Professional Program Admission Requirements

- A GPA of 2.5 or higher in the pre-professional core courses is required for admission into the Professional Program, including those courses taken at another institution.
- Grades of C or higher must be earned in all pre-professional courses for the following major: Business Economics.
- Complete at least 9 out of 11 Pre-Professional Courses (26 credits), 5 of which must be MATH 155, MATH 160, ECON 211 or ECON 212, ACCT 201, and BUAD 200. The remaining 2 courses must be completed in the first semester after being admitted to the Professional Program.
 - Grade Period is given to the completion of BUAD 200 until Fall 2024.
 - Students are admissible to the professional program when completing 8 out of 10 pre-professional courses (less BUAD 200) until Fall 2024.
- Students may repeat each business course **one time only**. If students exceed repeats, they will not be admissible to the Professional Program.
- Students must have completed **56 total credit hours** of college courses to be admitted into the Professional Program.
