POSTER LAYOUT SUGGESTIONS ›

■ **Title and Department**

Include SU logo and your department's name.

■ **Overview / Challenge**

What issue or opportunity are you addressing?

■ **Our Students**

What do we know about the students impacted by this work?

Include visuals (infographics, student quotes, or photos if appropriate).

■ **Our Approach**

Describe what your team implemented or changed.

Note how data, technology, or collaboration played a role.

■ **Results / Lessons Learned**

Share outcomes, insights, or key takeaways.

■ **Looking Ahead**

What's next? How can others collaborate or adapt your ideas?

■ **Contact Information**

Add names, emails, and QR code for follow-up resources.
