

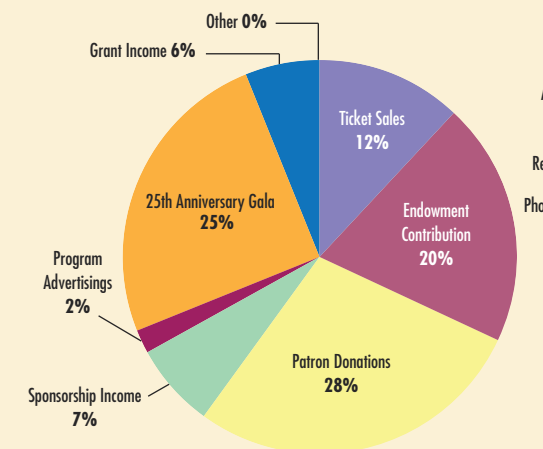
FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS: 2010-2011

Year Ending June 30, 2011

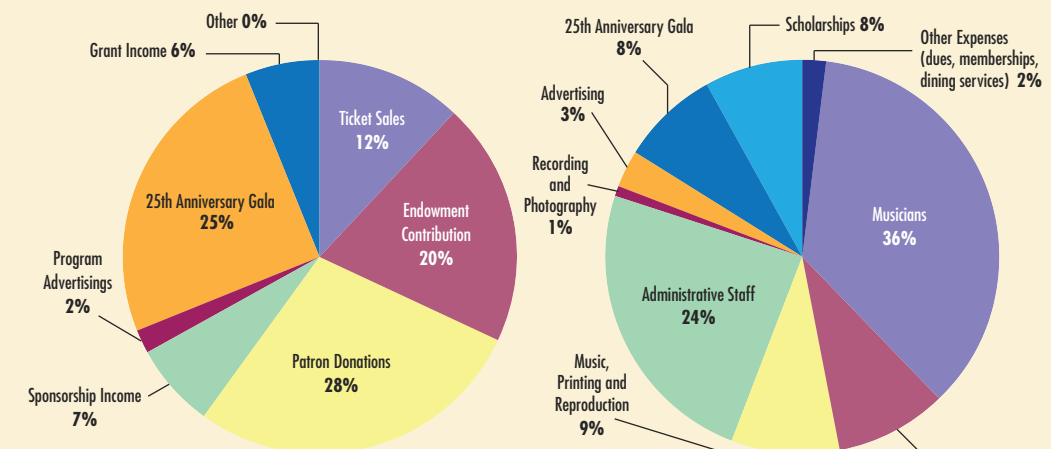
