The Office of Undergraduate Research and Creative Activities (OURCA) at SU sponsors a Travel Grant Award Program, which enables outstanding SU undergraduate students to present their research, creative, or scholarly projects at the National Conference on Undergraduate Research (NCUR). The award will cover travel, registration, and hotel. Students must be registered as undergraduates at Salisbury University in Spring 2026 in order to qualify.

***Please note that the Travel Grant Award Program is highly competitive, with funds for a limited number of students***

## SU NCUR Travel Grant Submission Instructions

- You must submit your abstract to NCUR by the Dec 5<sup>th</sup> 2026 deadline by using the NCUR submission portal
- Only those submissions accepted by NCUR will be eligible for the SU NCUR travel award.

To apply for the OURCA NCUR, Travel Grant, please follow the steps below:

1. First, to submit an application for the SU NCUR travel grant, have your ***abstract*** and ***your faculty mentor's email so they can be emailed a recommendation form*** ready to enter.

  - Please follow the abstract guidelines provided by NCUR
  - Please provide your faculty mentor's SU email
2. Access the [travel grant application form](#), and then
  - Complete all fields on the form and certify that you agree to attend NCUR 2026 April 13-15, 2026, if your abstract is accepted for presentation.
  - Upload two documents for review for your SU Travel Grant Application: Your ***abstract document*** AND ***your faculty mentor letter of support***, both in pdf format.
  - Deadline Sunday, November 30, 2025
