SULead: Professional Development Program

SULead is a Salisbury University professional development initiative designed to provide staff with the opportunity to learn about various aspects of University operations. The program creates a pipeline of diverse leaders within the institution and provides an opportunity for staff to be more informed about how various offices/departments work together to support the entire campus community. The program's goal is to foster engagement of talented, emerging staff with leadership potential. The program provides participants with the opportunity to gain familiarity with campus, engage with the University's senior leaders, and explore leadership through mentoring, assigned readings and facilitated sessions.

SULead will be a semester-long program that brings together a cohort of 5-10 staff members from various campus departments.

Goals:

- Learn about the many important functions of the University
- Understand how the University's offices and departments work together towards the shared mission of Salisbury University
- Network and build strong relationships across campus and throughout the wider community

Activities: Participants learn about each division from members of the President's Cabinet and interact with representatives from shared governance, the City of Salisbury and local business leaders. Participants also learn about the challenges and opportunities facing higher education and will provide input on specific challenges and opportunities. Each cohort participates in a semester-long series of sessions and group meetings. Most sessions are three hours and held once per week.

Requirements: Employees must have completed their probationary period and be in good standing with Human Resources. Selected finalists for SULead will need to receive supervisor and division vice president approval prior to entering the program. This program is intended for all staff up to the director level across all divisions. To apply, submit a resume and letter (no more than one page) on what makes you a good fit for this program.
