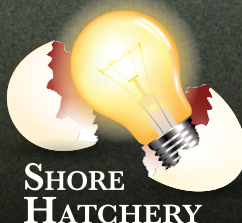

The Story of the Shore Hatchery Competition

The Shore Hatchery competition was established in 2013 with generous contributions from the Philip E. and Carole R. Ratcliffe Foundation. Over the past 12 years, the competition has distributed over \$2.3 million in funds to Mid-Atlantic startups and aspiring entrepreneurs. Our goal is to help entrepreneurs overcome critical obstacles to venture formation and growth with cash grants of up to \$50,000, leading to the creation of new jobs.

Around 60 companies apply for funding each year. Half are selected to compete in all-day competition events, which occur twice a year during the fall and spring semesters. Each event consists of an exhibit tradeshow and a pitch competition. The competition judges are business and community leaders from the Eastern Shore and representatives of the Ratcliffe Foundation. Between 10-15 companies are ultimately awarded a share of the \$200,000 in funds distributed

annually. Winners are also matched with members of the judging panel for mentorship.

Winners have self-reported estimated profits of \$98 million and created over 1,195 jobs over the past decade. The Shore Hatchery has drawn national attention, including auditions for the ABC-TV series *Shark Tank*. Winners like Tania Speaks organic skincare, The Frozen Farmer ice cream, and Tip Tough finger protector have appeared on national TV networks, securing investment deals and showcasing the competition's success in fostering entrepreneurship.

The Shore Hatchery Competition continues to honor the vision of Philip and Carole Ratcliffe, supporting young entrepreneurs and contributing to the regional economy. With ongoing support from the Ratcliffe Foundation and a strong network of mentors and resources, the competition remains a cornerstone of entrepreneurial development at Salisbury University and the Mid-Atlantic region.

The Shore Hatchery competition is administered by the entrepreneurship program operated by the Perdue School of Business at Salisbury University. Shore Hatchery complements the program's other initiatives such as the Student Entrepreneurship Competitions and the Dave and Patsy Rommel Center for Entrepreneurship.

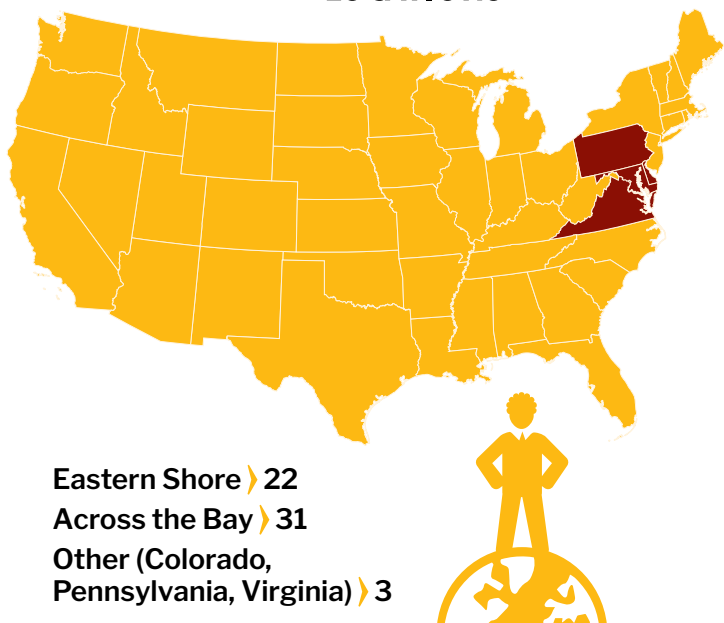

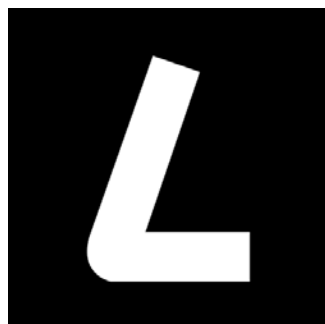

Eastern Shore ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

A primary purpose of the Shore Hatchery competition is to **promote economic development** on the Eastern Shore. Over the past five years, we have funded 26 Eastern Shore startups, including seven of the 15 competition winners this past year. These funds often go to **help these local businesses expand** their operating capacity or market reach by purchasing equipment or accessing new professional services. Winners typically have strong market validation and revenue.

