First Year Students Registration TIPS:

- All Students need **120** Credit Hour to Graduate => 4 year graduation, average of **30** credit hour each academic year (15 credit hour each semester)
- Class Registration will be Early In the morning (start between 6 am – 8am).
 - Check Gullnet -> Student Center -> Enrollment Date (at the right side of the page)

TAKE:

- a **combination** of courses from different area, for example: 2 General Education Courses, 2-3 Business Courses
- **ECON 211, INFO 211, MATH 155 & 160** EARLY! These courses are pre-requisite for other major required classes.
- **ENGL 103** (HONR 111 if you are Honors Student) early! This course is pre-requisite for all Literature Classes (General Education 1B Requirement)
