

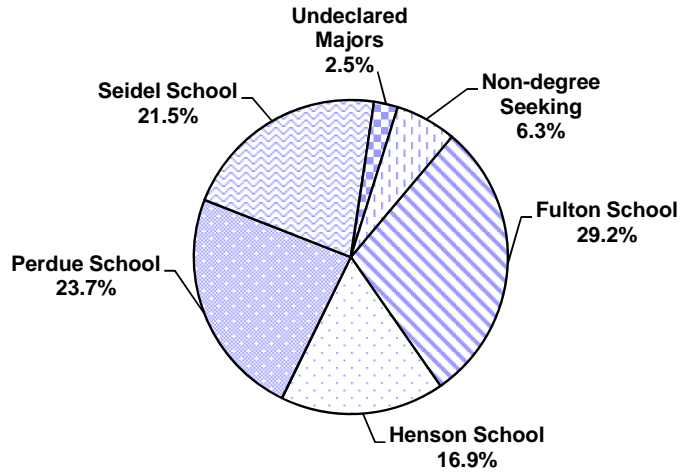

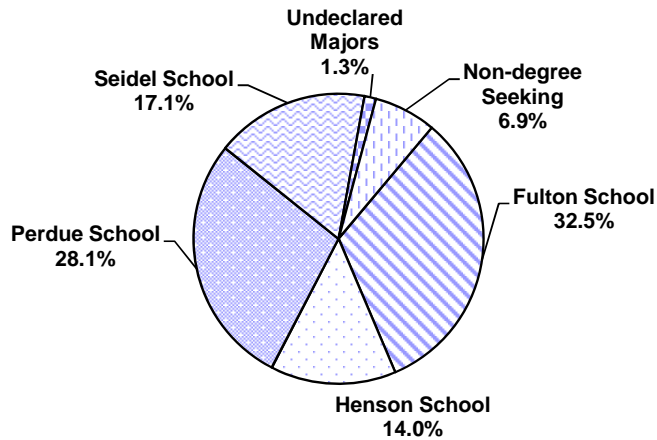

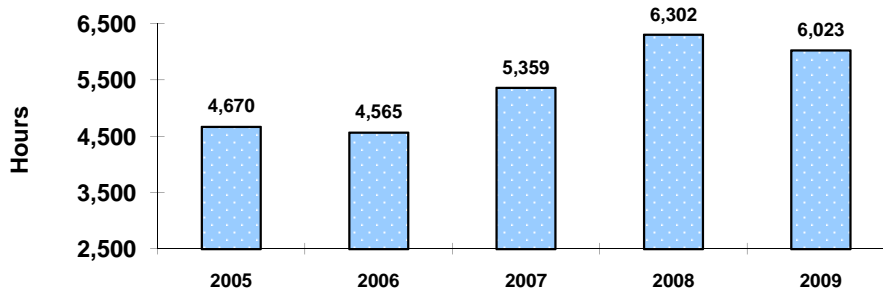
UG Enrollment by School: Winter 2005

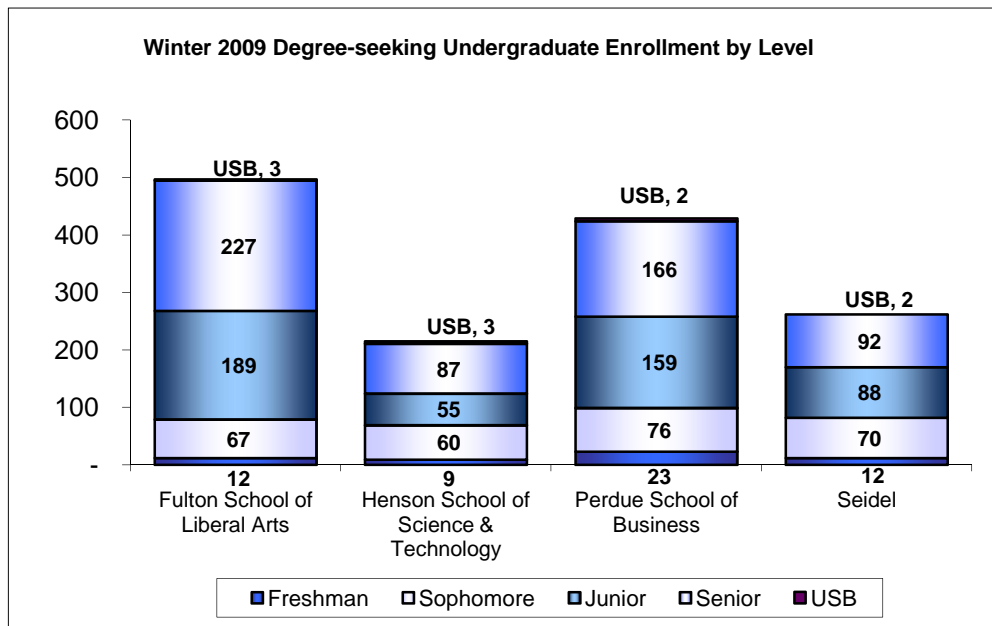

