Some 80 students vied for top honors during the sales championship competition held virtually for the first time.

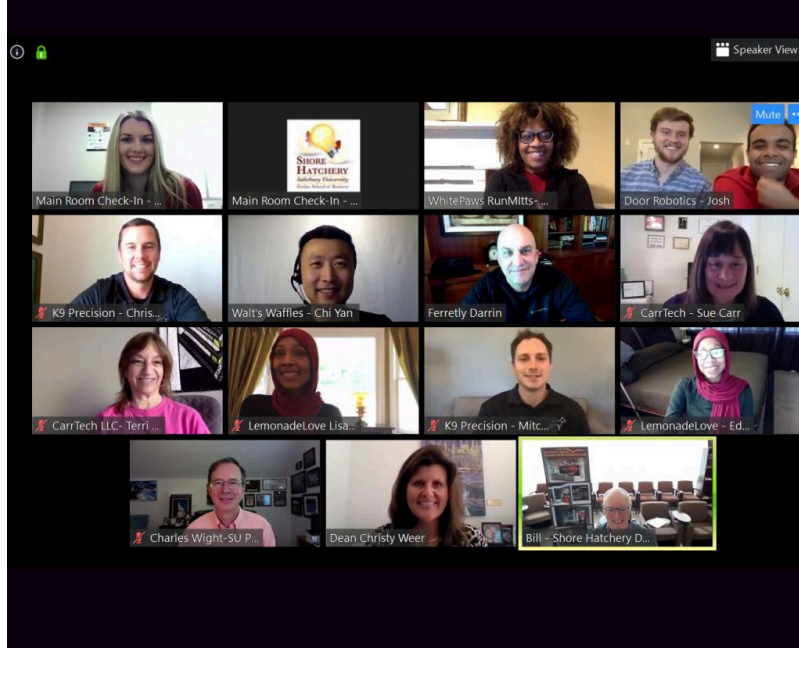