29 Eastern Shore based startups for 2020-2025

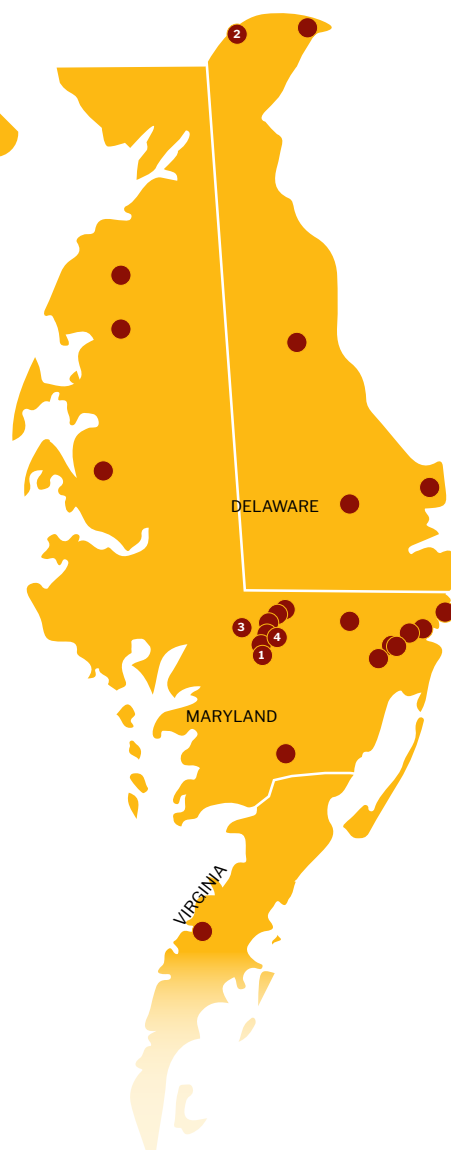

B&J's Soulful Creations ① (Fall 2024)

B&J's founder LaTosha Bateman of Salisbury, MD, won \$10,000 to expand her catering and food truck business. Known for its gourmet Southern cuisine, including vegan and vegetarian options, the company is dedicated to creating employment opportunities in the community, with a focus on mentoring and teaching troubled youth. Over the past year, LaTosha has purchased a generator, repainted her food truck, and added new equipment to support her growing operations. She is now actively seeking a restaurant location to continue expanding B&J's impact and reach.

Upstream Innovations ²

(Fall 2024)

The Newark, DE,-based company manufactures Bed Ledge, a product designed to support safe and independent bed mobility. Serving aging populations, medical facilities, and post-surgical rehabilitation, the device reduces fall risk and helps prevent future injuries. This has been a big year for the company, with funding in place to bring the product to market. They are currently focused on pre-sales, including a Kickstarter campaign that launched last month.

Mosaic Counseling & Wellness (Fall 2022) ³

Mosaic Counseling and Wellness, based in Salisbury, MD, expanded this year from a solo practice into a multi-practitioner office to better serve residents of the Delmarva Peninsula. Founded by Stephanie Blevins, the practice provides a range of services, recently adding youth counseling, art therapy, and hydromassage. With funding from the Shore Hatchery, Mosaic has increased its revenue by 190.5%, doubled its number of employees, and is expanding to two additional locations in Salisbury, MD, and Pocomoke City, MD.

