



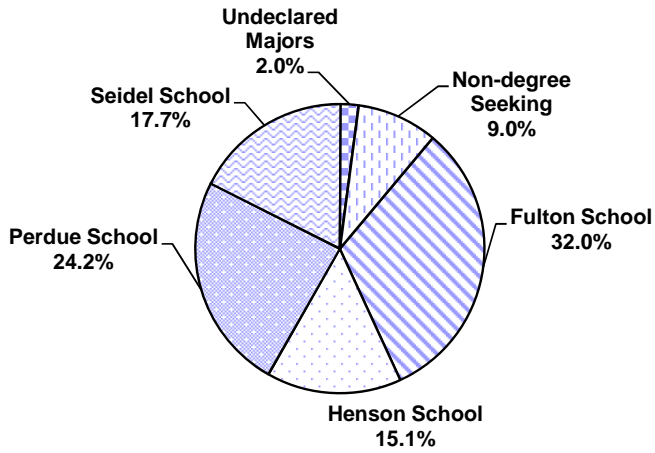

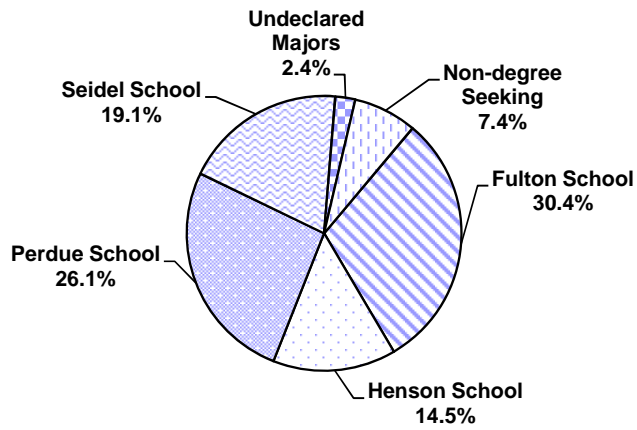

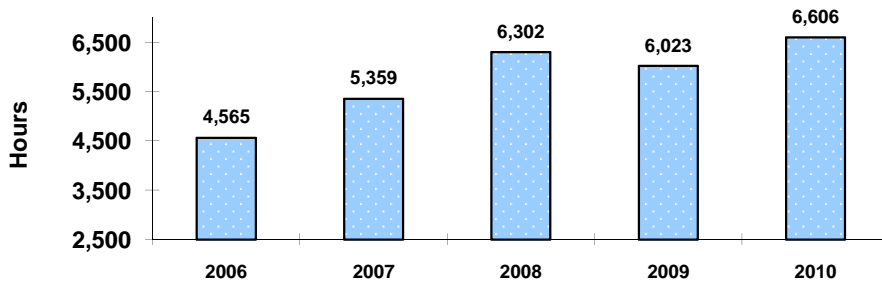
**UG Enrollment by School: Winter 2006**

