

What are the dual enrollment eligibility requirements?

- Full-time student at a Worcester County public high school
- Have an overall weighted grade point average of at least 2.75
- Prerequisite coursework may be required for some courses

How much does dual enrollment cost?

(includes all fees for up to four courses per academic year)

- \$135 per credit hour for in-state students
- \$270 per credit hour for out-of-state students
- FARM students attend for free
- Tuition is due by October 1 for the fall semester or March 1 for the spring semester
- Non-payment of tuition will result in automatic withdrawal from the course