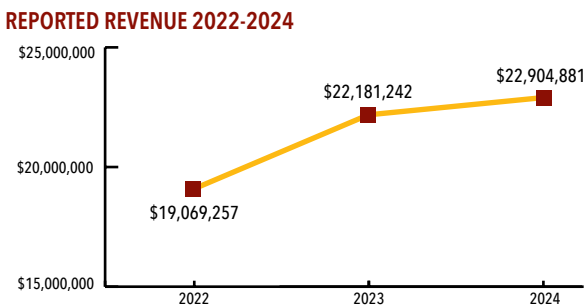
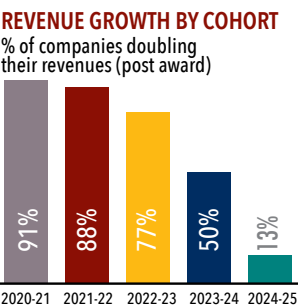
Blackwater Apothecary, based in Salisbury, MD, is a metaphysical supply store focused on expanding its offerings and growing in the wholesale market. With funding support, the company has purchased materials and strengthened its marketing efforts to build a solid foundation for long-term growth. Over the past several months, Blackwater Apothecary has streamlined its supply chain by buying bulk materials at reduced costs, boosting margins and improving efficiency to meet growing demand. The business also launched a refreshed, user-friendly website to better serve both retail and wholesale customers and expanded its wholesale marketing initiatives. These efforts have driven a steady increase in wholesale sales and helped the company build strong relationships with like-minded retailers.

TECHNOLOGY & COMMERCIALIZATION

The Shore Hatchery competition also supports technology startups. These businesses leverage new technology to produce **innovative products or services**. Tech companies have the potential to scale rapidly and generate many jobs. However, technology startups are risky ventures, and the majority do not survive to become large businesses. It is a high-risk, high-reward proposition. We often invest early on in a technology startup's lifecycle when the risk is highest and funding is very hard to find. Our awards typically go to assist with prototype development and securing intellectual property protection during the pre-revenue period. Shore Hatchery provides essential funding that helps these entrepreneurs continue to **advance their concepts** and bring new products to market.

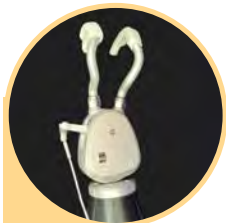

Marins Med (Fall 2024)

Marins Med, based in Georgetown, DE, develops body-powered upper extremity prosthetics designed to restore functionality and improve daily life for amputees. Co-founders Darryl and Suzen DuBre and Steve Burke created the patented ProHensor, a specialized prosthetic featuring a user-actuated lock, three functional modes, and a durable design that enhances prosthetic acceptance. With \$40,000 in funding from the Shore Hatchery, Marins Med has advanced device manufacturing and completed validation testing in South Africa and Ukraine, marking a significant step toward expanding the reach and impact of their innovative prosthetic technology.

Korion Health (Spring 2024)

Korion Health, based in Pittsburgh, PA, aims to expand health care access for underserved communities and those historically hesitant to engage with preventive care. The company is advancing telehealth accessibility through its electronic USB stethoscope and companion app with an intuitive guided interface that brings cardiopulmonary exams into patient homes. Korion Health was awarded \$10,000 in the spring 2024 Shore Hatchery competition, which was used for product research and development and usability studies. Major milestones over the past year include finalizing the hardware and electrical design of the product, setting up a quality management system, closing a pre-seed fundraising round, and winning multiple awards, including the \$1M Social Entrepreneurship Prize at the Hult Prize Global Finals.



The Shore Hatchery provided us with a strategic \$10K grant at a critical moment for our business. The funding allowed us to conduct a key usability study, which informed product design improvements and benchmarking of our device against competitors. This support was instrumental in helping us sharpen our focus, attract further investments, and prepare for the next stage of our growth.”

GaiaXus (Spring 2025)

GaiaXus, based in Germantown, MD, provides affordable environmental monitoring solutions for K-12 STEM education, citizen science, and undergraduate research. Its flagship product, the GaiaXus Water Guardian, is a water quality monitoring system designed for students, educators, and citizen scientists as a low-cost alternative to traditional lab instruments. The company was awarded \$5,000, which dramatically increased visibility, sharpened its value proposition, and improved its pitch. In 2024, GaiaXus released a new multi-mode water quality monitoring system, completed all required testing, and began low-volume manufacturing. The company also finalized pilots in the Netherlands, positioning it to expand into Europe with the support of the Maryland Department of Commerce, and completed a large study with a Title I school in Hawaii, which is expected to become a customer.



