




SU SOCI Alumni Success & Satisfaction (2021 survey)

- Median Personal Income \$60,000-\$80,000 (survey question asks by range)
 - Median household income was over \$100,000
 - National Data for Sociology Majors: Early Career (o-5 years) Median Salary \$46,200, Mid-Career (10+ years) Median Salary \$72,500 (payscale.com)
- Graduate Education
 - 52% have a masters degree or above (83% masters) are currently pursuing one
 - Wide Range of Fields: Sociology, Education, Social Work, Counseling / Psychology, Business, Criminal Justice, Law, Public Policy / Public Affairs, Public Health
- 80% of Alumni use knowledge gained from their degree on a regular basis

SU SOCI Major Seniors on the Program & Preparation

(senior survey data -2016-22)

- 100% of SU SOCI Majors that the sociology program has prepared them for employment
- 89% of Majors responded that the sociology program has prepared them for graduate study
- 96% of Majors responded that the sociology program has prepared them for Civic Life or Civic Activism
- <u>100% of Majors</u> ranked the SOCI faculty as excellent or good in their <u>knowledge of sociology</u> (96% excellent)
- 100% of Majors were satisfied with the quality of teaching (85% strongly satisfied)
- 96% of Majors ranked the SOCI faculty as excellent or good in their teaching skills (mainly former)
- 100% of majors ranked the SOCI faculty as excellent or good in their caring / concern (85% excellent)
- 100% of Majors were overall satisfied with their experience in the major (88% highly satisfied)
