This minor provides students with a basic core accounting background. For non-accounting Perdue School majors, it provides excellent credentials for those seeking careers where a background in accounting and business administration is important. It can also be utilized by non-accounting Perdue School majors to fulfill the necessary accounting prerequisites for entry into the accounting track of the MBA (Master of Business Administration) program at Salisbury University. Additionally, non-Perdue School majors may also use it to establish credentials for their careers.

Policies and Procedures

1. All courses in the ACCT minor must be completed with a "C" or better including transfer credits. No course may be taken pass/fail.
2. At least **9 credits** of the ACCT minor must be earned at Salisbury University.
3. The minor in Accounting consists of 18 credits, any of which may be used to fulfill other Perdue School requirements.
4. The Perdue School does not allow course substitution; only those courses listed as fulfilling the minor are accepted.