Lytos Vodka

(Fall 2022)

Lytos Vodka, based in Columbia, MD, distills gluten-free vodka from corn infused with salt, potassium, and phosphorus, creating the first spirit of its kind with added electrolytes. Lytos received \$20,000 to support on- and off-premise marketing, trade sales, and digital advertising. The funding helped shift the business from a cash-burning startup to a profitable and growing venture. In 2024, Lytos was awarded the allowance for its U.S. patent, recognizing the company as the first vodka brand to successfully infuse electrolytes into spirits while securing the proprietary production process. This milestone has strengthened the brand's credibility and positioned it for continued growth, with distribution now reaching every county in Maryland.



Funds received from the Shore Hatchery marked a turning point for my brand. I went from a struggling startup to a smooth-sailing operation, and Lytos has been in good shape ever since. Jay's Watermelonade (Fall 2024)

Jay's Watermelonade, a Baltimore-based company, won \$10,000 in the fall 2024 Shore Hatchery Competition and has since served more than 5,000 customers across the city. They are now expanding their production team and preparing to launch a shelf-stable version of their product for local retail and wholesale markets.

Rooted in social impact, Jay's Watermelonade offers paid seasonal internships for local youth, providing job training and entrepreneurial experience. They have partnered with Walmart, the Watson Institute, and Our Time Kitchen to host Baltimore's Food & Beverage Bootcamp, empowering emerging food entrepreneurs with resources and industry insights through a pitch competition.

Their achievements include winning first place in CCBC's Annual Business Plan Competition, earning \$20,000 in additional funding, and being selected for several competitive programs, including the Watson Institute's Retail Readiness Program (supported by Walmart), Baltimore Corps' Elevation Awards, and the Greater Baltimore Urban League's Restaurant Accelerator.

Science Nerds (Spring 2024)

Science Nerds is on a mission to make science fun, accessible, and engaging for children of all ages. In 2024, they expanded programming to reach children as young as two, while also bringing hands-on STEM experiences to thousands of students in underserved communities. They also launched virtual science sessions, connecting with learners beyond the Eastern Shore and broadening access to quality STEM education.

To further extend their reach, Science Nerds introduced retail-ready science kits – including Explore the Oceans and Outdoors Camping Science – that are now sold in popular local shops, campgrounds, and family destinations. These kits provide screen-free adventures for children and have created new wholesale partnerships that sustain their mission. With support from Shore Hatchery, Science Nerds has been able to grow their impact, combining entrepreneurial success with a strong commitment to educational equity and community enrichment.

Sindri Materials (Spring 2024)

In October 2024, Sindri Materials was awarded \$10,000 from the Shore Hatchery, funding that proved pivotal in advancing their first commercial product: graphene-based cryo-EM grids, used for high-resolution imaging in structural biology and gene therapy. The award supported critical early-stage needs – including R&D, procurement of specialized materials, and access to essential testing and quality control resources – laying the groundwork for future commercialization.

Equally as important, Sindri has dedicated time and expertise to giving back through education and mentorship. Over the past year, the team has spoken on entrepreneurship panels at Columbia University, delivered a tech talk at the University of Delaware, and mentored students through job shadow programs. By expanding into a larger lab, tripling their team, launching a pilot program in gene therapy applications, and securing \$350,000 in seed investment – all while fostering the next generation of innovators – Sindri demonstrates how Shore Hatchery companies can combine entrepreneurial success with meaningful social impact.



Nina's Cookies (Fall 2021)

Nina's Cookies, a mission-driven bakery, has been steadily growing its footprint while staying rooted in community impact. Through its popular Dough of the Month Club, Nina's donates 10% of profits each month to a different local charity. To date, the bakery has supported 18 charities, contributing approximately \$2,400 over its first five years in business. Beyond financial contributions, Nina's also donates cookies to community organizations, spreading kindness in both meaningful and delicious ways.

