

Summer Faculty Mentoring Fellowship

Purpose

The Summer Faculty Mentoring Fellowship is intended to provide funding support for faculty conducting summer research and scholarly activities with undergraduates. They are intended for faculty that are not receiving funding for summer stipends from other sources to support their mentorship of undergraduates (i.e. grants, etc.). These summer funds will be paid via faculty supplemental contracts.

Eligibility

All 10-month full-time faculty who have academic appointments at Salisbury University are eligible for this program.

Funding

The Dean of Graduate Studies and Research will provide awards for summer 2023. Faculty are eligible for a one-time summer supplemental payment of \$1,500 to be paid by August 1. Applications must be submitted by May 8. A limited number of awards will be made.

Review Process

All applications will be reviewed by the Dean, Graduate Studies and Research, in consultation with the respective academic deans.
