

SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER WORKFORCE EXPANSION

(SUDWE) FELLOWSHIP



The current substance use treatment workforce in Maryland is insufficient to meet the treatment needs of individuals with substance use disorders (SUD).

The Substance Use Disorder Workforce Expansion (SUDWE) Fellowship aims to increase the number of social workers providing evidence-based interventions in the treatment field. The program is a one-year fellowship for Master of Social Work students in their specialized year who are committed to working in integrated behavioral health.

With grant support from the Maryland Behavioral Health Administration (BHA), recipients will be awarded a tuition stipend of \$15,000 (contingent on funding availability and split semester disbursement).
