SAFETY ----- TERRORISM	Personal Safety Concern ----- Suspicious packages, materials or individuals	UNIVERSITY POLICE	on campus 3-6222 off campus 410-543-6222
FIRE	Uncontrollable fire: Evacuate area; call for help; pull fire alarm; walk to nearest exit; warn others to evacuate as you leave the building; move a safe distance from the building; provide information to emergency responders as they arrive	911...NEXT, CONTACT UNIVERSITY POLICE FROM A SAFE LOCATION	911

ALL SERIOUS INJURIES	Life threatening injuries (major cuts, major trauma, loss of consciousness, unresponsive, difficulty breathing, not breathing, etc.): Call 911; University Police is trained in First Aid.	911	911