In 2024, Nina's Cookies was awarded \$10,000 from the University System of Maryland Launch Fund, fueling their growth and momentum. Over the past year, sales grew by 25%, climbing from \$70,000 to \$88,000. Most recently, the company signed the lease for its first brick-and-mortar store – an exciting milestone that will expand its reach while deepening its community impact. Nina's Cookies continues to blend entrepreneurial success with social responsibility, proving that small businesses can make a big difference.

The company has doubled its store count, expanded into Albertsons Mid-Atlantic, Giant Eagle, and Market District locations across Pennsylvania and Ohio, and it is now featured in more than 100 stores throughout the region. With new product innovations like their Stress Relief Fridges boosting sales, Zenjoy achieved \$500,000 in revenue and is on track to surpass \$1.25 million in 2025. Their expansion into the college market marks the next chapter of growth for this fast-rising brand.



PROGRAMS & PEOPLE



MAIN SAIL ANGEL NETWORK

This year, the Shore Hatchery expanded its entrepreneurship competition portfolio with the addition of the Mainsail Angel Network, a new angel investing group based in Salisbury, MD. The network provides funding and support to early-stage businesses in the Greater Eastern Shore region, offering investments typically ranging from \$50,000 to \$500,000 to companies across various industries that demonstrate growth potential and regional impact. Their application process runs on an annual cycle, with businesses submitting applications by year-end, presenting to panels in the spring, and making final pitches to investors during the summer. Beyond funding, selected companies receive mentorship and guidance from experienced investors and entrepreneurs. The network focuses on supporting ventures that contribute to economic development in the Eastern Shore community.



SCALING NEW HEIGHTS

Since securing \$30,000 in 2022, Omega 3 has scaled its business to new heights. The company signed a contract with Goldstar, the largest K-12 distributor in California, while also landing sales through an airline industry partner. These efforts have driven revenue growth from \$970,000 to more than \$2.8 million and expanded their team to 25 employees. Omega 3's trajectory highlights Shore Hatchery's role in supporting businesses with both funding and critical market connections.



NETWORK OPENS DOORS

Huck Bucket leveraged its participation in the Shore Hatchery and the inaugural Main Sail Angel Network meeting to open doors to new opportunities. Through connections made at the event, the company secured a major order from Pohanka and was introduced to a potential investor. These milestones reflect the power of the Shore Hatchery ecosystem to not only provide capital but also foster the relationships that help entrepreneurs scale their businesses.

RESEARCH PROJECT ENHANCES COMPETITIONS

Our future Ratcliffe Shore Hatchery Graduate Assistant Leah Osmon conducted a research project focused on improving student engagement in Salisbury University's business competitions. She surveyed students across all schools, analyzed participation barriers, and reviewed best practices from peer institutions. Her findings revealed that awareness of competitions remains low outside of the business school, with faculty engagement, targeted digital marketing, and examples of past winners identified as the strongest ways to broaden participation. Leah's research is directly shaping our continuous improvement process, helping us strengthen outreach, create more inclusive opportunities, and ensure our competitions inspire innovation across every discipline at SU.

SHORE HATCHERY GRANT RENEWAL

This year, Salisbury University celebrated the renewal of its Shore Hatchery program with a \$900,000 gift from the Ratcliffe Foundation, ensuring the initiative continues through 2029. Established in 2013, the Shore Hatchery provides funding and mentorship to entrepreneurs who are actively growing their small businesses, helping them overcome barriers to expansion and reach new markets. Each year, up to \$200,000 is awarded to applicants selected by a board of directors following competitive presentations. In addition to funding, all participants gain access to guidance and resources through the Dave and Patsy Rommel Center for Entrepreneurship. Now in its second decade, the Shore Hatchery continues to play a vital role in strengthening the regional economy and supporting the success of emerging business leaders.

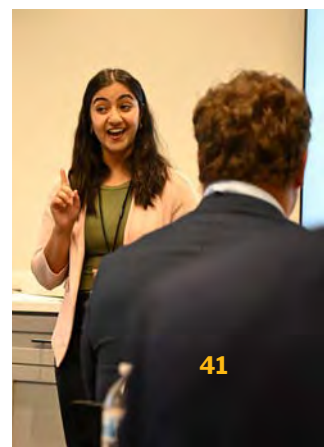