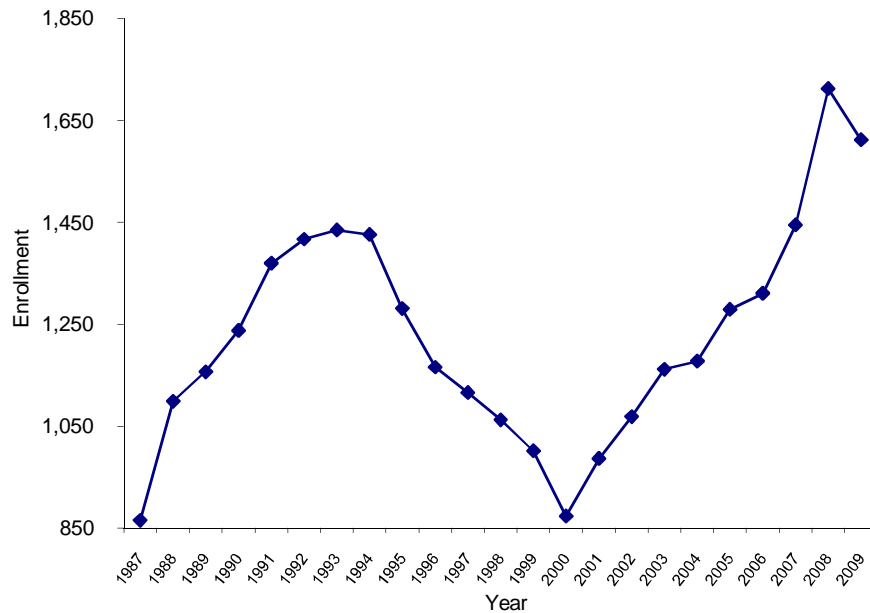

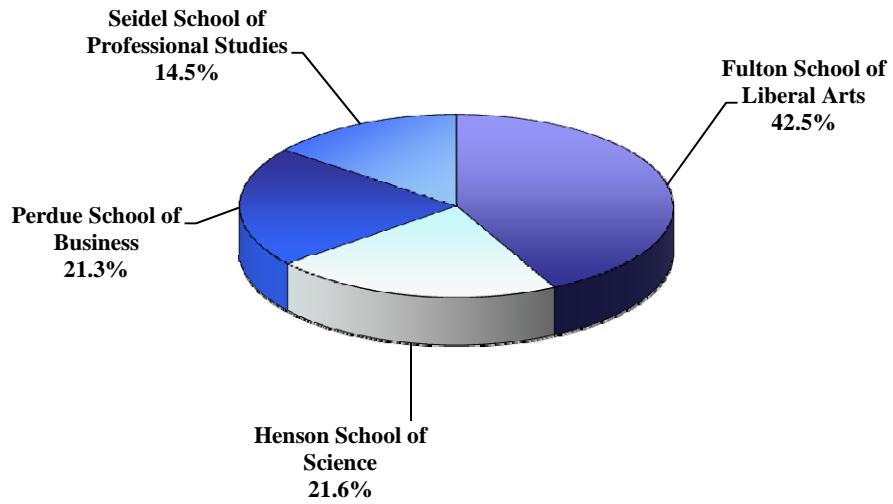
Total Winter Enrollment by Year
1987-2009



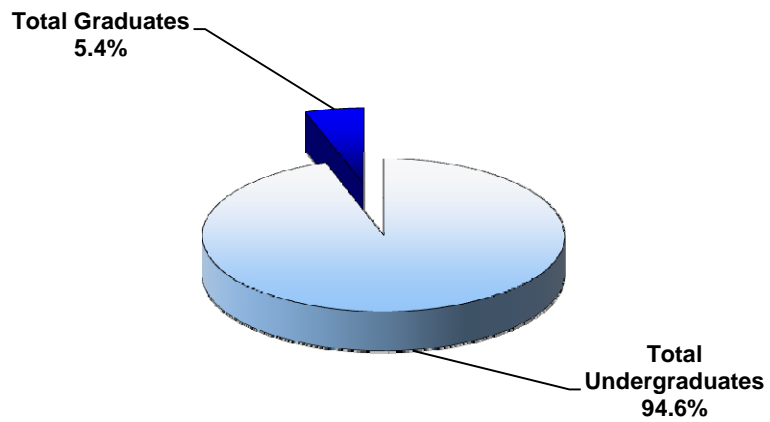