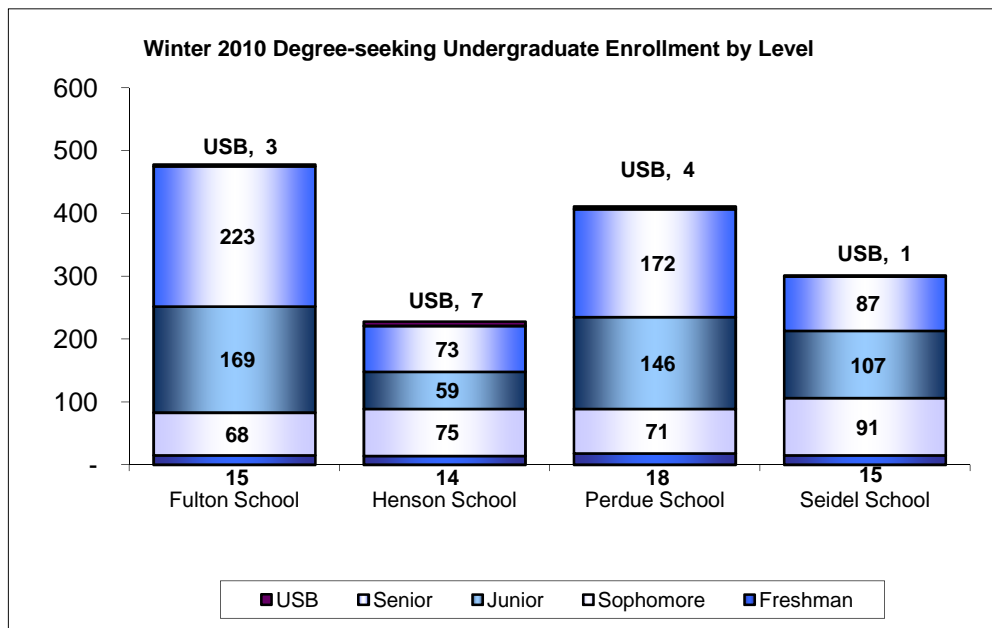

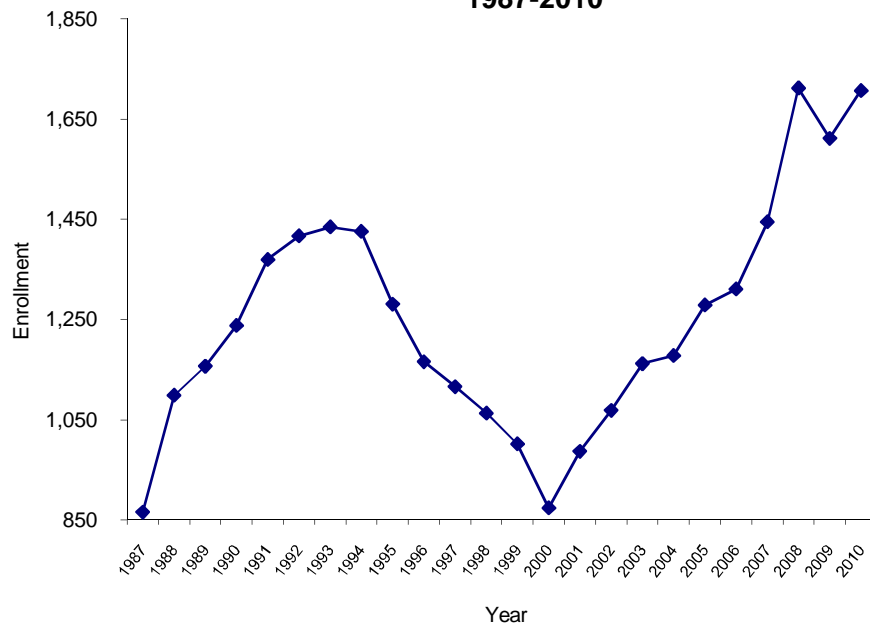

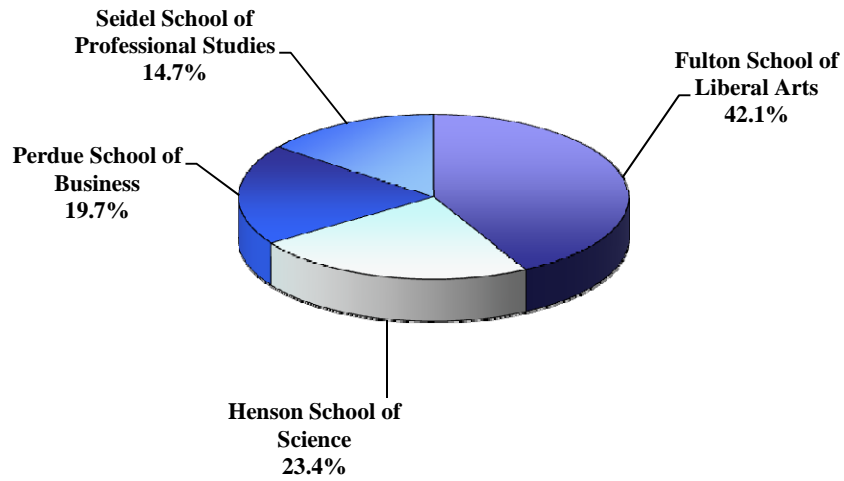
**Total Winter Enrollment by Year  
1987-2010**



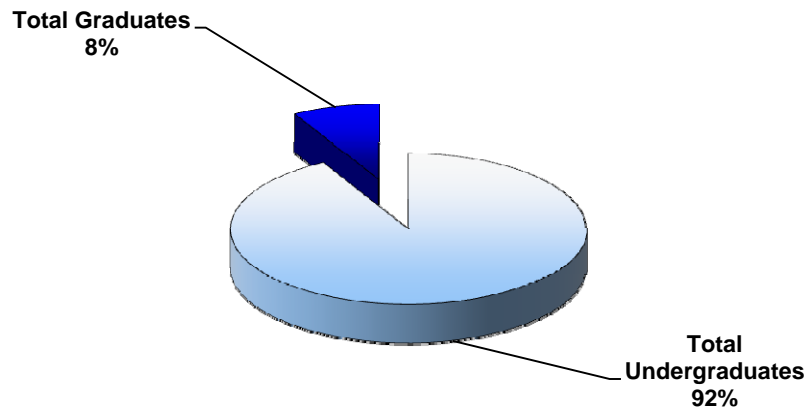
