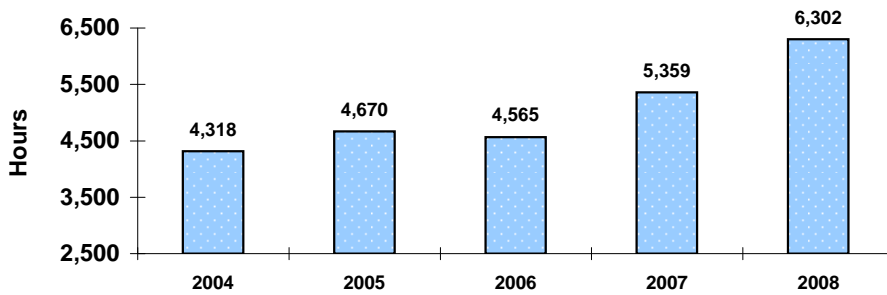
**UG Enrollment by School: Winter 2004**

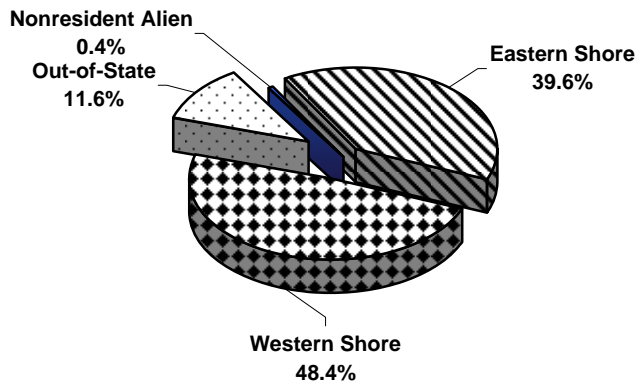

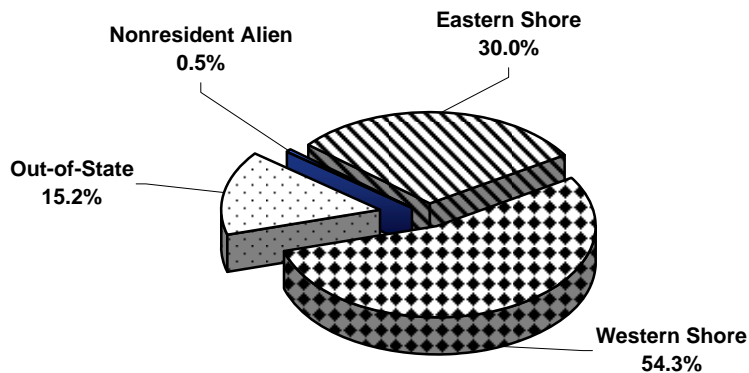

### Enrollment by Region: Winter 2004

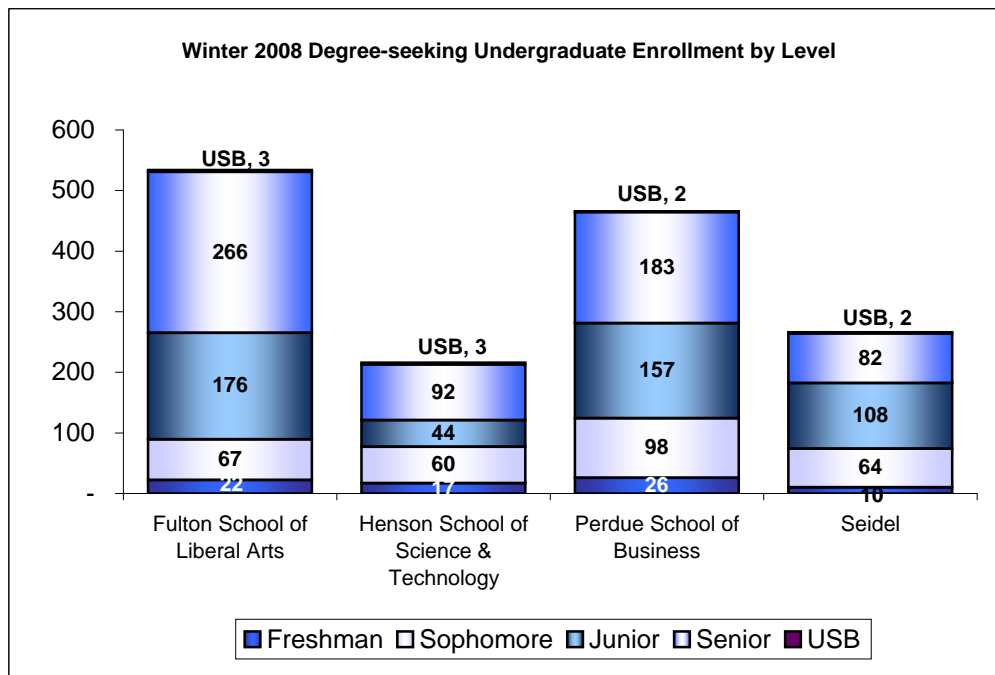


