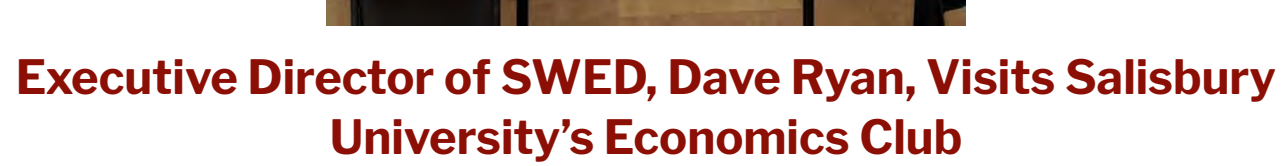


**BEACON Releases Latest Eastern Shore Business Sentiment Survey Results**

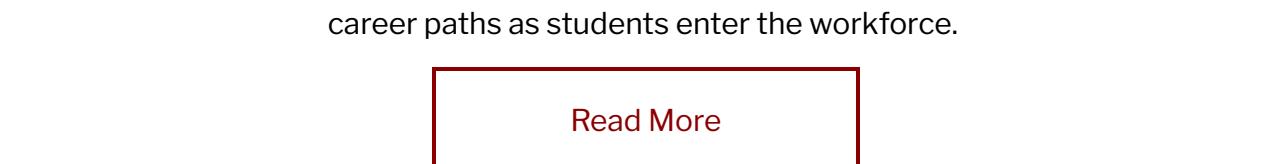

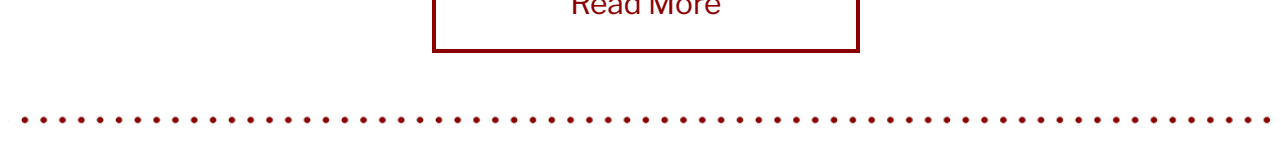
