PROGRAM POLICIES

- The delivery of the program includes 3 years of coursework and a year devoted to research and writing of the dissertation.
- 60 credits (course work and dissertation) are required, with more if a student chooses to select optional electives.
- A part-time track is available for those candidates who are unable to engage in full-time study

Advisement for the program is available from the Literacy Studies Department.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Complete 60 credits with an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher. A course grade below C will lead to program dismissal.
- Receive a passing score in the Preliminary Exam. Those receiving an unsatisfactory score may continue on probation and must pass the preliminary examination by the end of the following semester.
- Receive a passing score in the Advancement to Candidacy/Comprehensive Examination.
- Successfully defend a Dissertation Proposal.
- Successfully defend a Dissertation Defense.
- Submit final dissertation to ProQuest Dissertation Publishing
