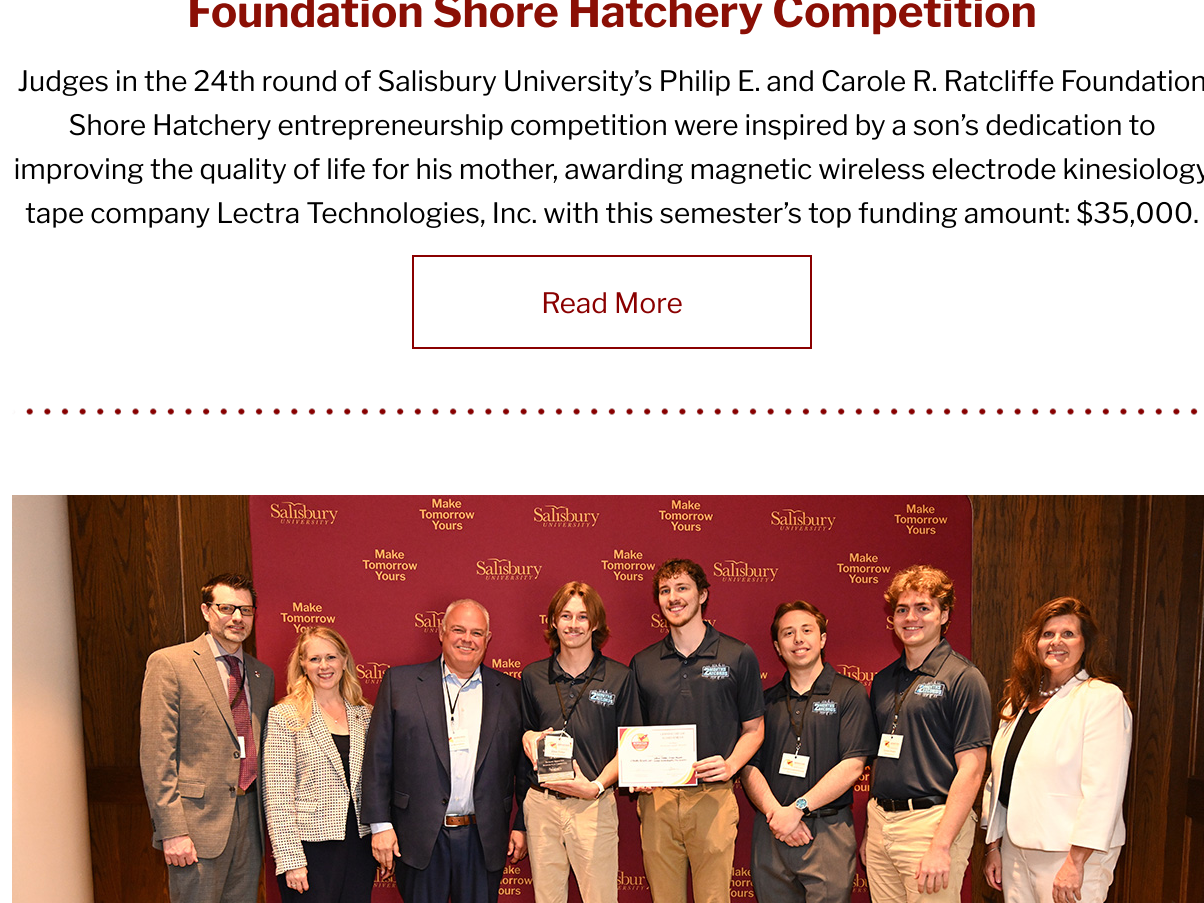

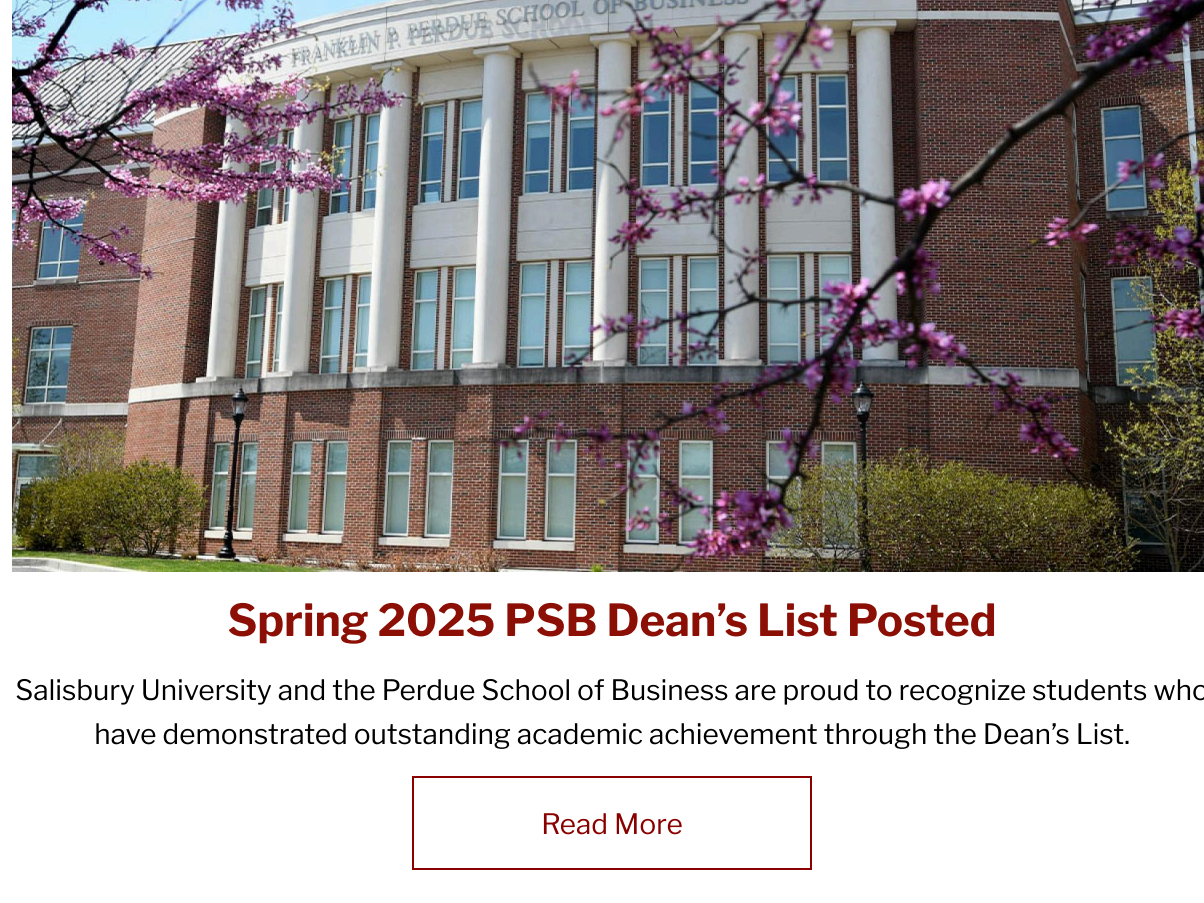

The Community Foundation of the Eastern Shore (CFES) hosted a