Fall 2023: Tell Dr. Walton (kpwalton@salisbury.edu) if you want to register for IDIS 280 (fellowship writing) in the Spring Semester

- IDIS 280, 2nd half of semester: Meets Tuesday 3-5pm after Spring Break
- 1 credit class
- Will result in a draft of Fulbright application by end of term
- Email Dr Walton to reserve your spot in class (spaces limited)

January 2024: Start thinking about country and research options

April 2, 2024: On-Line Application Opens: DO NOT HIT SUBMIT UNTIL

- APPROVED BY DR WALTON, DR PERRET, or DR BASHAM!
 - Register with site: **Be sure to list Salisbury University in** the PRELIMINARY QUESTIONS section so SNCFO can access your information & register with an email you can access through 8 October!
 - Check out application and requirements and attend Overview if able: <u>Fulbright U.S. Student Program Overview</u> (2-3pm for applicants)

April-May 2024: Decide on what project/Fulbright -

- do research on your topic if a Research Grant
- Research country for either grant
- Research Grants: Start looking for Affiliations (Names and Universities)
- Work on language
- Speak with Dr. Walton/Perret at SNCFO on summer activities

June 1, 2024: Intent to Apply for Fulbright (recommended)

- Email Dr Walton and Fill out survey monkey with basic information (found under student resources: https://salisbury.co1.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_8qPWPrGg8sHL445

Summer 2024

- SUMMER BOOT CAMP (time TBA, zoom, during lunch hour)
- Start drafting statements for application
- Fill out the personal details for application: at (go to application for OKTA: https://apply.iie.org/apply)
- Start looking at Language reference writers (See Drs. Walton/Perret first)
- Think about your recommenders reach out to them
- Decide on Affiliation and make first contact

**AUGUST 1, 2024

- DUE DATE for first consideration applications for 2022
- Fill out application on Site OR send PDF (email Dr. Walton when ready)
- This will ensure full involvement in the revision process and strongest assistance for completing the Fulbright successfully.

***September 5, 2024

- FINAL DATE for First REAL draft of Application Due fill out online application on Fulbright web-site.
- YOU **MUST** upload at least full drafts of your statements at this time and list recommenders/language, et al.

***September 5, 2024

- Due date for COMPLETE application for round 1 of Interviews.
- This due date gives you more time for revisions post-interview.
- PLEASE give this date to your recommenders/Language Evaluators/Affiliations when working on the application
- This application WILL be used for your interview

September 5-15, 2024

- Meet with Dr. Walton/Dr Perret/Dr Basham (multiple times preferred)
- Writing sessions for Fulbright applicants
- Order transcripts from University
- Complete Language evaluation
- Speak more to recommenders give drafts of statements and info for application

***September 15, 2024

- COMPLETE application due for use of SNCFO recommendations, language evaluation, transcripts, et al, must all be uploaded to the application at this time. Revised essays submitted (UPLOAD on Slate – DO NOT HIT SUBMIT)
- THIS APPLICATION will be used for your interview, so it needs to be in good shape

September 9-18, 2024: First Round of Interviews

- Campus Interviews
- Application will be unsubmitted for additional revisions post-interview.

September 18-25, 2024: Second Round of Interviews

- Campus Interviews
- Application will be unsubmitted for additional revisions post-interview.

OCTOBER 1, 2024

- SU due date for what you think as final application uploaded on site