### Enrollment by Region: Winter 2008

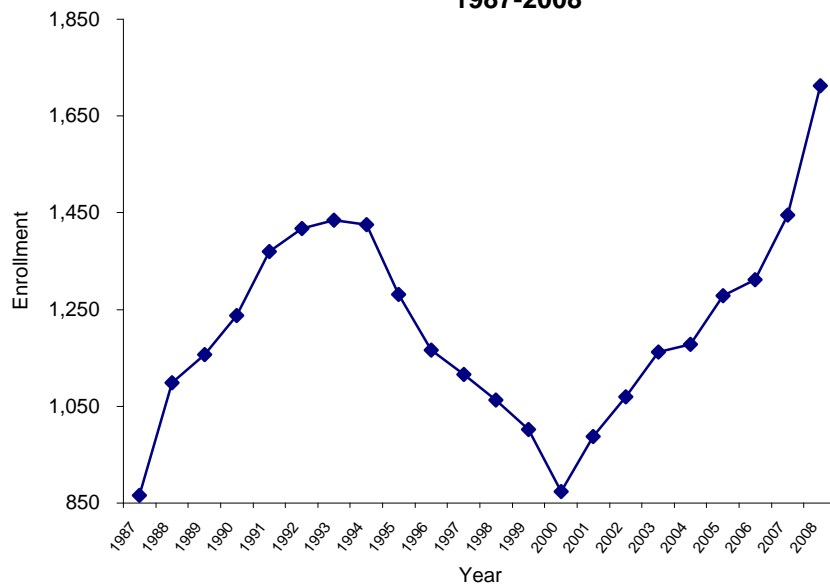

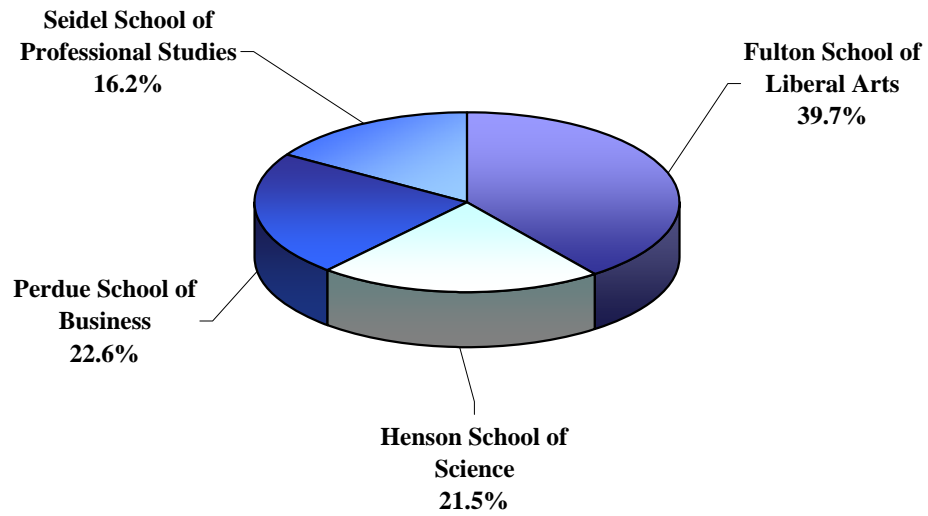
**Total Winter Enrollment by Year  
1987-2008**



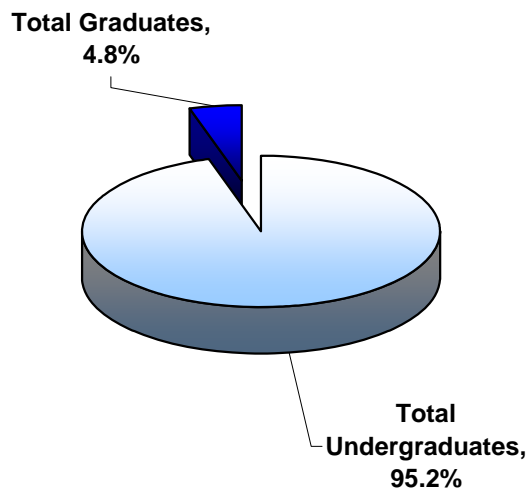