continuing education event for local financial planners in which our financial planning students participated.

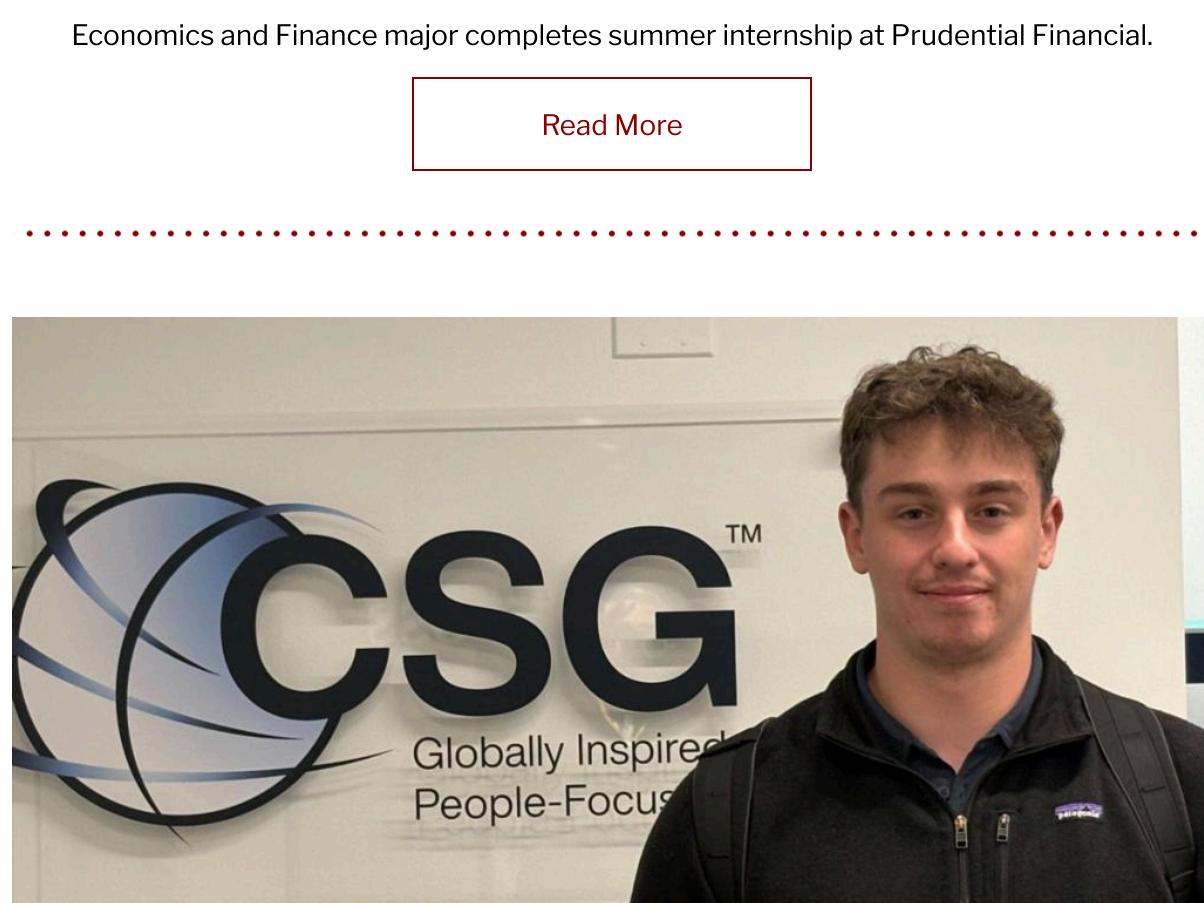
