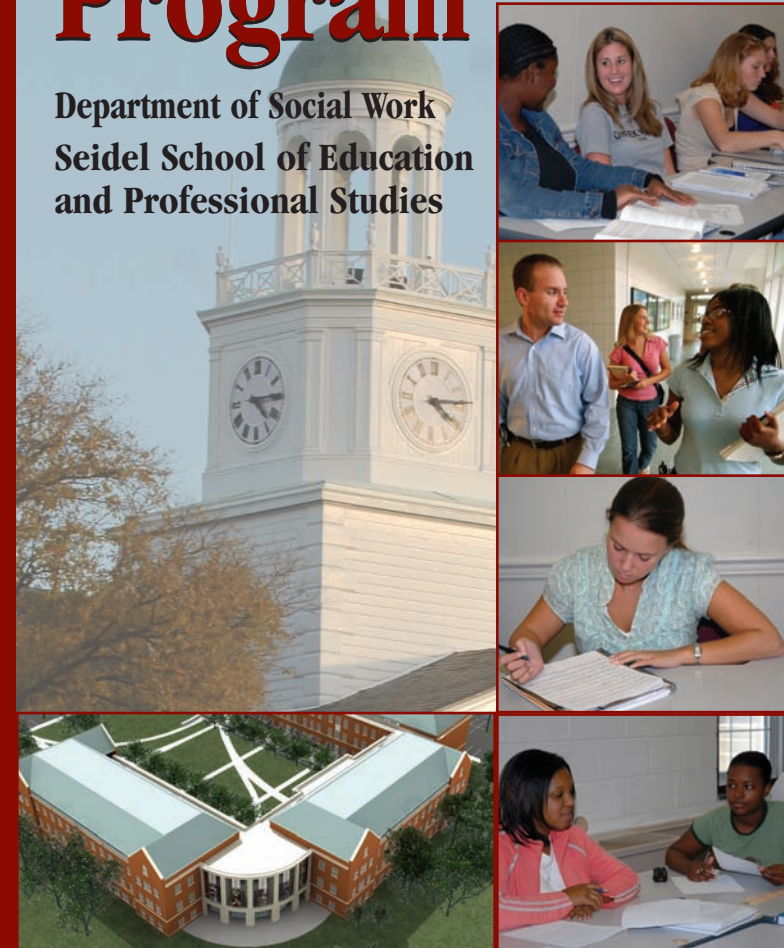
Come See Salisbury for Yourself

To meet the different needs of our students we offer both the Regular and Advanced Standing Programs on a full- or part-time basis.

Advanced Standing Program

31 credit hours

Full Time: 2 Semesters

Part Time: 4 Semesters

- Applicants who are recent graduates of an accredited undergraduate social work program can apply for advanced standing status.
- Incoming students will begin immediately with the Concentration Curriculum, focusing on direct practice with individuals, families and groups.
- Full-time advanced standing students can graduate in as few as **two semesters!**

Regular Program

61 credit hours

Full Time: 4 Semesters

Part Time: 7-8 Semesters

- The Regular Program provides professional graduate preparation for students with a variety of undergraduate experiences.
- This program includes a Foundation Curriculum to acquaint students with a solid understanding of the knowledge and skills associated with generalist social work practice.
- Following the Foundation Curriculum, students build upon successful mastery of foundation knowledge and skills by focusing on direct practice with individuals, families and groups through the Concentration Curriculum.
