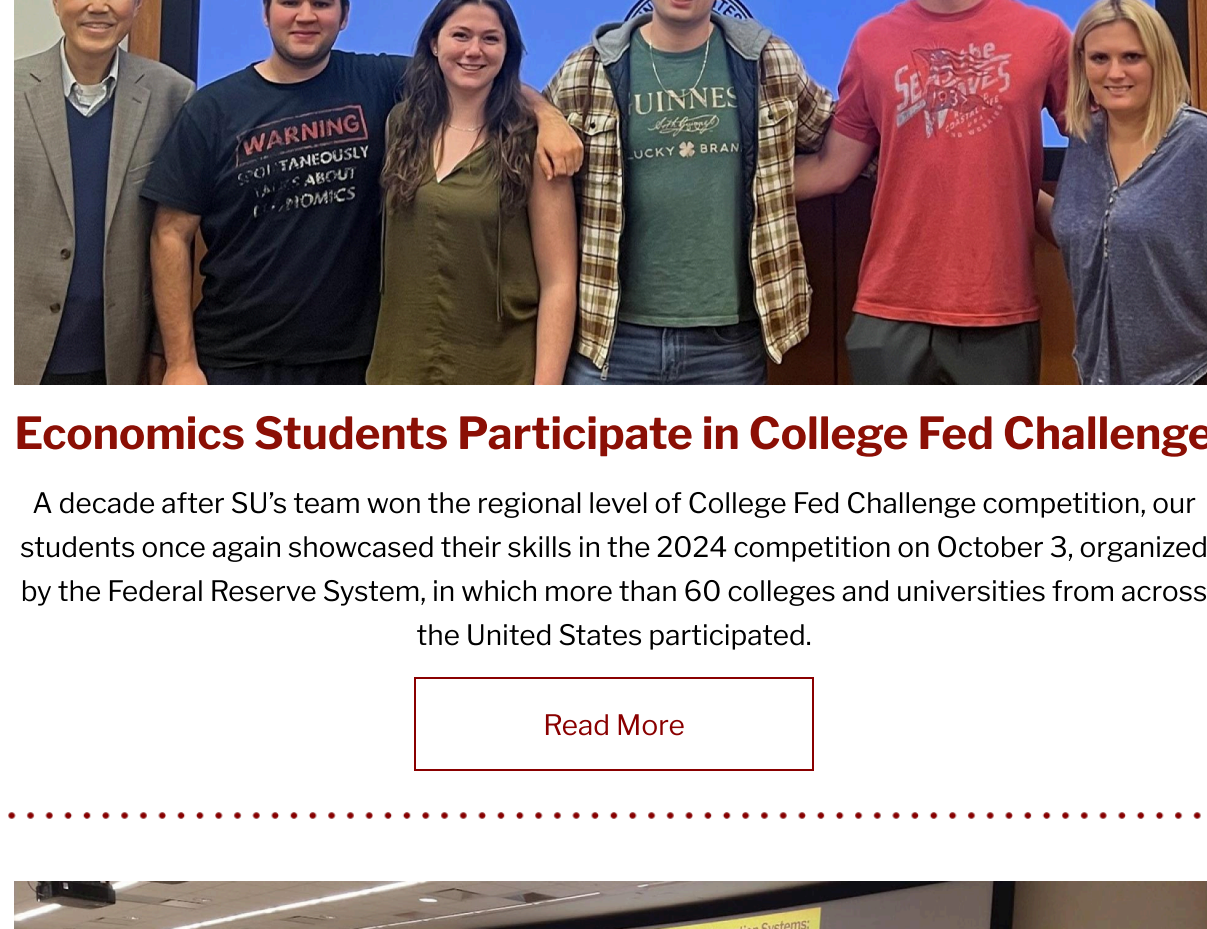




### Marins Med Earns Top Prize in Fall Ratcliffe Foundation Shore Hatchery Competition
