### CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING SLIDES WITHIN YOUR PRESENTATION ›

- **Title Slide**  
Presentation title  
Department name(s) and presenter(s)  
Contact information
- **Framing the Topic**  
What challenge or opportunity are you addressing?  
Why is this important for student success?  
(Connect to one or more conference goals.)
- **Knowing Our Students**  
What student populations or trends informed your work?  
How have students' needs or behaviors changed in your area?
- **Innovative Approaches**  
How did your team's support, service, or process evolve?  
How are you using data, technology (e.g., Navigate), or partnerships to improve outcomes?
- **Impact and Outcomes**  
What have you learned or achieved so far?  
Include data, feedback, or observations.
- **Next Steps & Collaboration Opportunities**  
How could others partner or build on this work?  
What are your future goals for supporting students?
- **Q&A / Discussion**  
Prompt: "How does this connect to what you're seeing in your area?"
