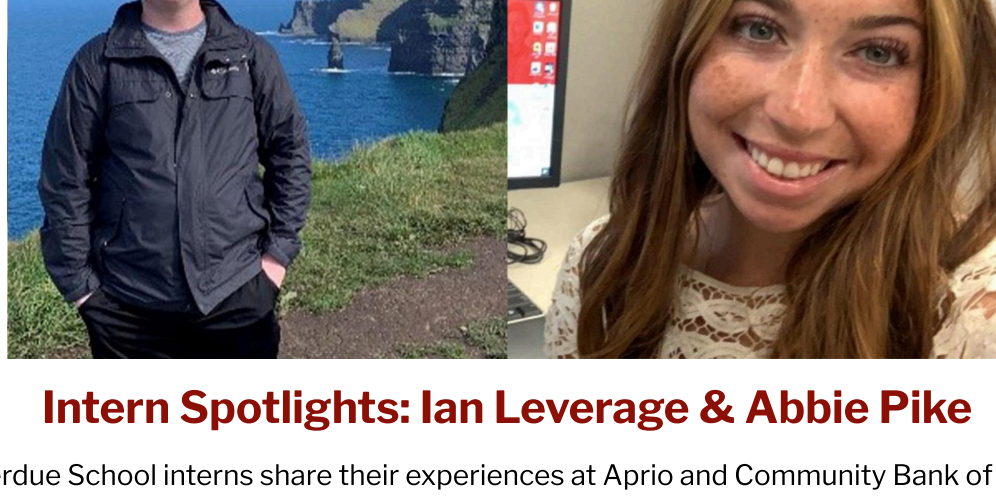


Greetings from the Dean's Office
